The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

The representative of Environmental Consultant Sri G.V Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad, informed that they have submitted another proposal also and present proposal is duplicate proposal for the same project and hence, they are withdrawing the present proposal.

In view of the above, the SEAC decided to return the proposal, as it is a duplicate proposal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri. N. V. Sunil Kumar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s.Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, it is observed that the site exists adjacent to the water body. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of Ir. dt. 06.07.2021 issued by Executive Engineer, North Tanks division, Hyderabad of I&CAD Dept. The SEAC observed from the document that the land in Sy. No. 56 admeasuring Ac 9.36.94 Gts/40065.30 Sq.m. situated at Hafeezpet (V), Serilingampally (M), R.R. District in north side of applicants site partially falling under FTL and Buffer zone of Meedikunta, Hafeezpet (V). The buffer zone applicable to this tank is 9.00 mtrs as the FTL area of tank is less than 10 Ha vide G.O.Ms.No. 168, MA&UDD, dt.07.04.2012. The applicant has to leave 9.00 metres from the FTL boundary of Meedikunta, Hafeezpet (V) as buffer zone. The applicants site on north west corner portion is located on the downstream of Meedikunta. As per CE, MI guidelines issued in memo dt.24.04.2014 the applicant has to leave open/maintain a width of 5.00 mts from toe line of main bund as buffer zone. As such the FTL area affected in applicants site is 203 Sq.mts, buffer area affected in applicants site is 607 Sq-mts and downstream buffer area affected in applicants site is 150 Sq-mts. Hence, the net area available in applicant site is 39,105.30 Sq.mts. Accordingly, the proponent proposed layout of the project.

The proponent informed that they have obtained NOC's (2 no.) dt. 20.07.2022 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copies of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 585.75 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 735.75 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI.

The project is proposed in a total plot area of 28,146.1 Sq.m., for construction of Residential Apartments with total built-up area of 2,43,220.4 Sq.m.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from March to May 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for Townships and Area Development projects.

The SEAC considered the request of the proponent. After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Townships and Area Development projects" considering baseline data from March to May 2022 and submit EIA report.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Mohd. Azam and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s.Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

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Earlier the SEAC in its meeting held on 22.07.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to acquire land for Compensatory Afforestation near the mine lease area and submit copies of land documents for the same.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted reply. The proponent informed that they will develop greenbelt in the Survey No. 174/19, Thumalapally (Village), Chowderigudem (Mandal), Rangareddy District with an area of Acre 2.0 gts. which is near to their mine site as compensatory afforestation and submitted Undertaking along with copies of land documents for the same. But, the SEAC observed from the documents that the land is in the name of Smt. Faheem Begum, whereas, the name of the proponent is Smt. Faheemunnisa Begum. In this regard, the proponent informed that due to typographical error the name was mentioned as Smt. Faheem Begum instead of Smt. Faheemunnisa Begum and submitted a copy of Aadhar card for the same.

The SEAC examined the information submitted by the proponent and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Sunil Kumar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed with in 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, **Manchirevula (V)** is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

Earlier, the project proponent obtained EC vide order dt.29.02.2016 from the SEIAA, TS. Now, the proponent proposed expansion of the project w.r.t Built-up area, parking area & No. of units. It was informed that the present status of the project is under construction and it is not yet completed.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that the proposed site is located near to Osman Sagar. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of letter dt.10.06.2013 issued by the EE, North Tanks Division, Hyderabad of I&CAD Dept. The SEAC observed from the document that, the site is located in Sy. Nos. 377, 380, 381 & 382 to an extent of Ac. 35-09 Gts towards downstream of Osman Sagar. The distance from the FTL boundary to the applicants site is reported to be 385 m. As per Govt.Memo.No.261/I1/2006, Dt.16.07.2007 vide para 7 (i), no development will be allowed upto 500 m from the bund/FTL in the downstream of Osman Sagar and the same shall be declared as a prohibited zone. The Metropolitan Commissioner, HMDA was requested to take action as per guidelines stipulated vide G.O.Ms.No.111 MA, dt.08.03.1996, Govt.Memo.No.261/I1/2006, dt.16.07.2007 and G.O.Ms.No. 168 dt.07.04.2012 and subject to any further orders issued from time to time before permitting any structure in the vicinity of Osman Sagar and not to disturb the ecology surrounding the Osman Sagar Lake. Accordingly, the proponent proposed layout of the project.

The proponent submitted Structural stability certificate dt.01.06.2022 proposed Residential Villas construction project with G + 2 Floors & Amenities G + 2 Floors situated at Sy. Nos. 369, 377, 380, 381, 382, Manchirevula, Gandipet (M), Rangareddy District. The structure is reinforced concrete framed structure with RCC wall and slab system for its residential floors and is complying with the Bureau of Indian Standard norms and design is safe and suitable for the purpose for which it is intended. It has been designed in accordance with IS: 456 and IS: 875 and the structure falls under seismic zone II as per seismic code IS: 1893 (Part-1)-2016, the design has been done for same and shall be detailed accordingly.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 1,35,776.0 Sq.m.; Out of which green area is 16,986.0 Sq.m. (12.5%)

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It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 1,16,347.2 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Villas Construction Project to accommodate 146 no. of units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential villas (G + 2 floors) & Amenities (G + 2 Floors).

It is also noted that adequate Parking area will be provided in each Villa for 2 parking spaces.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 300.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 303.87 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 6.53 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs. 14.13 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs. 49.39 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit Certified Compliance Report issued by the Regional office of MoEF&CC, GoI, as per O.M. dt. 08.06.2022 of the MoEF&CC, GoI.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Abdul Raheem and Smt. V. Bhavani of M/s. M/s. EPTRI Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 4.95 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the average thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as above 8.0m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report submitted by the project proponent.

It is proposed to mine 99,000 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Kottapally (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.45 km from the boundary of the sand reach.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 24.75 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.40 Lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the SEAC observed from the google map/KML file and latest satellite image that presently, water exists in the proposed sand reach and hence the application cannot be considered as in stream/underwater mining is not allowed.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for rejection of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Abdul Raheem and Smt. V. Bhavani of M/s. M/s. EPTRI Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 4.85 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan &EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the average thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as above 8.0m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report submitted by the project proponent.

It is proposed to mine 97,004 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Ambatipally (V) which is existing at a distance of 2.15 km & Singaram RF @ 1.85 km exists from the boundary of the sand reach.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 24.25 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.40 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC noted that the proponent submitted Joint Inspection Report for the investigations carried out on 27.11.2019 which is very old.

Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit latest Joint Inspection Report.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 4.40 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the average thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as above 8.0m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report submitted by the project proponent.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 4.20 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the average thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as above 8.0m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report submitted by the project proponent.

It is proposed to mine 84,982 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Peddampeta (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.20 km & Singaram RF @ 1.5 km exists from the boundary of the sand reach.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 21.24 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.376 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC noted that the proponent submitted Joint Inspection Report for the investigations carried out on 27.11.2019 which is very old.

Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit latest Joint Inspection Report.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

Agenda Item No. 10	2.00 Ha. Road Metal & Building Stone of M/s. Shreyan Reddy Stone Crusher and Rock Sand, Survey No: 683, Chillapur Village, Dubbak Mandal, Siddipet District. - TOR/ Violation - Reg.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Durga Reddy and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 25.05.2009 in favour of Sri. C.Venkat Reddy for a period upto 24.05.2019. Then, the lease was transferred on 02.12.2015 in favour of Sri. Pandi Swamy. Later, Extension of quarry lease was granted on 24.05.2019 for a period upto 23.05.2024. Then, again the lease was transferred on 20.06.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period upto 23.05.2024. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 77,041 m³/annum of Road metal and Building Stone. The proponent continued mining operations even after 24.05.2017, as per lr. dt.21.04.2022 of ADMG, Siddipet District, without obtaining prior EC.

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Nearest human habitation is Harijanwada exists at a distance of 1.20 km; Nearest water body exists at a distance of 0.30 km; Nearest RF is Chikod RF exists at 0.43 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit final EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri V.N.V.R.M Suresh and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was granted (in-principle) on 09.02.2022 in favour M/s. Sri Gayatri Minings for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted after 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is applicable to the project. Accordingly, proponent has submitted cluster letter dt. 12.04.2022 of ADMG, Nalgonda district stating that there are no quarry leases existings within 500 Mts of the proposed mine area. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 14.652 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan.

The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 25,002 m³/annum of Black granite.

Nearest human habitation is Narboyangudem @ 650 m; Nearest water body exists at 210 m from the mine lease area.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" and undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri J. Anjaiah and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier they obtained EC vide order dt. 12.08.2013 from the SEIAA, AP for mining 3600 m³/annum of Colour Granite with validity of 9 years i.e upto 11.08.2022. It was informed that they also obtained CFO vide order dt.26.08.2017 valid upto 31.08.2022 for the project. It was informed that earlier, reserves were estimated/shown very less in the Approved Mining Plan for 7 years due to which even the EC was issued with validity of 9 years only.

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Now, the proponent applied for Extension of EC on 30.07.2022 i.e within the validity period of earlier EC. Hence, it was requested to issue the extension of EC for the balance lease period i.e 25.11.2023 or life of mine 7 years.

As per old APM life of mine was 9 years. But mineral was extracted less than the permitted quantity in EC. Subsequently, the proponent informed that as per the Approved Mining Plan the total reserves are 4,20,800 m³/annum and the life of mine is 7 years. The proponent proposed to extract with the same mining capacity as permitted in the EC. Hence it was requested to issue extension of EC considering latest AMP.

The SEAC noted that as per latest Approved Mining Plan, the average annual production is 18,000 m³/annum and geological reserves are 4,20,800 m³/annum and life of mine is 7 years.

The proponent submitted a copy of letter dt.29.07.2022 of the ADMG: Karimnagar District furnishing the details of year-wise production & dispatch permits for the period from 2013-14 to 2022-23 (upto 27.07.2022). The SEAC observed from the letter that the production was carried out & dispatch permits were issued for the period from 2014-15 to 2016-17 & from 2018-19 to 2021-22 and no production was carried out & dispatch permits were issued during 2013-14; 2017-18 & 2022-23 (upto 27.07.2022).

The proponent informed that they have done CSR activities in the nearest village and submitted a copy of Certificate dt.23.02.2022 issued by the Head Master of ZPHS Elagandal (V), Kothapally (M), Karimnagar District informing that the proponent has donated Rs. 7,600 for Carpets and Rs. 10,000 for snacks for 10th class students during the study hours and also donated for white washing of the school building.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Extension of Validity of EC.
