The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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Agenda Item No. 01	14.50 Ha. Quartz Mine of M/s. BHARGAVA MINERALS, Survey Number 580, Redla Repaka village, Valigonda Mandal, Yadadri-Bhongiri District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/401793/2022 (TOR)

The representative of the project proponent Sri T. Rajender Reddy and Sri M. Venkatesham of M/s. Global Enviro labs, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was granted (in-principle) in favour of the proponent on 14.06.2018 for a period of 20 years. The SEAC noted that the lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent also submitted copy of cluster lr. dt. 20.06.2019 of ADMG, Yadadri - Bhuvanagiri informing that there are no leases existing within 500 mts from proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 14.50 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan. It was informed that it is proposed to mine 96,000 TPA of Quartz.

Nearest human habitation is Redla Repaka (V) @ 1.6 km; Nearest water body i.e Musi river exists at 5.2 km (N) from the mine lease area.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" and the proponent is informed to undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri B. Saida Rao and Sri M. Venkatesham of M/s. Global Enviro labs, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 24.09.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to acquire additional land near the mine lease area for compensatory Afforestation along with land documents for the same.

Accordingly, the project proponent informed that they will develop greenbelt in their partner's land over an extent of Ac. 1.39 in Sy.No. 149 located adjacent to the mine lease area as compensatory afforestation and submitted copies of land documents and Partnership deed.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Satyanarayana and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the project proponent informed the following:

- We have applied for the Environmental Clearance our proposal was considered in the SEAC meeting held on 14.03.2022 and recommended for grant of Environmental Clearance.
- In SEIAA meeting held on 01.04.2022 the SEIAA has noted that in principal grant was obtained on 26.07.2016, hence directed to submit the status of mining activity duly certified by the ADMG.

- We were unable to login in the Parvesh Portal, we have communicated same to NIC due to no proper response from them we are uploaded as a new proposal.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 26.07.2016 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 04.03.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. It was also informed that there are no quarrying operations, since it is fresh quarry lease application is under process. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.023 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 2.023 Ha. and Net cluster area is 2.023 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Feroziguda Hamlet which is existing at a distance of 0.35 km; nearest water body i.e., Shettipalli Cheruvu exists at 1.1 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 20,000 TPA of Quartz & 30,000 TPA of Feldspar and the life of mine is reported as 1.77 years for Quartz & 2.572 years for Feldspar.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.4 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC noted from the Lr.dt.04.03.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District, that "there are no quarrying operations since it is a fresh and quarry lease application is under process". The same was also mentioned in the minutes of SEAC meeting held on 14.03.2022.

In view of the above, and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Rajesh and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 6,652.33 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 702 Sq.m. (10.6%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 35,654.49 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartment Building Project to accommodate 220 flats. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are C + S + 10 Floors (including 2 TDR floors and Amenities area).

It is also noted that parking area to be provided is 9,132.02 Sq.m. (34.43 % against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 45 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 62.0 Lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 11.0 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

In view of the above, the SEAC decided to return the proposal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Divakar Reddy and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that, earlier, the DEIAA, Warangal Urban District issued EC vide order dt.29.07.2017 to mine 40,925 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal with life of mine of 5 years only. The validity period was not mentioned in the EC Order. However, considering life of mine of 5 years, the project proponent uploaded the proposal afresh.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 30.03.2016 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years i.e upto 29.03.2026. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent also submitted copy of cluster lr. dt.01.10.2022 of ADMG, Hanumakonda informing that there are no leases existing within 500 mts from proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.00 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Gatlanarsingapur (V) exists at a distance of 1.5 km; nearest water body i.e unknown water body at a distance of 480 mts (N) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 30,170.4 m³/annum (Average Production) of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 26 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 9.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.51 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.01.10.2022 of ADMG, Hanumakonda District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2017-18 to 2022-2023 (upto September 2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2017-18 to 2022-2023 (upto 30.09.2022).

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.15.12.2017 & dt. 25.05.2018 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Bheemadevarapally (V & M), Hanmakonda District stating that the proponent has donated material of worth Rs 20,000/- & Rs. 25,000/- for developmental activities in the village.

The SEAC informed the proponent to submit production details, dispatch particulars, status of quarry upto 28.07.2022 & after 28.07.2022 till date duly certified by the mining department.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

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The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 31.10.2002 in favour of Smt. M. Hanumayamma the proponent for a period of 20 years i.e upto 30.10.2022. Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt.31.12.2015 with a capacity to mine Quartz @ 35,000 TPA & Feldspar @ 4,368 TPA in the name of Smt. M. Hanumayamma (Sri B. Karthik Reddy being GPA Holder) with validity of 6 years. Subsequently, the lease was transferred to project proponent on 08.05.2017 for un-expired portion of lease and Renewal of LOI was issued on 25.04.2022. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.42 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Melargudur (V) exists at a distance of 136 mts (N); nearest water body i.e Unknown water body at a distance of 1.625 km (E) from the mine lease area and nearest Reserve Forest at a distance of 1.93 km (E).

It is proposed to mine 23,590.20 Tons/annum of Quartz, 39,317.0 Tons/annum of Feldspar and the life of mine is reported as 5 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.55 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.8 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of certificate dt.28.03.2017 of Lease transfer order in favour of M/s. S.K.R. Mines and minerals. But, EC was not transferred in favour of proponent.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.26.09.2022 issued by the Head Master, MPPS Ammaipally, Annojiguda (V), Kandukur (M), Sangareddy District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 25,000/- for developmental of school.

During presentation, the SEAC noted that nearest habitation is located at 136m only. In this regard, the project proponent informed that no blasting operations are involved in mining. Hence, it was requested to consider their proposal as per the minimum distance criteria mentioned in order dt.21.07.2020 in OA No.304/2019 of Hon'ble NGT, New Delhi.

The SEAC informed the proponent to submit production details, dispatch particulars, status of quarry duly certified by Mining department.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 6.07 Ha. Which is more than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.17.10.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2007-08 to 2022-2023 (upto 12.10.2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 22.06.2007 (to 04.03.2008) to 2022-2023 (as on 12.10.2022).

The representative of the project proponent Sri Joshi and Sri D. Sreekanth of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC (expansion) vide order dt.09.04.2021 to produce MS Ingots / Billets and TMT Bars / Angles / Channels & Girders and other rolled products Secondary Metallurgical unit.

The industry obtained CFE vide order dt.28.07.2021. The industry proposed to include Galvanization Plant within the acquired land site so as add value to their products and also to meet 36.8% greenbelt development.

Subsequently, the industry obtained EC (Amendment) vide order dt.12.05.2022 and it was informed Galvanization plant as such do not require to obtain the prior EC as per the EIA notification dt.14.09.2006. Subsequently, when the project proponent approached TSPCB for CFE, the Board directed the project proponent to obtain amendment in EC. Hence, the proponent requested to issue EC (Amendment) with the following changes:

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Gopal and Sri S.N. Rao of M/s. Pragathi Labs & Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 26.11.1998 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years upto 25.11.2008. Later, the 1st renewal of lease was granted on 23.03.2009 for a period of 10 years upto 22.03.2019. Subsequently, the 2nd renewal of lease was granted on 20.05.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 0.75 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 Category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 7,200 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal. The proponent continued mining operations even after 22.03.2019 as per lr. dt. 25.05.2022 of ADMG, Peddapalli District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Bodaguttapalli @ 0.9 km; Nearest water body is SRSP canal exists at 0.29 km (E); Nearest RF is Nalaga Gutta RF exists at 1.4 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.
