Sub:- Approval of Mining plan and progressive mine closure plan of Mouje Harur, Stone Quarry over a Lease area of 1.20 Ha. Located in Gut No. 299/B, Part, Village Harur Tal. Ajara, Dist. Kolhapur

In exercise of the powers conferred by Government of Maharashtra vide Industries, Energy and Labour Dept. Mumbai notification No. MNG- 1004/PK/610/Ind-9, dt. 16/06/2004 under rule 22 (BB) of Mineral Concession Rules 1960 and the authorization given by Director, Directorate of Geology and Mining, Government of Maharashtra, Nagpur vide Notification No. STC/265/4/2014/1625, dt. 04/07/2017, I hereby approve above said Mining Plan. This approval is subject to following condition.

1. The Mining plan along with PMCP is approved without prejudice to any other laws that applicable to the mine / area from time to time whether made by central or State Government or any other authority.
2. That this approval of Mining Plan along with PMCP does not in any way imply the approval of the Government in terms of any other provisions of the Maharashtra Minor Mineral Extraction (Dev. & Reg.) Rules, 2013 / Maharashtra Granite extraction Rules 1995 including environment protection Act. - 1986 and the Rules made there under.
3. Relevant clearances should be obtained as per Environment Protection Act.-1986 and E.I.A. notification dated 21/01/1994 and 14/09/2006.
4. It is further clarified that the approval of the Mining Plan along with PMCP is subject to the provisions of forest (Conservation) Act. - 1980, Forest Conservation Rules, 2003 and other relevant status, order and guidelines as may be applicable to the lease area from time to time.
5. The execution of Mining Plan along with PMCP shall be subject to vacation of prohibitory order/notices, if any.
6. This department does not undertake any responsibility regarding correctness of the boundaries of the Mining lease area shown on the ground with reference to Mining lease map and other plans furnished by the lessee.
7. That if any thing found to be concealed, act in the contents of Mining Plan and the proposal for rectification has not been made the approval shall be deemed to have been withdrawn with immediate effect.
8. That Mining Plan along with PMCP is approved without prejudice to any other order or directions for any Hon. Court of competent jurisdiction.
9. The financial assurance should be submitted to District Collectorate before the execution of the said mining lease as per rule 30 of Maharashtra Minor Mineral Extraction (Development and Regulation) Rules, 2013.
10. The proposals shown on the platesand or given in the document is based on the lease map/sketch submitted by the applicant /lessee and applicable from the date of approval.

11. This approval of proposed mining operations and associated activities is restricted to the mining lease area only.
12. The approval is without prejudice to any other order or direction from any court of competent jurisdiction.
13. This approval is given for the received proposal as applicable from this date onwards. The provision made under rule 24 (3),28(1)MMME (D& R)-2013 will be applicable to the approval.
14. At any stage,if it is observed that the information furnished in the documents are incorrect or misrepresent facts,the approval of the document shall be revoked with immediate effect.
15. The DMO is directed to verify the pit-size vis-à-vis the royalty paid by the lessee.The difference or royalty if any should be recovered from the lessee.
16. The approval of the above said mining plan is subject to the compliance and to fulfill the requirement as mentioned in Maharashtra Minor Mineral Extraction (Development and Regulation)Rules,2013.
17. Whatever production capacity of the area in consideration is shown or calculated in the mining plan it is recommended to restrict the annual production as per Environment department guidance. Hence,you are not permitted to excavated annual production of the material (Stone,boulder, murum) beyond prescribed limit by Environment department and Collector's order.
18. Use of blasting, if any, should be with prior permission of the DGMS, all safety major regarding mine depth, drilling, blastin parameter should be strictly followed as per DGMS guidelines.
19. This mining paln is approved on the basis of information provided by lessee/RQP if any queries raised by DMO regarding pit size (length width and depth excavated), quantity of material excavated and dimensions of lease boundary etc., it will be the responsibility of the lessee / RQP and if such any dispute occurs it will be binding on lessee to resolve the issue time to time after proper corrections and rectifications with consultation of District Mining Officer.
20. The mining plan is approved with regards to mining lease purposes to be granted by competent authority as per provision of Maharashtra Minor Mineral Extraction (Development & Regulation) Rules-2013.
21. Approval of Mining Plan subject to proposed rules to be framed by state Govt. with respect to Laterite and same will be abided to lease holders.
22. The Decision/Guidilines Givenby Hon.N.G.T. in case No. 8/2017 (WZ) dated 14/11/2017 is applicable to all concerned lessee/District Mining Officer.
23. The validity of the mining plan is up to five years or up to the lease period whichever is earlier.
