In exercise of the powers delegated to the undersigned by the Central Pollution Control Board vide Notification No. B-12015/7/92. Published in the Gazette of India NO. 746 dated 26/11/1992 and Administration order No. 45/1(1)/92-F&E/4700 dated 8/2/1993, the Consent is hereby granted under Section 25, Sub-section (1) & (2) of Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Amendment Act, 1988, to operate the industry at the above mentioned address subject to the following terms and conditions :-

- PRODUCTS:**
1. Polymers of vinyl acetate - 600 M.T./year
  2. Vinyl co-polymers - 600 M.T./year (Water based adhesives)
  3. Acrylic Polymers - 960 M.T./year
  4. Poly vinyl alcohol solution - 100 M.T./year

**CONDITIONS:**  
 1) This consent is valid upto 31/07/1999. (By Director only)  
 2) The maximum daily discharge of effluent shall not exceed to the following:

3. The treatment facilities must be provided for the treatment of domestic and industrial effluent before commissioning of the industry so that the treated effluent quality must be capable of achieving the following limits :-

SR. NO.	PARAMETERS	LIMITS
1.	pH	6.5 - 9.0
2.	BOD 5 20 C	Not to exceed 50 mg/l.
3.	Suspended Solids	Not to exceed 50 mg/l.

- 4) If at any time it is observed that effluent fails to confirm to the limits prescribed, consent will be withdrawn prohibiting the industry to manufacture either existing or new products.
- 5) The industry shall comply with general conditions of Consent on the reverse.
- 6) The applicant shall submit separate application for obtaining Consent for operation/renewal under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 before 30 days of expiry of validity period of Consent.
- 7) The industry shall comply with Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1977 and submit monthly Cess Returns as contemplated in the Act, in the prescribed form.
- 8) There shall be no discharge of water/solid.
- 9) There shall be no emission of gases.
- 10) Formaldehyde shall not be used as a raw material.

11) The products shall be prepared only by dilution and not by manufacturing
