The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

The representative of the project proponent Sri V.Ramachandra Reddy and Sri Rajesh Mankar of M/s. Vison Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 2,51,007.0 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 25,120.0 Sq.m. (10.01%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 1,49,936.58 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Villas Construction Project to accommodate 558 no. of units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Villas (G + 1 Floor).

It was informed that one car Parking space will be provided in each Villa.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 177.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.265 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs.60 lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P.Chandra Shekar and Sri Rajesh Mankar of M/s. Vison Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 5766.77 Sq.m., and Net site area is 5,725.86 Sq.m. Out of which green area is 625.00 Sq.m. (10.92%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 33,113.88 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 420 no. of units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Apartment (3S + 12 Upper Floors) including Amenities area in 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Floors.

It is also noted that parking area to be provided is 6708.96 Sq.m. (25.41 % against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 35.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.35 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs.10 lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri V. Sriman Narayana and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. AmplEnviron Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 17.06.2020 in favour of proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is applicable to the project. However, the SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 12.0 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The SEAC noted that Auto-TOR dt. 01.09.2022 was issued by the SEIAA, TS for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 22.07.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing that the issues are: greenbelt development, dumping waste within mine lease area and implement EMP measures. The proponent reported that they have allocated Rs. 4.2 Lakhs towards budget for CER/CSR. It was further reported that they have allocated Rs. 13.0 Lakhs budget towards implementation of EMP measures.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 22.09.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District furnishing the details of status of mining activity. It was reported in the letter that the Royalty Inspector inspected the area and reported that, "at the time of inspection the LOI issued area is under non working condition".

The nearest village Madharm (V) exists at a distance 0.57 km (SW); nearest water body i.e Bapanna cheruvu & Mantri kunta exists at a distance of 110 m; Nearest RF is Kazipally RF exists at 0.96 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 6,50,000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum (Average production) of Rough Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 10 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 125.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 13.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.4 Lakhs/annum.

After details discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Pradeep Kumar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 11.08.2004 in favour of M/s. Sri Sailaja Exports (P) Ltd for a period of 20 years. The SEIAA issued EC videw order dt.10.07.2013 in favour of M/s. Sri Sailaja Exports (P) Ltd. for mining of Black Granite @ 1,485 m<sup>3</sup>/annum. Later, the lease was transferred on 27.09.2018 in favour of the proponent for a period upto 10.08.2024. Accordingly, the EC was also transfered vide order dt.11.10.2021 in favour of the proponent. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.13 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

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It was informed that proponent obtained CFO vide order dt. 18.09.2015 and operating the mine. Now, the project proponent proposed expansion of the project and submitted proposal for expansion.

The proponent also submitted Certified Complaine report dt. 04.05.2022 issued by the IRO, MoEF&CC, GoI, Hyderabad.

The nearest village Tigelaveni (V) exists at a distance 326 m (S); nearest water body i.e canal exists at a distance of 275 m (W); Nearest RF is Nayakpalli RF exists at 230 m from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 11,129.81 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 6 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 55.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.71 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.07 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 06.08.2022 of ADMG, Mahabubabad District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period from 2013-14 to 2022-23. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2013-14 to 2022-23 (upto 31.07.2022).


The project proponent informed that they have obtained 8 No of oxygen concentraters to the District hospital and submitted a copy of press clipping in News paper. It was also informed that they have undertaken following activities:

- Scholarships to students
- Appointment of school teachers
- Providing clean drinking water facility for the surrounding villages
- Donation of mineral water plant in the girls hostel located at kothagudem, gundur mandal, mahbubabad District.
- Providing bus stop shelter
- Undertaking haritha haram work in Gudur Mandal
- Donated considerable amount for development of children park at mahabubabad.
- Play ground area for school going children
- Land for power sub-station installation
- Renovation of temples.
- Construction of new temple of Goddess Durga in Balya Nayak Thand, Teegalaveni Village, Gudur Mandal.
- Major contribution in setting up of Junior college in Kesamudram Town
- Donated Oxygen concentraters to the District Administration During the pandemic
- Provided COVID vaccination to the people of villages located in and around our mine site.
- Donated ambulance to the district administration.
- Donated land over an extent of 3.37 acres for Ekalavya Hostel situated at Teegalaveni Village, Gudur Mandal.
- Distribution of food grains and ration to needy pandemic lock down.

After details discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Aravind Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

  
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The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted on 05.03.2007 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years (i.e., upto 04.03.2017). Later, the lease was extended on 30.07.2018 in favour of the proponent for a period upto 04.03.2022. Subsequently, 1<sup>st</sup> renewal of lease was granted (In-principle) on 26.05.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.5 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. But, since it is a violation project, it is considered as B1 category. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 2,23,258.0 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Stone & Metal quarry. The proponent continued mining operations even after 2017 without obtained EC as per Ir. dt. 01.09.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District even after 2017 without obtaining EC.

Nearest human habitation is Khazipalli (V) exists at 1.26 km (SE); Nearest water body i.e Small water pond (Cheruvu) exists at 59 m (S) and nearest RF is Khazipalli RF exists at a distance of 150 m from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from March - May 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Building Stone and Road Metal Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from March - May 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit final EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

<b>Proposal No.</b>	<b>SIA/TG/MIN/402992/2022 (TOR Violation)</b>

The representative of the project proponent Sri G.Madhava Reddy and Sri D.Sreekanth of M//s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted on 29.09.2015 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years (i.e., lease upto 30.10.2025). It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Ir dt. 30.06.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy district stating that there are two quarry leases existing within 500 mts from the proposed quarry. Out of two quarry leases one lease (4.0 Ha. - lease granted before 09.09.2013) remaining one lease ( 4.83 Ha. – lease granted after 09.09.2013). The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.87 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 12.7 Ha. and Net cluster area is 8.7 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 78,120 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Stone & Metal and 50,034 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Gravel/Morrum. The proponent started mining operations from the year 2015 without obtaining EC, as per Ir. dt. 30.06.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District.

Nearest human habitation is Indranagar (V) @ 1.23 km (W); Nearest water body near Indranagar exists at 1.71 km (SW) and nearest RF is Elakcharla RF exists at a distance of 8.6 Km (W) from the mine lease area.

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The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from October - December 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Building Stone and Road Metal Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from October - December 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report, considering the baseline data from October - December 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O. No. 804 (E), dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt. 28.01.2022 and the proponent is informed to undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Uma Shanker Phani and Sri Deshpande of M/s. Anacon Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., Nagpur attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed that the industry has obtained EC vide order dt.24.08.2009 from the MoEF&CC for manufacturing production quantity of 150 KLPD grain based distillery to manufacture RS/ENA/Ethanol and 6.5 MW power plant in the name of M/s. Shasta Bio-fuels Pvt Ltd. Subsequently, obtained transfer of EC vide order dt. 29.07.2019 from MoEF&CC for name change from M/s. Shasta Bio-fuels Pvt Ltd., to M/s. Allied Blenders and Distillers Private Limited. The proponent obtained CFO vide order dt.24.03.2021 from TSPCB and operating the unit.

Now, the project proponent proposed expansion of the project from 150 KLPD to 180 KLPD grain based distillery along with existing 6.5 MW Power plant and hence requested to issue for expansion of EC.

The proponent also submitted certified compliance report on EC conditions vide lr.dt.08.09.2022 Issued by IRO of MoEF&CC, GoI, Hyderabad; and also submitted Certified compliance report on CFO conditions vide lr.dt.08.08.2022 of RO: Hyderabad of TSPCB.

The SEAC noted that, the SEIAA, TS has issued TORs (Auto generated) dt.23.06.2022 for expansion project. Accordingly, the project proponent submitted EIA report. The SEAC noted that Public hearing was already conducted on 27.06.2009 at the time of initial EC. Hence, the project is exempted from process of Public hearing for expansion proposal as per provisions of para 7 (ii) of EIA Notification & its amendments.

The SEAC noted the contents of the EIA report and noted the details of the project after proposed Expansion as follows:

Total area is Acres 30.0, out of which Green area is Acres 10.81 (36.03%).

Nearest human habitation is Rangapur (V) @ 1.9 km (SE); Nearest water body is Krishna river @ 0.8 km (NE); No RF falls within 10km radius from the project site.

The SEAC noted the EMP measures proposed by the project proponent.



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Project Cost for proposed project after expansion is Rs. 302.60 Crores. Budget for Environmental protection towards Capital Cost is Rs.11.01 Crores and Recurring Cost is Rs. 17.03 Crores/annum. Budget for CER is Rs. 241.37 is already spent during 2016-17 to 2021-22.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that the treatment facilities proposed by the project proponent in proposed expansion are insufficient. Further, the greenbelt proposed in the layout map is not adequate. The SEAC also observed that the proponent submitted details of CER activities already spent but not submitted details of CER activities in proposed expansion. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit the following:

- Details of water balance i.e water consumption & effluent generation, adequate treatment systems with disposal option.
- Details of solid waste generation & its disposal.
- Details of proposed CER activities.
- Details of greenbelt alongwith site layout plan earmarking the same.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri CH. Venkata Ramanaiah and Sri Mohan Reddy of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted on 26.11.2007 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years (i.e., upto 25.11.2017). Later, 1<sup>st</sup> renewal of the lease was granted (in-principle) on 13.06.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. But, since it is a violation project, it is considered as B1 Category. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 1,24,404.8 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal mine. The proponent continued mining operations even after 25.11.2017 without obtaining EC as per Ir. dt. 06.08.2022 of ADMG, Suryapet District.

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Nearest human habitation is Lakmavaram (V) exists at 0.70 km (NNE); Nearest water body i.e Unnamed water body exists at 80 m (W) and There is no RF exists within 10 km radius from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

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The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 21.12.2015 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Ir dt. 06.08.2022 of ADMG, Suryapet district stating that there is one quarry lease (2.00 Ha. – lease granted before 09.09.2013) existing within 500 mts from the proposed quarry. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.50 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 4.5 Ha. and Net cluster area is 2.5 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. But, since it is a violation project, it is considered as B1 Category. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The nearest village Sarvesharapuram (V) exists at a distance of 0.78 km (W); nearest water body i.e Kapugallu pond exists at 1.70 km (W) and Nearest RF Balusupadu RF exists at a distance of 3.0 km (E) from the boundary of the site.

The proponent submitted a copy of Ir. dt.06.08.2022 of ADMG, Suryapet District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2015-16 to 2022-2023 (upto 13.07.2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2017-18 to 2022-2023 (upto 13.07.2022). The SEAC noted that project proponent started mining operations without obtaining prior EC.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

During presentation, the SEAC observed from Google Image that a water body exists on East side adjacent to the mine lease area within 50m. Hence, the project cannot be considered for TOR.

In view of the above and after details discussed, the SEAC recommended for Rejection of TOR proposal.

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 1,56,680.00 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments and Commercial Area with Multiplex. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Apartments with towers A & B (3C + G + 26 floors) to accommodate 197 units. (3BHK: 96, 4BHK: 94 and Pent house: 7 No's) and Commercial area with Multiplex (3C + G + 5 floors).

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Auto generated) on 23.06.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded online.

The proponent informed that they have obtained NOCs (2 nos.) dt. 14.06.2022 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted copies of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 584.9 mts AMSL & the permissible top elevation is restricted to 792.48 mts AMSL for Blocks A to J. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

During presentation the proponent informed that at present there are temporary Storage Sheds existing in the site, which will be dismantled and the present project will be takenup.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 39,492.86 Sq.m., and Net plot area is 38,749.53 Sq.m.; Out of which green area is 3,874.95 Sq.m. (10.01%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 5,56,021.18 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartment Project to accommodate 1089 flats. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Block (A to I) – (4B+S+50 floors); Block J- (4B+S+54 floors) & Amenities – (4B+G+4 floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided for Towers is 1,40,458.62 Sq.m. (33.79 % against required 22%).



It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2017-18 to 2022-23 (upto 30.09.2022). It was reported that "As per this office records there is a stock of about 1300MT of Raw material as on 30.06.2022 as per the returns submitted by the lessee which was utilized in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter. There is no production from 01.07.2022".

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri R.P.Yeshudasu and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA in its meeting held on 23.09.2022 and noted that the ADMG, Nizamabad vide lr. dt. 10.05.2022 informed that one quarry lease i.e M/s. Kurapa Metal works, Sy.No. 758/13 of Jankampet (V), Yedapally (M), Nizamabad District is existing within the radius 500m of the proposed mine having mine lease dt. 05.11.2015, but the lease area of M/s. Kurapa Metal works details were not mentioned. Hence, it is referred back the project to SEAC to ascertain the cluster applicability.

The SEAC noted the decision of the SEIAA. In this regard, the project proponent again submitted lr dt. 10.05.2022, ADMG, Nizamabad informing that "M/s. Tecdatum Info services private Limited has informed that, there is one quarry lease is existing within the radius of 500 mtrs i.e. Quarry lease for Building stone & Road metal over an extent of 5.00 Hectares in Sy.No. 758/13 of Jankampet Village, Yedapally Mandal, Nizamabad District held by M/s. Kurapa Metal Works".

It is also observed from the letter that the lease was executed on 10.02.2014 with lease period from 10.02.2014. In this regard, the project proponent informed that earlier, 1.0 Ha. of Building stone and Road metal quarry was transferred in favour of M/s. Karunya Metal works from Sri. P. Satyanarayana for un-expired period of lease upto 25.07.2021 vide proceedings dt.29.04.2007 of DDMG: Nizamabad. The project proponent also informed that another quarry lease of 4.0 Ha. of Building stone and Road metal was granted in favour of M/s. Karunya Metal works for a period of 15 years w.e.f 20.10.2009 to 19.10.2024, vide proceedings dt.20.10.2009 of ADMG: Nizamabad. Subsequently, the ADMG: Nizamabad vide procds dt.07.11.2013 issued work orders for execution of Amalgamation of quarry leases of 5.0 Ha. (1.0 Ha. + 4.0 Ha.) for unexpired period with co-termination on 25.07.2021. Later, the above quarry lease of 5.0 Ha. was transferred from M/s. Karunya Metal works to M/s. Krupa Metal works vide proceedings dt.10.02.2014 for un-expired period.of lease upto 25.07.2021. Hence, it can be observed that the initial leases were granted before 09.09.2013 but transferred after 09.09.2013. Hence, the quarry of M/s. Krupa Metal works is not included in calculation of cluster. Thus, the total Cluster area is 9.5 Ha, but Net Cluster area is 4.5 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha.



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In view of the above, the SEAC again recommends the project for issue of TOR to direct the proponent to prepare EIA report, considering the baseline data from March to May 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit final EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

Earlier, the SEIAA in its meeting held on 29.09.2022 referred back the project to SEAC to ascertain the distance between the mine lease boundary and nearest water body as it is adjacent to mine lease area as per Google map.

The SEAC noted the decision of SEIAA and informed the proponent to attend the next upcoming meeting along with clarification on issue raised by the SEIAA along with supporting documents.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The SEAC deferred the project, as the proponent did not attend the meeting.

Hence, the SEAC decided to inform the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Purna Chander and Sri D.Sreekanth of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA in its meeting held on 23.09.2022 noted that the quarry lease was granted on 18.06.2007 for a period of 10 years i.e expired on 21.06.2017. After the expiry of the initial mine lease, the continuity of the mining activity shall be treated as violation. Hence, the issue is referred back to SEAC to ascertain the facts about the status of violation.

The SEAC observed that the project proponent continued mining operations even after 2017 without obtaining prior EC, as per lr.dt.12.10.2022 of ADMG: Sangareddy district.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from October - December 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Stone and Metal. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from October - December 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O. No. 804 (E), dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt. 28.01.2022 and the proponent is informed to undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.
