The Chairman and members of SEAC, T.S., declared that they do not have conflict of interest with any project proponent pertaining to the items discussed in the SEAC meeting held on 28.05.2021.

After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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| Agenda Item No. 01 | 4.00 Ha. Black Granite Mine of M/s. Seven Hills Granite Industry, Sy. Nos. 132,133/1,134,135,136,137 & 211 of Bojervu H/o.Papaiahpet Village, Chennaraopet Mandal, Warangal Rural District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg. |
| Proposal No. | SIA/TG/MIN/211622/2021 (EC) |

The representative of the project proponent attended on Video Call and Sri Venkat Reddy of M/s. Pioneer Enviro Laboratories & Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 05.03.2016 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of lr.dt. 30.04.2021 of ADMG, Warangal (Rural) District informing that there are no existing quarries falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 4.0 Ha. and Net cluster is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Bojeruvu (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.5 km; nearest water body i.e., a stream flows at 0.1 km; Nearest RF is Nayakpalli RF exists at 3.8 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 4,000 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 15 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 100 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 7.26 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.97 Lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the SEAC observed from the photographs and google map that much vegetation exists in the the Northern direction of the mine lease area. In this regard, the project proponent informed that they will not disturb the greenbelt existing in the the Northern direction of the mine lease area, as they will be leaving in the Buffer portion of the mine lease area for development of Greenbelt. It was also assured that they will maintain the said existing greenery and submitted Undertaking for the same.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended the project for issue of EC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 28.01.2016 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

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The Proponent also submitted a copy of Ir.dt. 30.04.2021 of ADMG, Warangal (Rural) District informing that there are two existing quarries (0.743 Ha. & 3.0 Ha. – Leases granted after 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 4.743 Ha. and Net cluster is 4.743 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Lingamadugupalli (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.82 km; nearest water body i.e., Ramappa Cheruvu exists at 60m from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 3,792.60 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 15 years.

It is proposed to mine 1,50,000 m³/annum of Colour Granite and the life of mine is reported as 20 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 100.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 10.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.0 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent attended on Video Call and Sri Shyam Sunder of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 18.0 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 23.04.2021 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing. The SEAC observed from the minutes of the Public Hearing that the issues emerged during public hearing are employment to local people, plantation, repair & maintenance of Roads, not to use Village Roads for transportation of sand to avoid nuisance, accidents, etc., and the proponent agreed to take measures for the same. The SEAC noted the contents of the Final EIA report.

It is proposed to mine 1,36,480 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Kothapalle (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.76 km and nearest RF is Chinnamidisileru RF at 4.53 km from the boundary of the site.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 35.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.50 lakhs. It was informed that they have not proposed recurring cost under EMP Cost, as the project is only for 1 year.

The proponent informed that the depth of proposed sand extraction is 1.0 m. But, the proponent has not submitted any Joint Inspection Report to ascertain the thickness of sand deposited in the proposed sand reach.

The proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 08.04.2021 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing. The SEAC observed from the minutes of the Public Hearing that the issues emerged during public hearing are employment to local people, plantation, develop avenue plantation with fruit bearing & medicinal plants in large scale in project area and surrounding villages, etc., and the proponent agreed to take measures for the same. The SEAC noted the contents of the Final EIA report.

It is proposed to mine 2,40,000 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

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The nearest village to the proposed site is Chinnaravigudem (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.24 km and nearest RF is Pedda Midisileru RF at 2.0 km from the boundary of the site.

It is noted that the mine lease area is 24.96 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 23.04.2021 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing. The SEAC observed from the minutes of the Public Hearing that the issues emerged during public hearing are employment to local people, plantation, not to use Village Roads for transportation of sand to avoid nuisance, accidents, etc., and the proponent agreed to take measures for the same. The SEAC noted the contents of the Final EIA report.

It is proposed to mine 1,79,702 m³/annum (Maximum Capacity) of Ordinary Sand by manual open excavation method.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Mummidaram (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.35 km and nearest RF is Konodayyaguden3.26 RF at 4.53 km from the boundary of the site.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.0 lakhs. It was informed that they have not proposed recurring cost under EMP Cost, as the project is only for 1 year.

The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 8.0 Ha, which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 31.03.2021 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing. The SEAC observed from the minutes of the Public Hearing that the issues emerged during public hearing are employment to local people, repair & maintenance of Roads, roads safety, etc., and the proponent agreed to take measures for the same. The SEAC noted the contents of the Final EIA report.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Elabotharam (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.57 km; nearest water body i.e., Kakatiya Main Canal exist at 1.13 m from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 54,000 m³/annum of Colour Granite and the life of mine is reported as 44 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 80.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 8.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.0 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 12.01.2021 informed the proponent to submit a copy of NOC issued by the I&CAD Department w.r.t the proposed mine.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted a copy of NOC issued vide lr. dt. 04.05.2021 issued by the Executive Engineer, I&CAD Dept., LMD Colony, Karimnagar. In the letter, it was reported that during construction of Lower Manair Dam, the I&CAD dept. has acquired the lands for submergence purpose in various villages & the Nustulapur Village is one of the submerged villages. The said land in Sy. No. 497 is a hillock area with metal quarry. It is observed that previously, the I&CAD Dept. issued NOC on 17.02.1994 and the ADMG issued work order on 05.05.2000 quarry to M/s. Sai Shakthi Stone Crusher (2.0 Ha.) for a period of 15 years from 05.05.2000 to 04.05.2015 and again in the year 2009, the ADMG, Karimnagar granted quarry lease to Sri Mannalal Gupta (2.0 Ha) for a period of 10 years from 29.04.2009 to 28.04.2019. Again on 02.02.2019, the ADMG vide Procds. Dt. 02.02.2019 transferred the quarry lease in favour of M/s. Real Constructions for a period upto 28.04.2019. The proposed quarry site is 4.60 km from the toe point at Ch. 325.00 of Right Flank Earth Dam. The I&CAD Dept., considered the project for NOC for lease of quarry subject to certain conditions.

One of the conditions in NOC is "Quarrying shall not be done above the average bed level i.e., (+835.00 Ft) of the LMD Reservoir only". But, the SEAC observed that the proponent has not yet furnished the contours of the mine w.r.t. LMD and distance of the mine from FTL of the reservoir. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit the same.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project after submission of above information by the proponent.

It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 5.0 Ha. and Net cluster is 5.0 Ha. The nearest village to the proposed site is Kambalapur (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.4 km; nearest water body i.e., a Lake exist at 0.2 km (W) & Tatipamula Cheruvu exists at 0.4 km (N) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 30,000 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 90 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.98 Lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 03.05.2021 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 547.65 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 792.48 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 5890.75 Sq.m., Net plot area is 5558.64 Sq.m., out of which green area is 557.56 Sq.m. (10.03%).

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It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 63,571.50 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments to accommodate 58 units. Maximum no. of floors proposed in the project are 3B + G + 38 Floors.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 11,826.0 Sq.m., (22.85 % against required 22%).
