In the reference, 1st cited, the Executive Engineer, PWD (WRD), Mining and Monitoring Division, Trichy has furnished a proposal with a request to grant permission for a new sand quarry in S.F. No. 350 (Part) over an extent of 16.00.0 Hects., in Coleroon river in Elakkurichi Village, Ariyalur Taluk & District.

2. In this regard, based on the recommendations of the Revenue Divisional Officer, Ariyalur, the Executive Engineer, TWAD Board, RWS Division, Ariyalur and the Assistant Director, Geology and Mining, Ariyalur, the application was examined, considered for the grant of sand quarry lease and directed to submit mining plan over an extent of 16.00.0 Hects., in S.F. No. 350(Part) of Elakkurichi Village, Ariyalur Taluk & District.

3. As directed, the Executive Engineer, Water Resource Department, Mining and Monitoring Division, Trichy-20 has submitted three copies of Mining Plan prepared by RQP vide reference 8th cited for approval. The Mining Plan has been examined and the details of area applied for etc., are detailed as below:-

4. The area applied for permission is 10 Kms away from the interState boundary, protected area under Wild Life Protection Act, 1972, critically polluted areas as identified by CPCB and notified Eco sensitive areas. The Mining Plan has been examined and it contains all the conditions stipulated in the rules. Hence, in exercise of the power delegated by the Government, the mining plan submitted by the Executive Engineer, Mining and Monitoring Division, Trichy is hereby approved subject to the following conditions.


1. That the mining plan is approved without prejudice to any other Law applicable to the quarry permission from time to time whether such Laws are made by the State Government or any other authority.
2. This approval of the Mining Plan does not in any way imply the approval of the Government in terms of any other provisions of the Tamil Nadu Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1959.
3. That the Mining plan is approved without prejudice to any other order or direction from any court of competent jurisdiction.

4. The applicant is directed to submit the application in Form-I as prescribed by the MOEF along with the approved Mining Plan to the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Tamil Nadu, Chennai to issue Environment Clearance.
5. The Executive Engineer, Water Resource Department (WRD), Mining and Monitoring Division, Trichy-20, shall strictly adhere the guidelines and instructions given by the Government for quarrying of sand.
6. Quarrying shall be under the direct control and supervision of a technical person not lower than the cadre of Assistant Engineer.
7. Quarrying shall be done without causing any hindrance to the local public and nearby Agricultural lands.
8. The proposed site is to be demarcated with pucca pillar stones and benchmark before the commencement of pre-quarrying operation in this area such as laying of road etc.
9. No criss cross road is permissible in the proposed quarry site which may cause obstruction to the flow of water.
10. No transport permit shall be issued for other States.
11. If any of the above condition is found to be violated the quarrying permission is deemed to be cancelled automatically without any notice.
