Recommendations of the SEAC on 06.10.2017:

The representatives of the proposed CETP project and NEERI, Nagpur have attended the meeting and presented their project proposal i.e., establishment of CETP for treatment of industrial effluents located along Yenamadurru drain in West Godavari District. Also requested for exemption from payment of processing charges as the project is Government project and intended for cleaning up of important water body i.e., Yenamadduru drain.

The Committee noted that the proposed project falls under Item No. 7(h) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006- Common Effluent Treatment Plants (CETPs).

The noted that that the Government of Andhra Pradesh has given top priority for control of pollution of Yenamadurru drain and other drains joining to Yenamadurru drain to restore the water quality to permissible levels. The APPCB awarded study to National Environmental Engineering Researach Institute (NEERI), Nagpur to carry out a detailed study on pollution of Yenamadurru drain and submitted a report for establishment of CETP for treatment of industrial effluents located along Yenamadurru drain in West Godavari District.

The Committee recommended for exemption from the payment of processing charges as the proposed CETP is put forward by the State Government of A.P.. The Committee also recommended for issue of Standard Terms of Reference (TOR) with exemption of Public Hearing for the proposed Yanamadduru CETP -35 MLD (Phase -I-25 MLD, Phase -II-10 MLD).

Decision of SEIAA: Agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC for issue of TOR with exemption of Public hearing.
