The representative of the project proponent Sri T. Laxmi Narayana and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier, it was a determined Mine. The project proponent applied for fresh lease. Accordingly, the lease was granted (in-principle) on 22.01.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 16.03.2022 of ADMG, Suryapet District informing that there are 04 existing quarry leases (ECs granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.353 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 20.122 Ha. and Net cluster area is 1.353 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Lakshmiapuram (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.2 km; nearest water body i.e., Lakshmiapuram canal exists at 54 m (E) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 56,688 m³/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal mine and the life of mine is reported as 6 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.48 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.77 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri SK. Akbar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the project proponent obtained EC dt. 16.10.2015 valid for 4 years. The SEAC noted that, EC was expired and mining was stopped.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 29.01.2016 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 21.10.2021 of ADMG, Mahabubabad District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 1.0 Ha. and Net cluster area is 1.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The ADMG: Mahabubabad District vide letter dt. 21.10.2021 also furnished the details of year-wise dispatch permits for the period from 2015-16 to 2020-21 (upto 21.10.2021). The SEAC observed from the letter that the production quantity was carried out during the period 2016-17 & 2018-19 only and no production was carried out during 2015-16, 2019-20 & 2020-21 (upto 21.10.2021).

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The nearest village to the proposed site is Andanalpahad (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.4 km; nearest water body i.e., a water pond (Cheruvu) exists at 0.45 km (SE) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 1,830.34 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 24 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.61 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.14 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent also submitted a copy of Certificate issued by the Head Master, ZPHS, Mannegudem, Dornakal (M), Mahabubabad District that the proponent donated Almirah worth Rs.10,000/- and Certificate of Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat, Motugadda Thanda (V), Dornakal (M), Mahabubabad district informing that the proponent has donated Rs. 35,000/- for development activities.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 05.01.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 19.02.2022 of ADMG, Jagityal District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.55 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 4.55 Ha. and Net cluster area is 4.55 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

It is observed from the google map that much vegetation exists in the mine lease area. But, it is observed from google timelines that it exists much during non-summer season. Hence, the SEAC considered the proposal.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Habsipur (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.65 km; nearest water body i.e., a small Irrigation canal exists at 105 m (SE) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 1,07,745.2 m³/annum of Colour Granite (Recovery granite @21,549.04 m³ and waste (Road Metal) @86,196.16 m³/annum) and the life of mine is reported as 14 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 45.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.19 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.02 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. But, the SEAC noted that the proposal was uploaded prior to issue of SOP w.r.t. Violation cases. Hence, the SEAC decided to consider the proposal in terms of S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 & S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Stone and Metal Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 & S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 and undergo the process of Public Hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

During presentation, the project proponent informed the Following:

- Sri.C.Gopala Krishna Reddy, has applied for the Grant of quarry lease area in Survey No. 100, Ramakrishnapuram Village, Kothakota Mandal, Mahabubnagar District.
- Government has issued MEMO NO. 18573/M 1(2)2005-1, Dt: 2712.2005 to submit the approved quarry plan mine lease for 20 years .i.e. till 2025
- Department of mines and Geology has given Approved quarry plan vide Lr.No.1898/MP/2007, Dt: 31.08.2007, but lease was not granted.
- Applicant has filled RTI to know the status of the lease grant in 01-11-2014 as per the reply from the Department of mines and geology grant application was under process hence applicant has approached High court. 03/07/2015.
- Hon'ble court has directed Department of mines and Geology to consider for grant of Applied Quarry lease with earlier approved quarry plan.
- Based on the Directions of the court Department of Mines and Geology vide Memo no,27887/R2-2/2015, dt: 30.06.2016 directed to submit the EC and CFE.
- Applicant has applied for the Environmental Clearance to District Committee DEAC/DEIAA, on 18/02/2017.
- Now since the District committee has called off and the applicant has applied for the Environmental Clearance based on the ADMG letter stating the lease is Fresh and no quarry operation started since the quarry lease application is under process.

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The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 27.12.2005 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. However, the Proponent submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 29.12.2021 of ADMG, Wanaparthy District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease and also informed that there is no quarrying operation since it is a fresh and quarry lease application is under process. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.797 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 3.797 Ha. and Net cluster area is 3.797 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Ulindakonda Tanda which is at a distance of 1.11 km and Milasapali exists at a distance of 1.03 km from the mine lease area; nearest water body i.e., an unidentified water body exists at 278 m (N) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 2600 TPA of Quartz; 1000 TPA of Feldspar and the life of mine is reported as 16.39 years.

The SEAC examined the proposal as per the provisions laid under S.O.1223 (E), dt.27.03.2020 & S.O.3636 (E), dt.15.10.2020 & S.O.2859 (E), dt.16.07.2021 and considered the project under B2 Category.

The SEAC noted the contents of EMP report and noted the details of the project as follows:

Total area is 1.0 Acre (4,046.86 Sq.m) out of which Green area is 0.3307 Acres (1,338.44 Sq.m) (33.07%).

Nearest human habitation is Aregudem (V) @ 1.7 km; Nearest water body i.e Vagu @ 490 m (SW) and nearest RF is Choutuppall RF exist at 5.39 km from the industry.

The SEAC noted the EMP measures proposed by the project proponent.

Project Cost is Rs. 8.0 Crores. Budget for Environmental protection towards Capital Cost is Rs. 142.0 Lakhs and Recurring Cost is Rs. 18.0 Lakhs/annum. Budget for CER is Rs. 16.0 lakhs in first 5 years.

The SEAC observed that the total site area is only Ac.1.0 which is less than Ac.2.0. which is the minimum area required for establishment of Buk Drug & Intermediate manufacturing unit located outside Industrial Estate/ Industrial park, as per the guidelines of the SEIAA. In this regard, the proponent informed that though the site area is less than Ac. 2.0, they are meeting all other criteria mentioned in the guidelines as following:
