	<p>Category : B1</p> <p>This project proposal was earlier examined in the SEAC,A.P., meeting held on 26th -28th May, 2021 and minutes of the meeting is as follows: The proposed project is for establishment of Common Bio-medical Treatment Facility with a treatment capacity of 7 TPD.</p> <p>The Committee noted that the proposed project falls under Item 7(da) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006- common biomedical waste treatment facility.</p> <p>The Committee noted that the project proponent has not submitted the Technical Feasibility Report for the proposed Common Bio-medical Treatment Facility in Guntur District.</p> <p>The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&amp;CC' Notifications &amp; OMs and Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facilities (CBMWTF) guidelines and detailed deliberations, recommended to Defeat this project proposal. The project proponent shall submit the Technical Feasibility Report for the proposed Common Bio-medical Treatment Facility at the proposed site as per MoEF&amp;CC Notification G.S.R.343(E), dated.28.03.2016 (New Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016).</p> <p>M/s. Shuddh Enviro Logics vide letter dated 23.08.2021 furnished the information on Technical Feasibility Report.</p> <p>The issue was discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 26th -28th May, 2021. During the meeting, the Committee noted that earlier SEIAA,A.P., issued Terms of Reference (TOR) with public hearing to M/s. Y.J.Multiclave vide Lr.No.SEIAA/AP/GNT/IND/05/2016/84-1068, Dated 10.10.2018 for the proposed Common Bio-medical Treatment Facility at Sy.No. 7/1 &amp; 8/1, Tana Annavaram ( V), Nuzendla (M), Guntur District.</p> <p>M/s. Y.J.Multiclave vide letter dated 06.07.2021 addressed to the SEIAA,A.P., being a party to the Writ Petition No.11945 of 2019, to reject the application of the project proponent namely M/s. Sudha Enviro Logics for grant of Environmental Clearance for securing CFE and CFO from the Board and stated that</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>The in Principle Permission was given to M/s. Y.J.Multiclave on 23.05.2018 by APPCE as directed SEIAA which is prerequisite for applying for EC.</li><li>The APPCB vide its Order No. 1/APPCE/VJA/GTR/HO/CBMWTF/2018-634, dated 17.07.2018 while rejecting the BMW-CFE application of M/s. Ravi Enviro Care, Sy.No.394-1, 394-2, Pedanandipadu ( V&amp;M),Guntur District observed their application is an earlier one and in principle permission was accorded for establishment of 2nd CBMWTF in Guntur District.</li><li>TOR was given to M/s. Y.J.Multiclave on 10.10.2018 by SEIAA.</li><li>The Writ Petition No.11945 of 2019 filed by M/s. A.P.Enviro Technologies Pvt. Ltd., against M/s. Y.J.Multiclave in the Hon'ble High Court with regard to establishment of 2nd CBMWTF in Guntur District.</li><li>Public Hearing was conducted on 19.09.2019 and application</li></ol>

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I.A.No.5 of 2019 was filed to release proceedings kept in sealed cover. The same is pending for consideration.

The Standing Counsel of SEIAA,A.P., vide Lr dated 18.08.2021 informed that the W.P.No.11945 of 2019 filed by A.P. Environ Technologies against Y.J. Multiclave regarding Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility in Guntur District was under stay of public hearing. All these days. Today ie.18.08.2021, the Hon'ble High Court pleased to disposed of the matter directing the State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) to consider the minutes of Public Hearing with the true spirit of the said minutes and also under the scheme of environmental laws in the case of Y.J. Multi Clave in accordance with law.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, representations and detailed deliberations, recommended that M/s. Shuddh Enviro Logics shall submit (i) The availability of No. of beds and their MOU with the HCFs and details of location of this proposed project with respect to the other sites of CBMWTFs. Also to address a letter to the District Medical & Health Officer, Guntur with regard to No.of HCFs and their tie-up the existing CBMWTF in the Guntur District.

Accordingly, letters addressed to the M/s.Shuddh Enviro Logics and DM&HO, Guntur on 08.10.2021. Subsequently, M/s.Shuddh Enviro Logics submitted the availability of No. of beds as per the DM&HO, Guntur and their MOU with HCFs and details of location of the proposed project with respect to the other sites of the CBMWTFs, vide letters dated 21.10.2021 and 24.10.2021.

As per the DM&HO, Guntur letter dated 23.02.2021, the total no. of beds available is 27,690 of Govt. and Private HCFs. As per CPCB, New Delhi guidelines, one CBMWTF can be allowed upto 10,000 beds; One CBMWTF is already in operation in Guntur District and the SEAC recommended for EC for one more CBMWTF i.e. Y.J. Multi Clave in this meeting. The SEAC committee observed that after allowing 2nd CBMWTF in Guntur District, still there is availability of 7,690 beds (27,690-20,000) in Guntur District.

M/s.Shuddh Enviro Logics further requested for exemption of public hearing. The proposed site is located in notified industrial estate i.e., Nadikudi Industrial Park which notified on 09.03.1998 and hence requested for exemption of public hearing.

The committee noted that the PP proposed CBMWTF in the Naidikudi, Industrial Park and the exemption of public hearing is covered as per the MoEF&CC Office Memorandum dated 16th May, 2014 under the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006.

The Committee after detail discussions and based on details available, **recommended for issue of Standard Terms of Reference (TOR) with exemption of public hearing** and with additional TOR: The PP shall take measures for protection of nearby surface water. The project proponent shall comply with the Bio-medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and its amendments and the Central Pollution Control Board Revised guidelines - 21st December, 2016., to this Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBMWTF) of Capacity - 7000 kgs/day proposed at **Plot No. 6, 9, 17 & 18, Industrial Park, Nadikudi, Phase-II, situated in Sy.No. 127/15 & 127/26, Nadikudi Village - 522414, Dachepalli Mandal, Guntur District, Andhra Pradesh,** without prejudice to the orders of any Hon'ble Courts.

*The committee noted the MoEF&CC, GoI, New Delhi issued the Standard operating Procedure ( SoP) for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification 2006 vide Office Memorandum dated 7th July, 2021. Subsequently, the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Tamil Nadu on 15th July, 2021 issued Order "The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change have issued the impugned office memorandum. Thus, from what we have noted above, we are of the clear view that the petitioner has made out a prima facie case for entertaining the writ petition. Accordingly, the writ petition is admitted and there shall be an order of interim stay. List the matter after twelve weeks."*

The SOP dated 07-07-2021 is presently sub judice and cannot be implemented before the finalisation of the case in Hon'ble High Court of Tamil Nadu.
