In exercise of the powers conferred by Government of Maharashtra vide Industries, Energy and Labour Department, Mumbai notification No. MNG 1004/PK 610/Ind-9 dated 16/06/2004 under rule 22(BB) of Mineral Concession Rules 1960 and the authorization given by Director, Directorate of Geology and Mining, Government of Maharashtra, Nagpur vide Notification No. STC/265/Part-4/2016/2462, dated 3<sup>rd</sup> Nov. 2017, I, hereby approve the said Mining Plan. This approval is subject to the following conditions.

- 1) The Mining Plan along with PMCP is approved without prejudice to any other laws applicable to the mine/area from time to time, whether made by the State Government and any other authority.
- 2) That this approval of Mining Plan along with PMCP does not in any way imply the approval of the Government in terms of any other provisions of the Maharashtra Minor Mineral Extraction (Development and Regulation) Rules-2013/Maharashtra Granite Extraction Rules 1995 including Environment Protection Act-1960 including Environment Protection Act-1986 and the Rules made there under.
- 3) Relevant clearances should be obtained as per Environmental Protection Act-1986 and E.I.A. notification dated 27/01/1994 and 4/09/2006.
- 4) It is further clarified that the approval of the Mining Plan along with PMCP is subject to the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act-1980, Forest Conservation Rules, 2003 and other relevant status order and guidelines as may be applicable to the lease area from time to time. The Lessee is required to obtain all necessary permission as directed by forest dept. & comply in this regard.
- 5) The execution of Mining Plan along with PMCP shall be subject to vacation of prohibitory orders / notices, If any.

- 6) This department does not undertake any responsibility regarding correctness of the boundaries of the lease area shown on the ground with reference to Mining lease map and other plans furnished by the lessee.
- 7) That if anything found to be concealed act in contents on mining plan and proposal for rectification has not been made, the approval shall be deemed to have withdrawn with immediate effect.
- 8) That the Mining Plan along with PMCP is approved without prejudice to any other order or directions from any court of competent jurisdiction
- 9) The financial assurance should be submitted to district collectorate before execution of said mining lease as per Rule 30 of MMME (D& R) Rules 2013.
- 10) The approval of Proposed Mining operation and associated activities is restricted to mining lease area only.
- 11) At any stage, if it observed that the information furnished in the document are incorrect or misrepresent facts, the approval of the document shall be revoked with immediate effect
- 12) The DMO is directed to verify the pit size, vis- a vis the royalty paid by the lassee. The difference of royalty, if any should be recovered.
- 13) The approval of the said mining plan is subject to the compliance and fulfill the requirement as mentioned in MMME (D& R) Rules 2013, the approval is subject to necessary compliance to be lassee to IBM and collectorate.
- 14) Use of blasting if any should be prior permission of concerned authority.
- 15) The mining plan is approved with regards to mining lease purposes to be granted by competent authority as per provision of MMME (D& R) Rules 2013
- 16) Whatever Production capacity of the area in consideration is shown or calculated in the mining plan it is recommended to restrict the annual production as per Environment Department guidance. Hence, you are not permitted to excavated annual production of the material (Stone) beyond prescribed limit by Environment Department and Collector's order
- 17) Approval of mining plan subject to rules to be framed by state Govt. with respect to the stone and same will be abided to the lease holders,
- 18) The provision of Mines act 1952 and Rules and Regulation made there under including submission of notices of opening, appointment of manager and other statutory officials as required by Mines act 1952 shall be complied with.
- 19) The implementation of approved mining plan is applicable only after the grant and execution of mining lease to the applicant and valid up to the end of lease period or Plan Period which is earlier.
