Sir,

This refers to your proposal no. IA/MH/IND2/64043/2017 dated 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 along with project documents namely Form-I, Pre-feasibility Report and draft 'Terms of Reference' as per the EIA Notification, 2006. It is noted that the proposal is for expansion of molasses based distillery from 35KLPD to 65KLPD at Shreepur, Malshiras Taluk, Solapur District (Maharashtra) by M/s Brima Sagar Maharashtra Distilleries Ltd.

2. Distillery is located in an area of 30.60 hectares and no additional area is required for the proposed expansion. Industry has developed 5.0 hectares of greenbelt and the remaining 5.25 hectares to fulfil the requirement of 33% of Greenbelt is under development. Total employment will be 254 persons as direct and 60 persons indirect after expansion. Industry proposes to allocate 1.25 cores at 2.5% towards Corporate Social Responsibility.

3. As per Form 1 it is reported that there are no National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuaries, Biosphere Resources, Tiger/ Elephant Reserves, Wild Life Corridors etc. lies within 10 km radius of the site. Bhima River is flowing at a distance of 4.6 km in N-E direction.

Ministry's website) for preparation of EIA/EMP report, along with the additional TOR as under:-

Based on the recommendations of the EAC, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change hereby accords the terms of reference for preparation of EIA/EMP reports for the above said project, with the standard ToR applicable for such projects and the additional ToR as specified above. Public hearing is exempted under the provisions as per para 7(ii) of the EIA notification, 2006.

7. You are requested to kindly submit the final EIA/EMP prepared as per TORs to the Ministry for considering the proposal for environmental clearance within 3 years as per the MoEF O.M. No. J-11013/41/2006-IA.II (I) dated 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2014.

8. The consultants involved in the preparation of EIA/EMP report after accreditation with Quality Council of India/National Accreditation Board of Education and Training (QCI/NABET) would need to include a certificate in this regard in the EIA/EMP reports prepared by them and data provided by other Organization(s)/Laboratories including their status of approvals etc.
