Sri S K Seal Sarma, Chairman, SEAC, Assam presided over the meeting. Welcoming all the Hon'ble Members the Chairman, SEAC expressed that altogether 21 nos. of cases have been included including one presentation and started the proceedings as per agenda item placed on the table.

The minutes of the 46th SEAC meeting held on 29th Sept. 2022 is placed on the table for perusal of the Hon'ble Members and necessary discussion. The minutes of the 46th SEAC meeting is approved unanimously after a brief discussion.

The project proposal asking modification of FC for mining of stone from "Madhupur Patta Land Stone Materials Mining Permit Area" under Cachar Division proposed by Sri Robijyoti Bhattacharjee is placed before the SEAC for scrutiny, appraisal and discussion. On scrutiny it is observed that the previous EC was granted on 29th Feb. 2020 with validity for two years against mining area 2.94 hect. The application for extension of the EC was submitted on 6th Aug. 2022 that is after a gap of about six months with respect to the validity of the previous EC. Further, the previous EC was granted against mining area of 2.94 hect whereas the fresh Mining Plan for the

same prepared for an area of 4.0 hect. Due deliberation is held and the committee requires the following additional information/clarification for consideration of the project proposal.

- Storm water discharge plan attached as Annexure-V is a different ma. Proper storm iii) water discharge plan with detail size, and interconnectivity and linked to outside drain is required.
- Water Budget and Water Balance should include rainwater harvesting component. iv)
- Flood inundation map as per EDS is required. v)

The DFO will also arrange to mark the approved mining site on the ground fixing pillars before actual mining operation as mining is allowed within the approved mining site and not beyond the limit of the same. - the proposed site in under water in the river bed and class of land is agriculture (Faring). Clarification is required stating how the patta land falls in the river bed. Further, non agriculture land certificate from the appropriate authority of Revenue Department is required.
- The CHD, BTAD vide letter dated 29th March 2022 has approved quantity of sand 1000 cu.m. and gravel 1000 cu.m. are to be extracted. On the other hand quantity for extraction minable materials in the approved Mining Plan recommended 400 cu.m. sand and 600 cu.m gravel per year. Further, the percentage of Sand and Gravel has not been shown in the estimation in the approved mining plan.

In view of the above and after due deliberation the committee resolved asking the proponent to submit revised Mining Plan addressing the above points.

The Mining Plan approved by the DGM, Assam dated 5th Aug. 2022 and LOI issued by the DFO dated 6th July 2022 are discussed. The estimation in the approved mining plans shows reserve quantity 29970 cu.m per year whereas recommendation for extraction is made 6000 cu.m for three years i.e. 2000 cu.m. per year. Detailed deliberation is held and the committee requires proper clarification information on the following points for taking further requisite action.

- Recommended /required quantity is very low in compare to large reserve quantity estimated in the approved mining plan against 3.33 hect. minable area.
