The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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Agenda Item No. 01	6.0 Ha. Colour Granite Mine of M/s. Sinai Granites, Sy. No. 37/1 & 38, Garimillapally (V), Inavole (M), Hanumakonda District. - TOR - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/77187/2022 (TOR)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Guddeti Madhukar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs and Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Colour Granite with Mine Lease Area of 6.0 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 102808.8 m³ /annum (Recovery (Granite) @ 20561.76 m³ and Waste (road metal) @ 57703.2 m³) of Colour Granite.

The SEAC noted from Notice dt. 16.08.2018 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan.

Nearest human habitation is Garnapalli (V) @ 400m; Nearest water body is Cheruvu exists at 200 mts (E) from the mine lease area.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from December 2021 - February 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed project. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from December 2021 - February 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

The SEAC noted informed the proponent to submit the status of Mine certified by the Mining Department, as the mine lease was granted in the year 2018.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Guddeti Madhukar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs and Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Black Granite with Mine Lease Area of 6.0 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 59763.6 m³ /annum (Recovery (Granite) @ 5976.4 m³ and Waste (road metal) @ 268936.2 m³) of Black Granite.

The SEAC noted from Notice dt. 13.04.2018 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan.

Nearest human habitation is Lakshmpuram (V) @ 500m; Nearest water body is Cheruvu exists at 645 mts (SW) from the mine lease area.

The proponent informed that no mining operations were started in the mine lease area since inception of mine lease from the year 2018 and the same has been verified by the SEAC from the Google timelines images.

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The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from December 2021 - February 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed project. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from December 2021 - February 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

The SEAC considered the request of the proponent. After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from December 2021 - February 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Sunil Kumar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- State Government vide GO Ms No. 153, dt. 01.03.2002 constituted Mining Zone Committee for Ranga Reddy District. Mining Zone committee identified an area in Survey No. 268 creation of mining zone as per GoMs No. 89, dt. 22.03.2006 by the State Government.
- As per the state government orders vide G.O.Ms. No. 48, dt. 26.07.2017 for issue of Scrutinized Quarry Plan, all lease holders prepared quarry plans.
- A case was filed before the Hon'ble NGT vide Original Application (O.A) No. 9 of 2022 (SZ) w.r.t. the Quarries located in above mentioned Mining Zone.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Stone & Metal Quarry with Mine Lease Area of 5.038 ha or 12.45 Acres (6.0 Acres in Block No. 17A, 4.0 Acres in Block No. 17B and Acr 2.45 gts in Common Area). The SEAC noted that these Blocks of mine lease area are located adjacent to each other. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area of 5.038 ha. is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 153400 m³/annum of Stone & Metal.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years upto 10.04.2023 and the proponent started mining operations from the year 2008-09 to 2020-21 as per Ir. dt. 19.03.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Deshmukh (V) @ 1.6 km; Nearest water body i.e., Seasonal Musi River exists at a distance of 3.2 km (N); Nearest RF i.e., Bacharam RF exists at 3.6 km from the boundary of the site.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

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After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 & S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 and OM dt. 07.07.2021 & 28.01.2022 undergo the process of Public Hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Damodar Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 07.01.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to acquire additional land for development of greenbelt and submit the land documents along with Undertaking for the same.

Now, the proponent informed that greenbelt will be developed in their own land of Ac. 3.11 at Sy. No. 154 P & 155 P, Jukal (V), Shamshabad (M), Rangareddy District located at about 31.4 km away from the proposed quarry lease area for compensatory afforestation and submitted undertaking for the same along with copies of land documents.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri N. Mohammed Iqbal and Sri Chandrashekar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Black Granite Mine with present Mine Lease Area of 4.9 Ha. (after part surrender of quarry lease for 0.66 Ha. from existing quarry lease of 5.5 Ha., as per Procds. dt. 30.01.2019 of the DMG: Hyderabad) which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 37100.40 m³/annum of Black Granite.

The SEAC noted that 4th renewal of quarry lease was granted by the Mining Dept., vide Procds. dt. 15.07.2008 that quarry lease was in favour of the proponent for a further period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was initially granted before 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent continued mining operations without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Peddapuram @ 0.5 km; Nearest water body is Ramappa Cheruvu exists at 0.25 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

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The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from March - May 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from March - May 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

The representative of the project proponent Sri N. Dileepa Chary and Sri M. Venkatesh of M/s. Global Enviro Labs, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Quartz and Feldspar Mine with Mine Lease Area of 8.09 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 15,012 TPA of Quartz & 10,008 TPA of Feldspar.

The SEAC noted from Proceedings dt. 14.07.2016 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years and the proponent carried out mining operations without obtaining EC.

Nearest human habitation is Rajampet Tanda @ 0.6 km; Nearest water body i.e., Pedda Vagu exists at a distance of 2.8 km & nearest RF is Vanaparthy RF at 3.3 km from the mine lease area.

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During presentation, the proponent informed that earlier the project was considered by the SEAC/SEIAA as a violation case and the State Government was requested for taking action against the proponent on the violation under Section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Section 15 of the act for the period for which the violation has taken place. Accordingly, Complaint Case No 236/2017 was filed in the Court of Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Mahabubnagar. It was informed that the case was heard on 31.03.2022 and judgment has been given with a fine of Rs.50,000/- which was paid by the project proponent and submitted copies of supporting documents.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. But, the SEAC noted that the other proposal of same project was uploaded prior to issue of SOP w.r.t. Violation cases. Hence, the SEAC decided to consider the proposal in terms of S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 & S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 & S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 and undergo the process of Public Hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri V. Mahender and Sri M. Venkatesh of M/s. Global Enviro Labs, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Colour Granite Mine with Mine Lease Area of 10.0 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 30,144 m³/annum of Colour Granite.

The SEAC noted from Proceedings dt. 07.12.2007 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years and the proponent carrying out mining operations without obtaining EC.

Nearest human habitation is Kalwala @ 1.3 km; Nearest water body i.e., Kalwala Reservoir exists at a distance of 0.3 km from the mine lease area.

During presentation, the proponent informed that earlier the project was considered by the SEAC/SEIAA as a violation case and the State Government was requested for taking action against the proponent on the violation under Section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and Section 15 of the act for the period for which the violation has taken place. Accordingly, Complaint Case No 588/2017 was filed in the Court of I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Huzurabad. The case was heard on 20.12.2017 and judgment has been given to pay fine of Rs.12,000/- for the offence under Section 15 of E(P) Act., 1986, in default to suffer simple imprisonment for one month and accordingly the project proponent paid fine on 20.12.2017. The project proponent submitted copies of the same.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. But, the SEAC noted that the other proposal of same project was uploaded prior to issue of SOP w.r.t. 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After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 & S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 and undergo the process of Public Hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Ravinder and Sri A. Mohan Reddy of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Colour Granite with Mine Lease Area of 3.30 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 51,510 m³/annum of Colour Granite. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan.

The SEAC noted from Notice dt. 25.02.2011 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. The SEAC noted that earlier, the SEIAA, AP (Combined State) issued EC vide order dt. 29.11.2012 to mine 4080 m³/annum of Colour Granite. But, the proponent continued mining operations with exceeded capacities than permitted as per EC from the year 2012-13 as per Ir. dt. 17.05.2022 of ADMG, Karimnagar District, without obtaining prior EC for enhanced capacity.

Nearest human habitation is Saiganipally (V) @ 0.59 km; Nearest water body is Baliahpally water body exists at 1.58 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from March - May 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from March - May 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

The representative of the project proponent Sri N. Abdul Raheem and Sri A. Mohan Reddy of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 19.98 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

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The proponent informed that the average thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach is more than 8 m. (as per Joint Inspection Report after Survey dt. 17.06.2021) and depth of proposed sand extraction is 2 m.


