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**I. TABLE AGENDA: SEAC-Sub Committee Report on Issues related to Mining Projects
(Major Minerals).**

- The issue was examined by the SEAC,A.P in its meeting held on 26.08.2016 . The Committee observed the following:

95.24.02: Issues related to Mining Projects (Major Minerals):

The Project Proponents presenting their cases before the SEAC for appraisal. During their presentations, the project proponents requesting for certain exemptions/clarifications on EIA/Public hearings etc. for category 'B' projects of Mining Projects (Major Minerals).

The Committee after detailed discussions, recommended to constitute a SEAC-SUB-COMMITTEE (Mining) with members: 1.Prof.K.Kameswara(convener), 2. Sri.V.Veda Kumar, 3. Prof. P.Jagannadha Rao, 4. Sri.P.V.Padmanabham 5.Prof.Sandeep Pro.Y.V.Rao.

This Sub Committee is requested to make a study on the procedure followed by the SEIAA,A.P so far while appraising cases of Mining Projects (Major Minerals) with respect to TORs(Terms of References), EIA Studies and Env.Public hearings, Environmental Aspects etc., with extent of Mine Lease Area (MLA). Also to study the various present MoEF&CC Notifications& O.Ms , Mines & Geology Dept, Government (GoI&GoAP) Rules & Regulations of Major Minerals for EC & TOR. as well as other environmental aspects. All these issues have to be summarized with remarks. The Sub Committee (MIN) is requested to submit the REPORT to the Chairman, SEAC, A.P within 2 weeks positively.

- The issue was examined by the SEIAA,A.P in its meeting held on 15.09.2016 and the Authority agreed with the recommendation of SEAC on constitution of SEAC subcommittee.
- The SEAC –subcommittee, A.P has submitted the REPORT to the Chairman, SEAC,A.P during this meeting on 01.12.2016 and the SEAC.A.P has recommended to accept the REPORT.

RECOMMENDATIONS of the SEAC-subcommittee on MINING PROJECTS (excluding minor mineral) :

- All Non-coal mining projects (Excluding Minor minerals) with lease areas ≤ 5 ha shall apply directly under B2 category and upload in the MoEFCC AP State portal, and such projects shall be appraised by the APSEAC/APSEIAA.
- All Non-coal mining projects (Excluding Minor Minerals) with lease areas between > 5 ha and up to 25 ha shall apply online to the MoEFCC AP State Portal and the project shall be categorized as B1 or B2, at the time of appraisal and with such conditions that the committee deems fit to the given environmental conditions of the proposed project.
- All Non-coal mining projects (Excluding Minor Minerals) with lease areas between 25 ha and up to 50 ha shall apply online to the MoEFCC AP State Portal under category B1 with standard TOR.
