The representative of the project proponent Sri A. Ravindra Babu and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s.Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed within 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, Puppalaguda (V) is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 19.07.2021 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 562.9 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 762.9 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI.

The project is proposed in a total plot area of 39,608.1 Sq.m., for construction of Residential Apartments with total built up area of 3,78,203.1 Sq.m.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from December, 2020 to February, 2021 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for Townships and Area Development projects.

The SEAC considered the request of the proponent. After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Townships and Area Development projects" considering baseline data from December, 2020 to February, 2021 and submit EIA report.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Rakesh Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that few trees exists in the site. In this regard, the proponent informed that the intervening trees will be translocated to the boundaries of the site.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 10,006.7 Sq.m., Net Plot area is 8,814.7 Sq.m; out of which green area is 900.9 Sq.m. (10.2%)

It was informed that the total built-up area of the project is 51,350.2 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments with 2C + G + 8 Floors to accommodate 156 units and Commercial Block with 2C + G + 5 Floors.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided for Residential is 9,522 Sq.m. (39% against required 22%) and Parking area to be provided for Commercial is 4,678.1 Sq.m. (36.6% against required 33%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 46.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 115.2 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 4.4 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs. 9.9 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs. 53.0 lakhs/annum during occupation phase, as per revised EMP Budget during presentation.

It is also noted that each Villa will be provided with 2 Parking spaces.

The total cost of the project is Rs.153.0 Crores. During presentation, the SEAC observed that few trees exists in the site. In this regard, the proponent informed that the intervening trees will be Retained or translocated to the boundaries of the site.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 88,314.0 Sq.m., out of which green area is 18,442.0 Sq.m. (20.9%).

It was informed that the total built-up area of the project is 77,885.2 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Villas (G + 2 Floors) to accommodate 129 units and Amenities (G + 2 Floors).

It is also noted that each Villa will be provided with 2 Parking spaces.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 167.0 Crores. **CHAIRMAN, SEAC**

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The SEAC noted that the proposal is for establishment of API - Bulk Drugs & Intermediates manufacturing unit.

The SEAC noted the G.O.Ms. No. 95, dt. 21.09.2007; G.O.Ms. No. 64, dt.25.07.2013 of the EFS&T Dept., GoAP & G.O.Ms. No. 24, dt.24.04.2019 of the EFS&T Dept., GoTS.

The SEAC examined the proposal as per the provisions laid under S.O.1223 (E), dt.27.03.2020 & S.O.3636 (E), dt.15.10.2020 & S.O.2859 (E), dt.16.07.2021 and considered the project under B2 Category.

The SEAC noted the contents of EMP report and noted the details of the project as follows:

Total area is 3.65 Acres, out of which Green area is 1.22 Acres (33.42%).

Nearest human habitation is Singampalli (V) @ 0.55 km; Nearest water body @ 318 m (NW) as per Kml file; Nearest RF is Kalkunda RF @ 4.91 km from the industry.

The SEAC noted the EMP measures proposed by the project proponent.

Project Cost is Rs. 6.0 Crores. Budget for Environmental protection towards Capital Cost is Rs.212.4 Lakhs and Recurring Cost is Rs. 183.7 Lakhs/annum as per revised EMP Budget. Budget for CER is Rs. 15.0 lakhs in first 5 years.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 16.09.2021 informed the proponent to submit earlier production details certified by the Mining Department and CSR activities already implemented by the project proponent.

Now, the proponent submitted a copy of letter dt. 26.07.2021 of the ADMG: Karimnagar District furnishing the details of year-wise dispatch permits for the period from 2016-17 to 2020-21. The SEAC observed from the letter that the production quantity was carried out for the period from 2017-18 to 2020-21 and no production was carried during 2016-17.

The proponent also submitted a copy of letter dt. 21.09.2021 of the ADMG: Karimnagar District furnishing the details of year-wise dispatch permits for the period from 2013-14 to 2016-17. The SEAC observed from the letter that the production quantity was carried out during the period 2013-14 & 2015-16 and no production was carried out during 2014-15 & 2016-17.

The proponent informed that they have done CSR activities in the nearest village and submitted a copy of Certificate dt.22.09.2021 issued by the Headmaster of Mandal Paraja Parishad Secondary School (M.P.P.S), Banjerupally (V), Manakondur (M), Karimnagar District informing that the proponent has donated 4 Ceiling Fans an & 15 chairs of worth Rs.31,000/- to the School.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Extension of Validity of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Ravindran and Smt. G. Pallavi of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.



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The proponent informed that the 1<sup>st</sup> renewal quarry lease was granted on 24.06.2009 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Thus, cluster is not applicable to the project. However, the Proponent submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 06.07.2021 of ADMG, Mahabubabad District informing that there is one existing quarry lease (M/s. Srinivasa Granites – 1.00 Ha. - leases granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.619 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 2.619 Ha. and Net cluster is 1.619 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

Earlier, the SEIAA, AP (Combined State) issued EC vide order dt. 17.04.2013 for Black Granite with production quantity of 500 m<sup>3</sup>/annum. Subsequently, the proponent obtained CFO issued by TSPCB vide order dt. 23.02.2018.

Now, the proponent proposed to enhance the production capacity from 500 m<sup>3</sup>/annum to 5000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum and submitted EC application along with a copy of Certified Compliance report dt. 24.05.2021 & 04.10.2021 issued by the IRO of MoEF&CC, GoI, Hyderabad.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Ayyangaru Palli (V) which is existing at a distance of 366 m; nearest water body i.e., Beti Cheruvu exists at 230m (SW); Nearest RF i.e., Ingurthy RF exists at 286m from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 5,000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Black Granite and life of the mine is reported as 6 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.2 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.35 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of letter dt. 06.07.2021 of the ADMG: Mahabubabad District furnishing the details of year-wise dispatch permits for the period from 2003-04 to 2021-22 (up to 06.07.2021). The SEAC observed from the letter that the production quantity was carried out for the period from 2005-06 to 2008-09, 2013-14 & 2015-16 to 2021-22 (upto 06.07.2021). It was informed that no production was carried during 2003-04 to 2004-05, 2009-10 to 2012-13 & 2014-15.

The proponent informed that they have done CSR activities in the nearest village and submitted a copy of Certificate dt.09.10.2020 issued by the Sarpanch of Ingurthy (V), Kesamudram (M), Mahabubabad District informing that the proponent has donated Rs. 2.0 Lakhs towards development activities of Ingurthy Village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 11.10.2021 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 01.11.2021 of ADMG, Wanaparthy District informing that there are no existing quarries falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.86 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 4.86 Ha. and Net cluster is 4.86 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

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The nearest village to the proposed site is Talapnur Tanda which is existing at a distance of 1.0 km; nearest water body exists at 1.253 km (S) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 52,650 TPA of Quartz & 5,460 TPA of Feldspar and the life of mine is reported as 33 years for Quartz & 26 years for Feldspar.

The total cost of the project is Rs.50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 9.1 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.4 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Now, the proponent submitted a copy of letter dt. 29.09.2021 of the ADMG, Rangareddy District furnishing the details of year-wise dispatch permits for the period from 2004-05 to 2019-20 (up to 04.07.2019). The SEAC observed from the letter that the production quantity was carried out for the period from 2004-05 to 2008-09, 2013-14 to 2014-15 & 2016-17 to 2019-20 (upto 04.07.2019) and no production was carried during 2009-10 to 2012-13 & 2015-16.

The proponent also informed that they have done CSR activities in the nearest village and submitted a copy of Certificate dt. Nil issued by the Sarpanch of Nomula (V), Manchal (M), Rangareddy District informing that the proponent has donated Rs. 70,000/- towards for road repair works and Graveyard. The proponent also informed that they will develop Greenbelt in their own land over an extent of Ac.10.0 located adjacent to the Mine Lease area and submitted a copy of the documents.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.


