Agenda Item No.-1

SAI City and Assorita Commercial Complex at Musatafapur, Phulwari, Patna (Bihar) by M/s Annuanand Constrution Pvt. Ltd., at Musatafapur, Phulwari, Patna (Bihar), Total Plot Area:- 35,468 m² Total Built-up Area:- 1,75,420.772 m². (Proposal No. - SIA/8(b)/604/19) Online Proposal No.:- SIA/BR/NCP/30736/2017).

From the perusal of the minutes of previous meetings of SEAC i.e. on 25-01-2019 & 26-02-2019 followings have been observed -

- The ToR to the project was issued vide F. No. 21-1/2018-IA-III, dated 27-02-2018 by the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India, New Delhi.
- Final EIA report submitted by Project Proponent to SEIAA, Bihar dated 16-01-2019 for grant of Environmental Clearance.
- The deficiencies found by SEAC and asked to submit corrected / required documents / Maps / Plan / Sketches etc. has been complied by the Project Proponent.
- The SEAC in its sitting of 26th February, 2019 has recommended the project for Environmental Clearance.

In the light of above recommendation of SEAC, SEIAA resolved to grant the Environmental Clearance.

Agenda Item No.-2

Proposed Additional Storage Facilities 2x600 MT Mounded storage vessel at Fatuha Industrial Area, Mauza- Raipura, Fathua Patna, Bihar-803201. BPCL (Proposal No.:- SIA/6(b)/533/18) Online Proposal No.:- SIA/BR/IND2/25643/2018.

In its sitting of 31-08-2018 the SEAC had recommended the ToR to the project. ToR was issued by SEIAA on 24.10.2018 and Final EIA report was received on 07-02-2019 from the Project Proponent. In its meeting of 26-02-2018 SEAC has recommended the proposal for grant of Environmental Clearance.

After considering the proposal and recommendation of SEAC, the SEIAA resolved to grant Environmental Clearance to the project.

Agenda Item No.-3

"KUNDAGHAT RESERVOIR SCHEME", Village:-Sikandra, Block:- Sikandra, Block:-Sikandra, District:- Jamui, State:- Bihar, (Proposal No. - SIA/1(c)/428/17). Online Proposal No.:- SIA/BR/RIV/26099/2016).

The Proposal has been appraised by the SEAC and after discussing the proposal in its sitting of 25-01-2019 and 26-02-2019 SEAC recommended for Terms of Reference applicable as in violation case under the provision of Notification S.O. 1030 (E) dated 08-03-2018 with all usual Terms and Conditions. The SEIAA resolves to grant Terms of Reference after due discussion.

Agenda Item No.-4

Expansion of Re-Rolling mill Production of MS Bar & TMT Bar from 60,590 TPA to 2,50,000 TPA, Village - Simli Malapur, Mahatama Gandhi Setu Road, Pahari, District - Patna, Bihar (Proposal No. - SIA/3(a)/540/18, Online Proposal No.:- SIA/BR/IND/25215/2018).

The project was monitored by the authorities of MoEF&CC, Regional office, Ranchi on 20-02-2018 and was found running beyond approved production level during the year 2014-2016 together with several other violations of Environmental Clearance granted to them on 02-06-2009 by the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

The Project Proponent has now proposed to expand its production from 60,590 to 2,50,000 TPA. The SEAC in its 4 sittings of dated 8/9th October, 2018, 26th & 27th November, 2018, 7th & 8th December, 2018 and 26th February, 2019 has discussed the proposal for grant of ToR. Members of SEAC have inspected the mill premises on 01-12-2018 and found continued violations of several Environmental Clearance conditions. The Project Proponent was directed on 7th/8th December, 2018 to strictly maintain its approved production for which Environmental Clearance was granted (60,590 TPA) to them. The SEAC observed that the proposal is not acceptable in its present condition for expansion due to lack of space, very poor ventilation inside the mill, and other several violations, however proposal could be considered if Project Proponent submit a decelerated on oath within a month that they have complied with the conditions of Environmental Clearance granted to them and also maintain the compliances. After receipt of deceleration that the Project Proponent has submitted vide their letter, dated 14-01-2019, the SEAC has considered the proposal in its sitting of 26-02-2019 and found revised proposal in order. In its revised proposal the Project Proponent has proposed expansion of project area from 7.47 acres to 8.03 acres, including increase in area of green-belt development. After discussing the proposal the SEAC has recommended ToR.

The SEIAA after discussion resolves to defer the consideration of issuance of ToR till a comprehensive presentation on level of production in last 5 years, together with status of compliance of Environmental Clearance conditions, and supporting facts & figures to confirm present level of production as has been given in their deceleration of dated 14-01-2019 is not presented by the Project Proponent. The above said supporting facts may include -

- (a) Comparative chart of monthly power consumption,
- (b) Employment of labour + supervising staff / officers / others per month.
- (c) Consumption of raw material / annum.
- (d) Production / sale - per month / annum and balance available presently within mill premises / outside mill premises.
- (e) Others if any

The SEIAA decided to visit the mill premises after above said presentation if need be arise.

The SEAC in its 2 sitting of dated 28-12-2018 and 25-01-2019 has discussed the proposal and recommended ToR as applicable in violation cases under the provisions of Notification S.O. 1030(E) dated 08-03-2018 with all usual Terms and Conditions. Members of SEAC too have visited the site on 28-12-2018 and found several violations by the Project Proponent.

The SEIAA resolved to grant Terms of Reference after due discussion.

Stone Mining project at Village:- Madurna, Thana:- Bhabua, District:- Kaimur, State:- Bihar (Proposal No. - SIA/1(a)/535/18). Online Proposal No.:- SIA/BR/MIN/30809/2019).

The SEIAA observed that -

- (a) The location of the proposed mine plot falls within 5 Km distance from "Kaimur Wildlife Sanctuary" requiring appraisal of the project as category 'A' at central level as required by corrigendum Notification issued by S.O. 1939 (E), dated 13-11-2006 and further substituted by the Amendment Notification issued by S.O. 3067 (E), dated 01-12-2009 and S.O. 1599 (E), dated 25-06-2014 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India, New Delhi.


- (b) Final Notification for Eco-Sensitive Zone of the said Sanctuary has been published by MoEF&CC, Govt. of India, New Delhi vide their Notification S.O. 3549 (E), dated 30-12-2015 prohibiting / Regulating Stone quarry, crushing units, commercial mining etc as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 04-08-2006 in the matter of T. N. Godavarman Vs Union of India in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and order dated 21-04-2014 in the matter of Goa Foundation Vs Union of India in WP (C) No. 435 of 2012.
- (c) As mentioned in notification of Eco-Sensitive Zone the boundary of Eco-Sensitive Zone has been appended with the Notification, which describes boundary in terms of Geo-Coordinates however the same requires verification with authentic maps; and possibly may require confirmation of the Environment, Forest & Climate Change Deptt. of the State.


