The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Yugandhar; and Sri P.V. Raju of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 10.09.2018 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of lr.dt. 17.11.2020 of ADMG, Khammam District informing that there is one quarry lease of M/s. Saileela Granites 1.0 Ha. (EC dt. 23.10.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 3.0 Ha. and Net cluster is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Keshapuram (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.9 km; nearest water body i.e., Keshampuram Cheruvu exist at 0.965 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 3,373.8 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 11 years (@ 2516.54 m<sup>3</sup>/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 6.4 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.2 Lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the SEAC observed from the Google map that much vegetation exists within mine lease area. In this regard, the proponent submitted Undertaking that they will leave buffer zone of 7.5 mts and will maintain greenbelt. It was also informed that they have vacant patta land at Sy.No.439/P & 452/P of Thettalapadu (V), Thirumalayapalem (M), Khammam District over an extent of 1.5 acres and the same will be dedicated for compensatory plantation in lieu of the greenery to be removed in the mine area.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Ravinder; and Sri M. Venkatesh of M/s. Global Enviro Labs., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, AP (Combined State) issued EC vide order dt.01.01.2013 for mining 2,07,600 TPA of Laterite with validity period of 6.85 years. The proponent also obtained CFO vide order dt.06.03.2019 valid upto 31.03.2024.

Now, the proponent informed that the lease was earlier granted in 2005 for a period of 20 years i.e, upto 06.04.2025. The proponent informed that they have carriedout mining operations during 2012 to 2019, but the proponent has not extracted the mineral completely as proposed earlier, as per production details furnished by the ADMG, Mulugu vide lr.dt.06.08.2019. Now, as per latest mining scheme / plan, the proponent reduced the mining capacity as 2,05,800 TPA and thus the life of mine is 7 years. Hence, the proponent requested for extension of validity period of EC for 7 years.

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The SEAC examined the proposal along with CSR activities being taken up. In this regard, the proponent informed that they have implemented the CSR activities in their village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of CSR activities along with supporting documents.

- 3. The proponent had not applied for NOC from I-CAD. Since one residential colony, Vijay Diary Farm with their quarters, Hindu cremation ground and an open land of minority community are seen between the proposed site and the PeddaCheruvu NOC from I & CAD is not required.*
- 4. The proponent had proposed environmental and mitigation measures as shown in Table 2. These measures are sufficient and there would be negligible impact on the surroundings due to construction of the project.*

**Recommendations**

*Water body viz Peddacheruvu is 165 meters away from the project site and in between housing colony, Vijay Diary farm, Municipal school, Cremation grounds are observed. The Out flow of the Cheruvu also is away from the project site. There would not be any adverse impact on to the waterbody PeddaCheruvu and the surrounding environment. Recommended for issuance of EC.*

The SEAC examined the report of the Sub-Committee and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended the project for issue of EC.
