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S.no 1 The Authority observed that project submitted has habitation, heritage building and 10 forest blocks very close to the project site i.e within 400mts and decided to seek detailed comments of SEAC and to specifically mention the grounds on which SEAC has recommended to grant EC. The SEAC may be asked to do so and resubmit the case again for the next meeting of SEIAA.

S.No 2,3,4,5,6,7 and 8: The Authority decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC to close and delist the cases

S.no9: The Authority recommended that the prevalent Rules and Regulations as well as Judgement given by various Hon'ble courts be followed

S.No 10 : The Authority decided that an opportunity of personal hearing be granted in all 8 cases and they may be called before the Authority on 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2019

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**S.no 11 and 12:** The Authority decided that as recommended by SEAC the matter has to be taken up with MoEF&CC, Gol in light of judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the SLP no 341/2013 state of Rajasthan vs Nature club of Rajasthan. The replenishment Study report as received from Director Mines and Geology may be send back to them along with the comment that this Authority be provided the study Report after its acceptance /approval by the state Government.

**S.No 13 :** The Authority observed that there is ambiquity in the file. It is not clear whether this is a matter of fresh EC, or its expansion as mine owner has given statement which is different to the recommendation of SEAC .comments of SEAC be sought again and matter reconsidered after that.

**S.no 14 & 15 :** The Authority accepted the recommendation of SEAC to close and delist all 80 and 36 files respectively.

**S.no 16 :** The Authority accepted the recommendation of SEAC to close and delist the case

**S.no 17:** The authority discussed the matter and decided that SEAC has to take a decision at their level after getting reply from RSPCB and PP.

**Additional Agenda:** it was observed by SEIAA that the minutes of meeting of SEAC are made available after a long period and hence Member Secretary, SEAC be requested that the meeting minutes of SEAC are made available to SEIAA within 7 days after the meeting is held
