# Agenda:

Findings and recommendation of SEAC, Mizoram in regard to the project proposal – "Onshore Oil & Gas Exploration Drilling & Testing at Location MZ-9 under NELP Block MZ-ONN-2004/1 in Hnahthial District (erstwhile Lunglei) in the State of Mizoram".

#### Deliberation:

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members present and as requested, the Member Secretary highlighted the submissions and recommendations of SEAC, Mizoram as per the Minute of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of SEAC held on 09.10.2023. The meeting deliberated on the matter and made observations as follows:

- The Project proponent needs to incorporate changes / rectifications in Form A and B as
  per decisions taken in SEAC Meeting minutes dt. 09.10.2023. Further, the rectifications
  to be made by Project Proponent are to be supported with relevant documents which are
  to be uploaded in the PARIVESH Portal.
- 2. The Project proponent may provide information on the location of the project site with regard to distance from nearest human settlement and any study on the Environmental Impact due to Noise/Air/Water Pollution.
- The Project proponent may provide information / justification for selection of the current site for the project proposal and also give details of alternative sites explored or examined, if any.
- 4. The Project Proponent may provide Muck Disposal Plan.
- 5. The Project Proponent may furnish information / plan of disposal of burnt lube oil generated from genset and the list of registered vendors for collection of same.

In addition, the members also emphasized that the monitoring intervals for air, water, soil and noise quality monitoring should be fixed as per CPCB guidelines and other established norms. Also, the noise generated during operation phase should not exceed the permissible limits and should conform to the standards prescribed under the Noise pollution (Regulation & Control) Rules, 2000 to minimize the effects on the wildlife population of the area.
