The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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Agenda Item No. 01	1.00 Ha. Building Stone & Road Metal Mine of M/s. Narsing Rao Stone Crusher, Sy. No. 58/1, Someshwar (V), Banswada (M), Kamareddy District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/273163/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri B. Raj Gambhir Rao and Sri Chandrasekar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was initially granted (in-principle) on 07.01.1994 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years and subsequently, 1st renewal of the lease was granted on 04.08.2009 for a further period of 15 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.00 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Someshwar (V) which is existing at a distance of 221m (as per kml); nearest water body i.e., Durki Lake exists at 0.40 km (N); nearest RF i.e., Hajipur RF exists at 3.71 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 20,700 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 22 years (@20,000 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.77 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.12 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 15.02.2022 of ADMG, Kamareddy District furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2009-10 to 2021-22 (Upto February, 2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued out during the period 2009-10 to 2020-21 and no dispatch permits were issued during 2021-22 (Upto February, 2022).

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.17.12.2019 issued by the Sarpanch, Someshwar (V), Banswada (M), Kamareddy District stating that the proponent has supplied metal for BT road repair works, supplied soil for burial ground and nursery of worth about Rs.2,00,000/-.

The proponent also submitted an undertaking that they will develop plantation over an extent of 1.00 Acre with 1000 plants in their own patta land at Sy. No. 64/a, 64/aa, 64/e/1, Vasudevapalli (V), Banswada (M), Kamareddy District which is near to the mine lease area.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Sagar and Sri Chandrasekar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt. 07.12.2019 with Builtup area of 22,125.59 Sq.m. The proponent informed that earlier, they left 20 mts from ORR buffer instead of required 15.24 mts. Now, they revised the layout accordingly and submitted revised proposal due to changes in project proposal. The proponent surrendered the earlier EC and submitted revised proposal afresh and also informed that they have not initiated any construction activity in the proposed site. Hence, it was requested to consider the revised proposal and issue EC.

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The SEAC noted that total plot area is 33,396.58 Sq.m., Net plot area is 31,021.02 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 4,070.74 Sq.m. (13.12%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 31,549.60 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Villas (G + 2 Floors) to accommodate 102 Villas and a Club House (G + 4 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided to park 2 four wheelers and 1 two wheeler in each villa.

The total cost of the project is Rs.33.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 54.4 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs. 14.2 lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of new EC in place of old EC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 09.02.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 12.04.2022 of ADMG, Nalgonda District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.760 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 3.760 Ha. and Net cluster area is 3.760 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Narboyangudem (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.55 km; nearest water body exists at 0.22 km (E) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 10,000 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 8 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 60.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 8.96 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.09 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri V.Prabhakara Reddy and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the initial lease was granted on 07.12.2004 in favour of Sri E. Kotaiah for a period of 15 years. Subsequently, the lease was transferred from Sri E. Kotaiah in favour of M/s. Venkata Kanaka Durga Metal Industries on 27.11.2017 for un-expired period i.e., 06.12.2019. Further, the extension of lease was granted on 13.08.2019 w.e.f 07.12.2019 to

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06.12.2024. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was initially granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.00 Ha. which is less 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA than Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Jangamvarigudem (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.0 km; nearest water body i.e., adjacent tank exists at 0.4 km (N); nearest RF i.e., Lalapur RF exists at 4.7 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine maximum 1,42,650 m³/annum (average 1,35,900 m³/annum) of Rough Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 8 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 45.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.8 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.5 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Ir. dt. 25.04.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri Bhongir District furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2004-05 to 2020-21. It is observed from the letter that despatch permits were issued during the period 2004-05 to 2020-21.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.28.07.2021 issued by the Sarpanch, Pillaipally (V), Pochampally (M), Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District stating that the proponent supplied metal and rock sand of worth about Rs. 1,83,750/- for construction of CC Roads and other activities etc.,

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Hence, the SEAC decided to inform the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Kamalakar and Smt. Lochana of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that few trees exists in the site. In this regard, the proponent informed that the intervening trees will be translocated to the boundaries of the site.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 21.03.2018 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 09.05.2022 of ADMG, Khammam District informing that there are 2 existing quarry leases (leases granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.50 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 7.5 Ha. and Net cluster area is 1.50 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.



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The nearest village to the proposed site is Pittalavari Gudem (V) which is existing at a distance of 805m; nearest water body i.e., Akeru Vaagu exists at 308m (N) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 4,250.40 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 12 years (@2919.12 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.95 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.85 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent informed that the initial lease was granted on 11.09.2007 in favour of Sri G. Chandrashekar for a period of 15 years. Subsequently, the lease was transferred from Sri G. Chandrashekar in favour of M/s. Anantha Sai Stone Crushing Pvt. Ltd., on 27.09.2008 for the balance lease period i.e., upto 16.10.2022. Further, the proponent applied for 1st renewal of quarry lease on 02.05.2022. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was initially granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.5 Ha. which is less 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Bolla Gudem (V) which is existing at a distance of 295m; nearest water body i.e., Khairatpur Lake exists at 944m (NE); nearest RF i.e., Malkapuram RF exists at 400m from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 1,12,036 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 6 years (@90072.8 m³/annum).

Kalyan Kumar in favour of M/s. Anantha Sai Industries Pvt. Ltd., on 10.07.2018 for the balance lease period i.e., upto 12.10.2021. Further, the proponent applied for 1st renewal of quarry lease on 25.04.2022 for 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was initially granted before 09.09.2013. The representative of the project proponent Sri Ashol Swaminathan and Smt. Lochana of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt. 18.03.2020 for Residential Complex with builtup area 56,684.63 Sq.m.

Now, the proponent informed that there are few changes from the original plan due to the suggestion of the GHMC, there are changes in Built-up area, Water requirement, Wastewater generation, Solid waste, STP Capacity, DG Sets, etc., The proponent also informed that the status that presently it is under excavation stage and constructing retaining walls. Hence, it was requested to issue amendment to EC with the following changes:

The representative of the project proponent Sri Srihari Vamsiram and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed with in 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, Madhapur (V) is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

During presentation, the proponent informed that currently HSBC Building with G + 5 Floors exists in the site. It was informed that it will be demolished and the proposed project will be constructed.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 13,607.64 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 2,261.440 Sq.m. (16.62%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 1,36,149.23 Sq.m. The project consists of Commercial Building Construction Project. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are 3B + Podium + 13 Floors.

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It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 40,584.88 Sq.m., (47.61% against required 44%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.110.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 115.0 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs. 15.0 lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Dr. Uma Maheswara Rao and Smt. Pallavi of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt. 16.02.2021 for expansion of Bulk Drug & Drug Intermediates and (APIs) manufacturing unit.

Now, the proponent informed that while applying for EC, the unit did not include by products along with the products in EMP. However, these by-products were shown in material balance and considered in load table, but not listed in EMP. Project proponent informed that they proposed to sale the by products to Industries/ Cement plants for co-processing/TSDf. It was informed that they inadvertently missed to include these by-products in EMP. Thus, there are no other changes proposed in the details mentioned in the EC except w.r.t. by-products. Hence, they requested to include the following by products and issue amendment to EC:

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Krishna Kanth and Smt. Lochana of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech (P) Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- Initial lease was granted on 04.09.1998 for a period of 20 yrs i.e., upto 03.09.2018. Later, applied for 1st renewal and lease was granted on 08.03.2019 for a period of 20 yrs. The proponent has obtained EC from SEIAA, TS on 09.10.2015 with a validity upto 08.10.2021 of Laterite Mine with production of 3,00,000 TPA.
- In the MoEF&CC Notification S.O.221(E), dt. 18.01.2021 it was mentioned that “9A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this notification, the period from the 1st April, 2020 to the 31st March, 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of prior Environmental Clearances granted under the provisions of this notification in view of outbreak of Corona Virus (COVID-19) and subsequent lockdowns (total or partial) declared for its control, however, all activities undertaken during this period in respect of the Environmental Clearance granted shall be treated as valid”. With this notification, EC validity is extended up to one year i.e., 08.10.2022.
- The proponent obtained CFE from TSPCB vide order dt. 21.02.2019 and CFO vide order dt. 09.09.2020.
- The mining plan is approved by the Deputy Director of Mines and Geology, Warangal for Laterite production of 3,00,000 TPA dt. 17.12.2021.
- As per the old mining plan, the life of the mine was given as 6 years i.e., upto October 2021. No mining operations were carried out since EC order granted.
- As per the revised mining plan life of the mine is extended up to 22 years.

The proponent further informed the following and submitted supporting documents:

- The lease was granted in 1998 in the name of Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao over an extent of 20.00 acres in Sy. No. 60/2, Mallampally (V), Mulugu (M), Mulugu district Telangana by the Director of Mines and Geology vide proceedings no: 1061/M/98, dated 04-09-1998 for a period of 20 years upto 03-09-2018.
- The mining operations commenced in 1998 and went on till 2011. Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao is paying dead rents on yearly basis.
- In the year 2006, Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha created fake documents and filed a case against the state government and Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao stating that the land belongs to Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha.
- While the case was going on, in the year 2010, court granted temporary injunction order to stop the mining operations.
- In 2011, the government enquired about the issue and resumed the land and taken over the land to their custody, as the land is ceiling surplus land belongs to G.M. Omer Khan who surrendered to government in the year 1991.
- In the year 2017, the case filed by Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha was dismissed by the court.
- Subsequently, again in the year 2018, M/s. Ganesh Mines & Minerals had filed writ petition in single bench of high court vide petition no 28339 of 2018 against the state government and Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao. Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha were impleaded in this case stating that the land belongs to them. Subsequently, the court dismissed the writ petition in 2018 after hearings.
- Again in the year 2019, M/s. Ganesh Mines & Minerals aggrieved by the single bench order and filed a writ appeal vide 14 of 2019 against state government and Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao in Divisional Bench at High Court. In the event of arguments the high court directed the District Collector of Mulugu District to provide a detailed report on the land situated at Sy. No. 60/2.

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- Accordingly, the District Collector had filed affidavit in high court stating that land belongs to state government, being ceiling surplus land surrendered by surplus land owner Sri. G.M. Omer Khan as per the orders of honourable tribunal (land reforms) Warangal by order dated 18-02-1991 and also stated that created fake registered documents to grab the government land. Now, the land has been resumed by the government. On hearing the arguments of all the parties, the honourable high court dismissed the writ appeal no 14 of 2019.
- By the time, the 1st renewal of lease was granted in 08-03-2019 to Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao with a condition of subject to the outcome of writ appeal no 14 of 2019 and the mining department after having enquired about the land details with the revenue department and also the following court orders, the mining department issued 1st renewal work order to Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao for a further period of 20 years w.e.f from 04-09-2018 to 03-09-2038 dated 22-11-2021 vide proceeding no 1998/1/Q/2017 dated 22-11-2021.
- Subsequently, again Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha filed a case against state government and Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao & family at 1st Additional Senior Civil Judge, Warangal dated 14-03-2022 claiming that the land is belongs to them. After the arguments in the court, the petition has been dismissed on 29-04-2022 stating that the land belongs to the government and petitioners are claiming the land with false, fabricated and bogus documents and also stated that the petitioners are not approached the court with clean hands and created the documents to grab the government land.
- Hence, with these issues Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao did not operate the quarry from 2011 to till date. Now, all the issues have been cleared by the honourable courts and state government. Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao will start mining operations after obtaining Extension of Environmental Clearance and CFE / CFO.

Now, the proponent is requesting to grant EC Validity Extension for 22 years.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Ummayyanagar (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.0 km; nearest water body exists at 1 km (E); nearest RF i.e., Jakaram RF exists at 370m from the boundary of the site.

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It is proposed to mine 3,00,000 TPA of Laterite and the life of mine is reported as 22 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.2 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.0 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.18.10.2021 issued by the Head Master, ZPHS, Mallampalli (V), Mulugu (M), Mulugu District stating that the proponent has donated Computer for School and other needs of students of worth Rs.30,000/-.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of extension of validity of EC.
