The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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Agenda Item No. 01	"Garuda Estilo" by M/s. Blubuild Infra Projects Pvt Ltd., Sy. No. 901/E, at Bhongiri (V) & (M), Yadadri Bhuvangiri District - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIS/270639/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Pavan Kumar and Sri Laxmikanth Reddy of M/s. Vision Labs, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that a Surplus course (Canal) of Pedda Cheru Bhongiri is existing adjacent to the site. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of letter dt. 29.10.2021 issued by the EE, Irrigation Division No.11, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District of I&CAD Dept. The SEAC observed from the document that out of total area of Ac.02-24 Gts., the total extent of deductible area of surplus course affected area & Buffer zone area Ac.00-09 Gts. in Sy. Nos. 901/2 is calculated as Ac. 00-13.50 Gts. Net extent after deducting surplus course effected area (Ac.00-04.5 Gts.) & Buffer zone area is calculated as Ac. 02-10.50 Gts. "No Objection Certificate" is issued for the land in Sy. Nos. 901/2 for an extent of Ac. 02-10.50 Gts situated in Bhongiri (V&M), as per the norms of G.O.Ms.No.168, dt.07.04.2012 of MA&UD Department. Accordingly, the proponent proposed layout of the project.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 10,425.44 Sq.m., Net plot area is 9,914.77 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 996.85 Sq.m. (10.05%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 41,322.67 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 207 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are C + S + 7 Upper Floors.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 12,253.19 Sq.m., (42.15% against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.64.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 96.0 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs. 20.0 lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 02	Residential Villas Project by M/s. Sark projects India Pvt Ltd., Sy. Nos. 16, 17, 18, 19 & 20, of Malkidanguda (V) and Sy.No. 510, 511, 512, 513 of Mokila (V), Shankarpally (M), Rangareddy District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIS/270655/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Ch. Naveen Kumar and Sri Laxmikanth Reddy of M/s. Vision Labs, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed with in 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, Mokila (V) is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996

During presentation, the SEAC observed that few trees exist in the site. In this regard, the proponent informed that the intervening trees will be translocated to the boundaries of the site.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that Canal existing adjacent to the site. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of letter dt. 25.04.2022 issued by the SE, Irrigation Circle, Hyderabad of I&CAD Dept. The SEAC observed from the document that out of total area of Ac.19-06 Gts., the applicant's land is affected in water bodies in Sy. Nos. 16, 17 and 20 area affected in 9.00 M wide Buffer zone area on one side of the surplus course as per G.O.Ms. No. 168, MA&UD Dept., dt. 07.04.2012 to an extent of Ac. 01-03.5 Gts but not affected in MFL of surplus course. Therefore, the applicant balance land to an extent of land Ac. 18-02.5 Gts out of Ac. 19-06 Gts in Sy. Nos. 16, 17 and 20 situated at Malkidhagnuda (V) and Maheshwaram (M), Rangareddy District is not affected in any water body/Nala/Channel and it is free from the water

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body as per the norms stipulated to G.O.Ms. No. 168, MA&UD Dept., dt. 07.04.2012. Accordingly, the proponent proposed layout of the project.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 98,023.29 Sq.m., Net plot area is 82,212.95 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 8,290.0 Sq.m. (10.08%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 60,001.0 Sq.m. The project consists of Duplex Villas (G + 1 Floors) to accommodate 326 Villas; Club House (G + 1 Floor).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided with two parking spaces (1 two wheeler & 1 four wheeler) in each Villa.

The total cost of the project is Rs.85.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 130.0 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs. 40.0 lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Ramesh and Sri Vinay of M/s. Shivalik Solid Waste Management Ltd., Punjab attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 07.04.2022 deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned letter issued by the TSPCB in favor of the proponent for establishment of proposed project.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted a copy of Ir.dt.06.05.2022 issued by the TSPCB. It is observed from the document that the Board (in-principle) agreed to consider the representation of M/s. Clean Harbors India for establishment of New CBMWTF at Sy. No. 537/A1/2, Peechara (V), Velair (M), Hanumakonda District to cater the HCFs located in erstwhile Warangal District for collection, transportation, treatment & disposal of only Bio-medical waste (as defined in BMWM rules -2016 & amendments thereof), with a condition to comply with the Revised Guidelines issued for CBMWTF by CPCB on 21.12.2016, subject to obtaining required permissions / licenses / clearances from all the concerned departments and fulfilling the meeting criteria.

Nearest human habitation is Velair (V) @ 5.25 km; Nearest water body i.e., Gauravelly Canal exists at a distance of 1.8 km from the boundary of the site.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 5766.77 Sq.m., (1.425 Acres), Out of which, green area is 1,911.70 Sq.m. (33.15%)

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from March 2022 to May 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from March to May 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from March to May 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facilities", undergo the process of Public Hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Raheem and Mrs. Shaheda Begum of M/s. EPTRI, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 4.98 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as 8.0m to 9.0m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report (Inspection dt. 20.04.2021).

It is proposed to mine 99,600 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Veerapuram (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.20 km; Nearest RF is Mulugu RF exists at 1.12 km from the boundary of the site.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 24.90 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.48 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Raheem and Mrs. Shaheda Begum of M/s. EPTRI, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 4.99 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as 8.0m to 9.0m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report (Inspection dt. 17.04.2021).

It is proposed to mine 99,800 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Gollagudem (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.25 km; Nearest RF is Subbampeta RF exists at 0.62 km from the boundary of the site.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 24.95 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.39 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Raheem and Mrs. Shaheda Begum of M/s. EPTRI, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 4.98 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as 8.5m to 9.0m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report vide lr.dt.30.03.2021.

It is proposed to mine 98,600 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Ramachandrapuram (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.75 km; Nearest RF is Mangapet RF exists at 3.2 km from the boundary of the site.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 24.65 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.45 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 07	4.99 Ha. Ordinary Sand Mine of M/s. Telangana State Mineral Development Corporation Ltd., Godavari River at Marikala (V), Venkatauram (M), Mulugu District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/271314/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Raheem and Mrs. Shaheda Begum of M/s. EPTRI, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 4.99 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent informed that the thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is reported as 8.5m to 9.0m as per Joint Inspection Report. The depth of proposed sand extraction is 2.0m, as per joint inspection report vide lr.dt.30.03.2021.

It is proposed to mine 99,800 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 24.95 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 0.47 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

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Agenda Item No. 08	4.97 Ha. Ordinary Sand Mine of M/s. TSMDC Ltd., Godavari River at Padmuru (V), Mangapeta, Mulugu District - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/254379/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Raheem and Mrs. Shaheda Begum of M/s. EPTRI, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 25.02.2022 informed the proponent to submit document/latest satellite imagery showing that there is no water in sand reach.

Now, the proponent submitted the latest Satellite Image with Data of Acquisition dt. 23.04.2022. The SEAC observed from the latest Satellite Image that no water exists in the sand reach.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 09	12.00 Ha. Quartz & Feldspar Quarry of M/s. Raging River Mines and Minerals Pvt. Ltd., Sy. No. 179/1 of Shaikpally (V), Hanwada (M), Mahabubnagar District. - TOR - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/76951/2022 (TOR)

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Munender and Sri M. Venkatesh of M/s. Global Enviro Labs, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Quartz & Feldspar Quarry with Mine Lease Area of 12.00 Ha. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 2,64,600 TPA of Quartz and 26,250 TPA of Feldspar.

The SEAC noted from Notice dt. 05.12.2021 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of lr.dt. 23.04.2022 of ADMG, Mahabubnagar District informing that there are no quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

Nearest human habitation is Shaikpally Tanda @ 0.36 km; Nearest water body i.e., Shaikpally Lake exists at a distance of 0.6 km; Nearest RF i.e., Kondapur RF exists at a distance of 9.5 m from the mine lease area. But, as per the guidelines of the SEIAA, the minimum distance from the boundary of mine lease area w.r.t. RF is 50m.

In this regard, the proponent informed that mining is being allowed even within the Forest area after obtaining Stage 1 & 2 Clearances. Whereas, Forest Clearances are not applicable in the present project as the mine lease area is located at a distance of 9.5 m from Forest boundary and it is meeting the minimum 7.5m safety distance as per the Forest Conservation Act, 1980. It was also informed that they will additionally maintain 7.5m buffer zone within the mine lease area. The proponent also submitted a copy of lr.dt.29.04.2022 of the DFO, Mahabubnagar informing that the proposed quarry site is falling outside RF Kondapur at a distance of 9.5 m from compartment No.310. Hence, it was requested to consider their proposal and issue TOR.

The SEAC examined the request of the proponent and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommends to issue TORs, Subject to Approval by the SEIAA and to direct the proponent to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals", undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

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Agenda Item No. 10	5.70 Ha. Building Stone & Road Metal Mine of Sri Makta Parameshwar Singh, Sy. No. 286, Solakpally (V), Jinnaram (M), Sangareddy District - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/254807/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Rajasekhar and Sri Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the SEIAA earlier issued EC vide order dt.26.04.2018 to mine 98,000 m³/annum of Stone & Metal. It was informed that the proponent obtained CFO vide order dt.28.02.2019 valid upto 31.01.2024.

Now, the proponent proposed enhancement of production capacity from 98,000 m³/annum to 6,98,250 m³/annum and uploaded the proposal seeking EC for expansion.

The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 5.70 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is to be considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. But, it is observed that the project proponent applied the proposal under EC instead of TOR in Parivesh.

In view of the above, the SEAC decided to return the proposal.

Agenda Item No. 11	10.12 Ha. Rough Stone & Road Metal Mine of M/s. Shries TNA Stones Industries, Sy. No. 747, Lakdaram (V), Patancheru (M), Sangareddy District. - TOR - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/24738/2018 (TOR)

The representative of the project proponent Sri L. Manjunath and Sri Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Rough Stone & Road Metal Mine with Mine Lease Area of 10.12 Ha. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 7,00,245 m³/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was initially granted to Sri Abhishek Goud for a period of 10 years from 02.02.2015 to 01.07.2025 and subsequently the lease transferred in favour of the proponent for unexpired period of lease upto 01.07.2025. The SEAC noted that the mining operations were started in the mine lease area from 2015-16 without obtaining prior EC, as informed by the proponent.

Nearest human habitation is Yerdanur Tanda @ 0.65 km; Nearest water body i.e., Lakdaram Lake exists at a distance of 0.92 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and undergo the process of Public Hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

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Agenda Item No. 12	4.96 Ha. Ordinary Sand Mine of M/s. Telangana Mineral Development Corporation Ltd. (TSMDC), Kathigudem Sand Reach, Kathigudem (V), Mangapet (M), Mulugu District. - Extension of Environmental Clearance Validity - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/270700/2022 (EC - Extension of Validity)

The representative Sri Raheem and Sri Mohan Reddy of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier they obtained EC vide order dt. 17.12.2020 from the SEIAA for the project to extract 59,400 m³/year of ordinary sand with vality period of 1 year from the date of CFO. It was informed that they also obtained CFE vide order dt. 27.02.2021 and CFO vide order dt. 05.03.2021 valid upto 31.01.2022 for the project.

Now, it was informed that obtained EC for Mining of Ordinary Sand with capacity of 59,400 m³/year over an Extent of 4.96 Ha on 17.12.2020. As per the Approved Mining Plan the total Mineable Reserves are 99,198 Cu.m and total life of the mine is 3 years. From the total mineable reserves, so far they achieved 59,400 cu.m only as per the EC. Hence, it was requested to issue the extension of EC for another 1 year to achieve the remaining production.

The SEAC noted the request of the proponent and observed that CFO was valid upto 31.01.2022 and EC is valid upto 04.03.2022 only. The SEAC further noted that deposition of sand may vary every year as the sand is carried away by rain water due to which the availability of sand in sand reach with particular coordinates may change unlike other minerals of mining projects. Hence, the EC was also issued only for one year.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended to return the proposal for extension of validity.

Agenda Item No. 13	19.80 Ha. Ordinary Sand Mine of M/s. Telangana Mineral Development Corporation Ltd. (TSMDC), Godavari River Sand Eppagudem (V), Venkatapuram (M), Mulugu District - Extension of Environmental Clearance Validity - Reg.

The proponent informed that 1st Renewal of the lease was granted (in-principle) on 01.09.2017 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 07.05.2022 of ADMG, Karimnagar District informing that there are 4 existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. It is observed from the letter that 3 leases granted before 09.09.2013 and another 1 lease granted after 09.09.2013. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.30 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 11.13 Ha. and Net cluster area is 2.93 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Elgandal Colony (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.30 km; nearest water body i.e., Kamanapur Pond exists at 0.6 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 19,818 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 20 years (@22,020 m³/annum).

The SEAC considered the project though the RF is adjacent to mine lease area as it is an existing mine granted in 2002.

It is proposed to mine 0.667 MTPA (Limestone: 0.66 MTPA + Top Soil: 0.007 MTPA) of Limestone and the life of mine is reported as 52.5 years @ 0.66 MTPA.
