



MINUTES OF THE 105th MEETING OF STATE LEVEL ENVIRONMENT IMPACT ASSESSMENT AUTHORITY (SEIAA), A.P, HELD ON 01.06.2018 & 02.06.2018 AT VIJAYAWADA, A.P.

Decision of SEIAA: Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC, A.P. for issue of EC.

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Recommendations of the SEAC on 11.05.2018

The representative of the project proponent and their Consultant M/s.SV Enviro Labs & Consultants have attended the meeting and presented their case.

The Committee noted that the mine lease was granted in 2001 by the Ind. & Commerce (Mines- I) Dept. Govt of A.P on 03.11.2001. The Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Markapuram vide letter dated 01.09.2017 stated that no Quartz produced and dispatched during the period 2001 to 2017. It is noted that this is new mine.

The mining plan was approved on 07.06.2017. The Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Markapuram vide letter dated: 28.02.2018, stated that there is one mine lease of Sri. T.Malyadri - 1.834 Ha., within 500 meters. It is noted that this mine and the proposed mine (8.328 Ha.) were comes under cluster with total extent of area is less than 25 Ha. Hence, the present proposal comes under category 'B2' project. The project proponent submitted the cluster EMP.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006- (i). Mining of minerals (<50 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

The Committee recommended for **issue of Environmental Clearance** to this Quartz mining project for the proposed production quantities **Quartz – 5850 TPA**, duly stipulating a condition that the Project Proponent shall maintain the setback distance 7.5 meters buffer zone all around the mine lease area for greenbelt development and other conditions to be fulfilled. The other conditions for underground mining are to be fulfilled. The project proponent shall allocated sufficient funds for implementation of CSR activities (plantation in the nearby villages).

Decision of SEIAA: Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC, A.P. for issue of EC.

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The representative of the project proponent and their Consultant M/s.Team Labs and Consultants, have attended the meeting and presented their case.

The Committee noted that the project proponent submitted the letter issued by the DM&HO , Krishna District that the bed strength is exceeding the 10,000 and there is a necessity of one more Common Biomedical waste treatment facility in the district since there are several Government and private sector health care units, industries, upcoming pharma companies in the District which require safe disposal of biomedical waste generated.

However the accredited consultant has not attended for presentation of their proposal.

On the request of the proponent, the committee recommended to defer the case and the project proponent shall present their proposal through an accredited consultant, for further appraisal.

Decision of SEIAA: *Noted.*

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Recommendations of the SEAC on 11.05.2018

The representative of the project proponent and their Consultant M/s. SV Enviro Labs & Consultants, have attended the meeting and presented their proposed TOR for expansion. They requested for exemption of public hearing.

The Committee noted that the existing unit obtained Environmental Clearance for Distillery unit Rectified Spirit / ENA/Ethanol Fuel - 20 KLPD Molasses based (or) Grain Based and proposed for expansion Rectified Spirit / ENA/Ethanol Fuel - 39 KLPD or Grain Based. The Project Proponent submitted the Transfer of EC in the name of M/s. KBK Biotech Pvt. Ltd. (formerly M/s. Milano Spirits India Pvt. Ltd.) on 02.05.2018.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 5(g) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006: Distilleries. This proposal comes under category 'B1' project.

The Committee recommended for issue of **standard Terms of Reference (TOR)** and accepted for **exemption of public hearing** due to less pollution load, adopting ZLD, only expansion and not new, no additional usage of resources of water, less fuel usage than previous one due to additional methane production, due to 25 to 30% water savings, condensation vapor recovery and other beneficial impacts to be implemented.

Decision of SEIAA: *The SEAC, A.P., is requested to examine their recommendations again, to mention the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 for the said grounds for exemption of public hearing to this proposed project.*
