**DECISION OF HON'BLE HIGH COURT ORDER DATED 18/8/2023 IN THE MATTER OF CHANDER KAMAL BALJEES VS. STATE OF HPSEIAA IN CWP No. 2807 of 2023**

Sh. C.K. Baljee, Chairman & Managing Director, H.No. 124, 3<sup>rd</sup> Main Defense Colony, Indira Nagar, Banglore, Kamataka vide online application No. SIA/HP/MIS/184041/2020 had submitted application for grant of Environment Clearance. The brief outline of the project is as under:

The 1<sup>st</sup> time proposal was listed & appraised by SEAC in its 78<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 8/4/21, thereafter it was again listed in 78<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC on dated 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2021 subsequently in 79<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC on dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2021, in 80<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2021, 53<sup>rd</sup> meeting of SEIAA on 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2021, 82<sup>nd</sup> meeting of SEAC on 11<sup>th</sup> Oct, 2021, 83<sup>rd</sup> meeting of SEAC on 29<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2021, 85<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC during 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>, July 2022, in 58<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEIAA on 21<sup>st</sup>, July 2022, in 59<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEIAA on, 28<sup>th</sup>, September 2022, in 87<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC on 28<sup>th</sup> December 2022 & finally in 60<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEIAA on dated 17<sup>th</sup>, February 2022.

The SEIAA in its 60<sup>th</sup> meeting decided that the Environment Clearance cannot be granted at this stage in view of prevailing orders of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal Order dated 16.11.2017 in the matter of OA No. 121/2014 titled as "Yogendra Mohan Sengupta Vs. Union of India and others. Accordingly the project proposal is disposed off.

Thereafter, the project proponent filed an appeal before the Hon'ble High Court, Himachal Pradesh against the decision of SEIAA taken on dated 17<sup>th</sup>, February 2022. The Hon'ble High Court on dated 18/08/2023 and passed an order in the matter in the matter of CHANDER KAMAL BALJEES VS. STATE OF HPSEIAA in CWP No. 2807 of 2023. The operative part of the Hon'ble High Court order is as under:

..... Consequently, in view of above, detailed discussion made herein above and law taken into consideration, this court finds merit in the petition and same is allowed, Annexure P-24 i.e. Minutes of Meeting dated 17.2.2023, in so far as they relate to the petitioner are concerned, are quashed and set aside and respondent No. 1 is directed to grant formal Environmental Clearance ...

The matter was listed in 64<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEIAA held on dated 5<sup>th</sup> Sept., 2023. In compliance of the orders of Hon'ble High Court dated 18-08-2023 in the matter of CHANDER KAMAL BALJEES VS. STATE OF HPSEIAA in CWP No. 2807 of 2023, approved to issue the letter of Environment Clearance in favour of the project proponent.

- In future the SEIAA secretariat may ensure that all the applications are well scrutinized, original documents are placed in file, original revenue records are taken on record with proper entries, etc. as are required for decision and that all applications are readable and complete in order in all respect failing which the case will not be listed for decision.
- It was decided that, henceforth, in case of applications where Public Hearing is involved only those cases will be placed for decision where the recommendations are clearly defined w.r.t. outcome of public hearing for either recommending or not recommending grant of Environment Clearance.
