The SEAC noted that total plot area is 5,761.3 Sq.m., out of which, green area is 585.0 Sq.m. (10.2%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 41,056.0 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are 2B + S + 17 Floors.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 11,427.0 Sq.m., (38.6% against required 33%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.48.0 Crores. 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The SEAC noted that the project is for Rough Stone & Road Metal Mine with Mine Lease Area of 10.266 Ha. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 4,40,000 m³/annum.

The SEAC noted from Notice dt. 23.12.2019 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan.

Nearest human habitation is Rekulakunta Thanda @ 0.374 km; Nearest water body i.e., Surasamudram Cheruvu exists at a distance of 8.14 km; Nearest RF i.e., Ramnutla RF exists at 0.050 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC considered the request of the proponent. After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

During presentation, it was informed that there are 5 mines of M/s. Jahnvi Minerals (13.50 Ha. & 13.50 Ha.) and M/s. Vishruth Minerals (14.90 Ha., 14.90 Ha. & 6.566 Ha.) are contiguous to each other located within 500 mts. as cluster as per the lr.dt.15.09.2020 of the ADMG, Rangareddy District.

The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 13.50 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 63.366 Ha. and Net cluster area is 63.366 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Mudivenu (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.1 km; nearest water body is Pedda Vagu exists at 0.92 km (E); Nearest RF i.e., Mudivenu RF exists at 3.1 km from the boundary of the site.

It was informed that individual TORs were issued for preparation of EIA report along with public hearing. The SEAC noted the EMP measures proposed by the project proponent.

Project Cost is Rs. 19.6 Crores. Budget for Environmental protection towards Capital Cost is Rs.295.0 Lakhs and Recurring Cost is Rs.33.0 Lakhs/annum. Budget for CER is Rs.39.2 lakhs in first 5 years.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 01.12.2021 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 06.12.2021 of ADMG, Kumaram Bheem Asifabad District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.43 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 2.43 Ha. and Net cluster area is 2.43 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Mutampet (V) which is existing at a distance of 2.1 km; nearest water body exists at 620 m (E); and an open mixed jungle exists at 1.2 km (E) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 3,50,000 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 18 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 9.1 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.4 Lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the SEAC noted that it is a government land, but it is observed from the google map that presently Agriculture is going on in the mine lease area. The proponent informed that the said land was allotted by the government after acquiring from the Lavani Patta holders.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project and informed the project proponent to submit evidence for acquisition of land from Lavani Patta to government and allotment to the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent attended on Video Call Sri Shyam Sunder of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, it was informed that M/s. TSIIC Ltd, has set up Industrial Park at Sy.no.228/9, Kucharam (V), Manoharabad (M), Medak District, in an area spread over 33.3 ha (82.5 Acres). The Proposed Industrial Park has obtained CFE from TSPCB vide Order dt: 20.11.2017. It was also informed that TSIIC has allocated 38 plot to industries currently out of which 8 are in operation & remaining are under construction phase and there are other plots to be allotted. Now, due to the demand of requirement of Bio Medical Waste (BMW) treatment facility by various surrounding Bulk drug and Pharma intermediary industries located in Hyderabad, Rangareddy and Medchal-Malkajgiri districts to dispose their Medical waste, TSIIC has allotted Plot no. 40 to M/s. SVR Incinerators for establishment of **Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBMWTF)** for treatment of biomedical waste and specified Industrial wastes (R&D, pharma and expired medicines) after receiving permission from TSPCB vide lr. dt. 31.07.2021.

M/s. S.V.R. Incinerators is proposing to set up a “Specific Industrial Waste (R&D, Pharma and expired medicine) & Common Bio-medical Treatment Facility” to cater biomedical waste from various bulk drug units generating and to cater to Health Care Facilities with (HCF) with 10,000 beds in and around Hyderabad and Medak Districts. The details of the CBMWTF are

The overall power requirement for the Industrial Park is approximately, 1.0 MW and the source of power is Telangana State Electricity Board. An electrical substation is also proposed in Plot no.69.

Water requirement during the construction phase will be around 4.5 KLD for Development of Infrastructure facilities.

After the complete occupancy of all the allotted plots, the approximated Total Water requirement is calculated as around 363 KLD, taking into consideration the requirement for common facilities also. Water requirement will be sourced through Bore wells.

Individual Industries, upon establishment, will have their own STP/ ETP for liquid waste treatment/ disposal and maintain a Solid waste/ hazardous waste storage facility, within their Plot as applicable as per TSPCB Norms.

As estimated quantity of 54 KLD of Domestic wastewater is going to generate from the entire industrial park. TSIIC Ltd is proposing an STP Plant with 66 KLD capacity in plot no.85 on South East side for domestic wastewater treatment.

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Individual Industries, upon establishment, will have their own ETP for liquid waste treatment/ disposal and maintain a Solid waste/ hazardous waste storage facility, within their Plot as applicable as per TSPCB Norms.

The SEAC observed that the TSIIC already set up Industrial Park as the total area was only 33.3 Ha. i.e., less than 50.0 Ha. and not housing any industry belonging to Category-A or B. But, now they applied for EC as they allotted plot to set up a CBMWTF which is a Category-B project and thus it requires EC.

The SEAC noted that TORs were issued by the SEIAA on 24.07.2020 and the proponent undergone the process of Public Hearing on 24.10.2021. The SEAC noted the contents of the final EIA report and observed that the issues emerged during public hearing are air pollution by the existing industries of industrial park, streams & ground water contamination, impact of industries on nearest village & fauna, death of sheeps due to consumption of contaminated water, employment to locals, odour nuisance & water pollution due to discharge of waste outside the premises. The SEAC also noted that 2 representations were received from Kucharam Gram Panchayat (signed by 11 people) and from M/s. Nature Icon Youth Association (signed by 228 people) of Kucharam village against establishment of CBMWTF by M/s. SVR Incinerators.

The SEAC also noted the Ir.dt.31.07.2021 of the TSPCB wherein it was informed that M/s. SVR Incinerators submitted representation seeking permission for establishment of "specific industrial wastes (R&D, Pharma and Expired Medicines) Bio-medical Treatment Facility" at Plot No.40, Sy.No.228/9 of Kucharam (V&M), Medak District, for the purpose of applying for EC. The Board (in-principle) agreed to consider the representation of M/s. SVR Incinerators for establishment of new CBMWTF at Plot No.40, Sy.No.228/9 of Kucharam (V&M), Medak District to cater the HCFs located in Hyderabad, Rangareddy & Medchal-Malkajgiri Districts for collection, transportation & disposal of only Bio-medical waste (as defined in BMW Rules, 2016 and amendments thereof), with condition to comply with the revised guidelines issued for CBMWTFs by CPCB on 21.12.2016, subject to obtaining required permissions / licences / clearance from all the concerned Departments and fulfilling meeting criteria. It was also mentioned that the request for handling of Industrial waste shall not be consider since the same has to dispose in accordance with relevant Rules. The SEAC noted that the TSPCB issued permission to apply for EC only for for collection, transportation & disposal of only Bio-medical waste (as defined in BMW Rules, 2016 and amendments thereof), but not for handling of Industrial waste since the same has to dispose in accordance with relevant Rules.

The SEAC also noted that earlier EC was recently issued to M/s. Radhika Industries for establishment of new Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBMWTF) at Sy.No.121/B & 124/B/2, Thokkapur (V), Bhongir (M), Yadadri District to cater HCFs located in old Hyderabad and Rangareddy Districts and while appraising the proposal the SEAC was informed that the Bed strengths of existing CBMWTFs was exceeding and hence to meet the exceeding Bed strength, the EC was issued to M/s. Radhika Industries.

The SEAC examined the proposal and informed the project proponent to submit the following:

- Justification for consideration of new CBMWTF as bed system is sufficient for existing CBMWTFs along with supporting documents issued by the competent authority.
- Exact number of plots in the Industrial Park as they were mentioned as 43, 40, 82.
- Details of common facilities provided by TSIIC.
- Details of power backup in the Industrial Park.
- Treatment & disposal of Dioxins & Furans from proposed CBMWTF.
- Response of TSIIC to the above representations received against the project.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the proposal for consideration after receipt of above mentioned information from the proponent.
