In the reference 1st cited above one Thiru.S.Balasubramanian, S/o.Selvaraj, Melavalavu Village, Melur Taluk, Madurai District has applied for the grant of lease to quarry Gravel over an extent of 2.18.5 Hectares in S.F. No. 23/6 (0.75.0), 24/6 (0.43.5) and 24/7 (1.00.0) of S.Keelapatti Village, Peraiyur Taluk under Rule 19 of Tamil Nadu Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1959.

The precise area has been communicated to the applicant based on the recommendations of the Revenue Divisional Officer, Usilampatti and Assistant Director (Mines), Madurai.

Accordingly Thiru.S.Balasubramanian has submitted the Draft Mining Plan and the details regarding production, Environmental aspects and other plans prepared by the RQP are in order.


Therefore, in exercise of the power delegated under Rule 42 of Tamil Nadu Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1959, I hereby approve the mining plan submitted by Thiru.S.Balasubramanian, S/o.Selvaraj, Melavalavu Village, Melur Taluk, Madurai District for grant of lease to quarry Gravel over an extent of 2.18.5 Hectares in S.F. No. 23/6 (0.75.0), 24/6 (0.43.5) and 24/7 (1.00.0) of S.Keelapatti Village, Peraiyur Taluk for a period of 3 (Three) Year and production quantity of mining after leaving safety distance is 87,328 CBM Gravel to a depth of 4 metre (2m above ground level and 2 m below ground level). This approval is subject to the following conditions:

- (i). That the mining plan is approved without prejudice to any other Law applicable to the quarry lease from time to time whether such Laws are made by the Central Government, State Government or any other authority.
- (ii). This approval of the mining plan does not in any way imply the approval of the Government in terms of any other provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, or any other connected laws including Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, Forest

Conservation Rules, 1981, Environment Protection Act, 1980, Indian Explosives Act, 1884(Central Act IV of 1884) and the rules made there under the Tamil Nadu Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1959.

- (iii). That the mining plan is approved without prejudice to any other order or direction from any court of competent jurisdiction.
