The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Venkat Rao; and Sri Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for **Rough Stone & Road Metal Mine** with Mine Lease Area of 27.5 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine -- m³/annum of **Rough Stone & Road Metal**.

The SEAC noted from Notice dt. 19.08.2021 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan.

Nearest human habitation is Madhavaram @ 0.54 km; Nearest water body exists near Mine lease area at 54.27 mts (W); Nearest RF is Kazipally RF exists at 1.4 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC considered the request of the proponent. After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" and undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Krishnaiah; and Sri Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted from Notice dt. 24.0.2016 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years upto 18.05.2031. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 08.10.2021 of ADMG, Sangareddy District informing that there is one quarry lease of M/s. Ganesh Metal Industries (4.047 Ha. – lease granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the project is for Rough Stone & Road Metal Mine with present Mine Lease Area of 4.98 Ha. (after part surrender of quarry lease for 0.68 Ha. from existing quarry lease of 5.66 Ha., as per Procds. dt. 01.07.2021 of the DDMG: Nizamabad) It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 9.027 Ha. and Net cluster area is 4.98 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 1,33,040 m³/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal Mine. The proponent started mining operations from the year 2016-17 as per lr. dt. 04.10.2021 of ADMG, Sangareddy District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Brahmanguda @ 0.77 km; Nearest water body is Chintalkunta exists at 0.79 km; Nearest RF is Admapur RF exists at 3.65 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Kasiviswanadham; and Sri Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Rough Stone & Road Metal Quarry with Mine Lease Area of 17.0 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 5,72,346 m³/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal.

The SEAC noted from Notice dt. 09.12.2010 that quarry lease was initially granted in favour of M/s. Rank Silicon Pvt. Ltd., for a period of 10 years and subsequently the lease was transferred to the proponent on 12.04.2012 for unexpired period of lease upto 08.12.2020. Later the lease was extended for a further period of 5 years on 25.07.2018 upto 08.12.2025. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent started mining operations from the year 2012-13 as per lr. dt. 26.05.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Yerdanur Thanda @ 0.5 km; Nearest water body is Lakdaram Cheruvu exists at 1.0 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Kasiviswanadham; and Sri Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Rough Stone & Road Metal Quarry with Mine Lease Area of 13.406 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 4,79,460 m³/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal.

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The SEAC noted from Procds. dt. 27.02.2013 of ADMG, Hyderabad that Amalgamation of three quarries (leases granted before 09.09.2013) quarry lease for co-terminus period upto 17.07.2018 . Later the lease was extended for a further period of 5 years on 13.09.2019 upto 16.07.2023. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent started mining operations from the year 2004-05 as per lr. dt. 23.05.2022 of ADMG, Medchal Malkajgiri District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Baswapur @ 1.0 km; Nearest water body is Shamirpet Vagu exists at 6.0 km; Nearest RF is Dasarlapalli exists at distance of 0.3 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Jayachandra Reddy; and Smt.Pallavi of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech (P) Limited, Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 26.02.2009 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.00 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Dontragundlu (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.1 km; nearest water body i.e., Gauravelli Right Canal exists at 620 m (E); nearest RF i.e., Malkapuram RF exists at 7.6 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 3,22,800 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 3 years (@2,67,030 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.9 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.45 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 12.05.2022 of ADMG, Hanumakonda District furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2009-10 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2009-10 to 2021-22 except during 2015-16.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.21.07.2021 & 08.06.2020 issued by the Sarpanch, Peechara (V), Velair (M), Warangal Urban District stating that the proponent has provided tree guards of worth Rs.75,000/- and supplied material of worth Rs.2.0 Lakhs for road repair works.

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The proponent also informed that they have developed plantation over an extent of 2.0 Acre in their own patta land at Sy. No. 565 of same village located at about 315 mts away from mine lease area.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Building Stone & Road Metal Mine with Mine Lease Area of 0.86 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha and thus it has to be considered under B2 Category. But, since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 12,312 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal.

The SEAC noted from Procds. dt.21.01.2008 that quarry lease was initially granted for 1.80 Ha. in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years and subsequently, the lease area became 0.86 Ha. after part surrender of lease area on 19.12.2017. Later the Mining Department granted lease (in-principle) on 26.06.2019 in favour of proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent started mining operations from the year 2019-20 as per lr. dt. 01.06.2022 of ADMG, Peddapally District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Bompally @ 0.6 km; Nearest water body is Kunta exists at 0.7 km; Nearest RF is Dense Mixed Jungle exists at 470 mts from the mine lease area.
