The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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<b>Agenda Item No. 01</b>	<b>1.0 Ha. Black Granite Mine of M/s. Sri Venkateshwara Granites and Polishing Unit, Survey No.142, 152 and 153, Gondriyala Village, Ananthagiri Mandal, Suryapet District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.</b>
<b>Proposal No.</b>	<b>SIA/TG/MIN/429198/2023 (EC)</b>

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Naveen and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the lease was executed on dt.05.11.2007 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years i.e upto 04.11.2027. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan.

It is proposed to mine 1,264.48 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 21 years.

The Nearest human habitation is Gondriyala (V) @ 0.32 km (S); Nearest water body i.e., Paleru River exists at a distance of 0.4 km (W) and Nearest RF is Gandrayi RF existing at a distance of 6.3 km (SE) from the mine lease area.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 15.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 1.84 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.03 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.03.05.2023 of ADMG, Suryapet District, furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period from 2007-08 to 2022-23. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2007-08; 2008-09; 2010-11 to 2017-18 and from 2020-21 to 2022-23 and Nil during the period 2009-10; 2018-19 & 2019-20.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.20.05.2023 issued by the Panchayath Secretary, Gondriyala (V), Ananthagiri (M), Suryapet District stating that the proponent has donated Rs.50,000 /- for development of the village.

The proponent submitted copy of land document dt.07.08.2020 for development of greenbelt in an area of Acres 9.3600 Gts.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The SEAC deferred the project, as the proponent did not attend the meeting.

Hence, the SEAC decided to inform the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

The representative of the project proponent Sri B.Chenna Kesava Reddy and Smt. Lochana of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech (P) Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

  
CHAIRMAN, SEAC

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The SEAC noted that the initial lease was granted on dt. 03.01.2018 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 10.04.2023 of ADMG, Khammam District informing that there is another quarry lease of (3.750 Ha. – lease granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from proposed mine lease area. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 8.750 Ha. and Net cluster area is 5.0 Ha. which is equal to 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Ayyavarigudem (V) exists at a distance 1.3 km (W); nearest water body i.e., Kattaleru canal exists at a distance of 2.143 km (W) and Nearest RF is Bhimavaram RF exists at a distance of 54.37 mts (S) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine average production of 43,403.36 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal, Gravel and the life of mine is reported as 32 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.2 lakhs and recurrings cost: Rs. 1.9 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Lr. Dt.16.05.2023 issued by ADMG, Khammam District. It is observed from the letter that on verification of their office records there is no dispatch permits issued to the proponent and physical observations, there is a small excavations noticed at North West Direction of applied area, which were done by the local veddera peoples, and the boulders utilized in their domestic needs only. But the applicant have not conducting any excavations after filing the application in the subject area.

The proponent has obtained NOC dt.25.02.2023 issued by DFO, Khammam District, Forest Department and submitted a copy of the same.

The proponent also submitted copy of land document dt.07.04.2018 for developing greenbelt in their own patta land with an extent of Acres 5.04 at Sy.No. 149/a, Ayyavarigudem Village, Yerrupalem Mandal, Khammam District which is at a distance of 441 mts from the mine lease area.

The SEAC noted that thick vegetation was observed within the proposed site, SEAC informed the proponent to submit the NOC from concerned authority under WALTA Act.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the project proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri J.V.L. Ganapathi and Sri J. Rahul and Smt. Shaheda Begum of M/s. EPTRI, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

#### **Project Background:**

- Coal mining operations in RK No.8 Incline started in the year 1983.
- The mine was operated without Environmental Clearance.
- In accordance with MoEF&CC No.J-20012/11/98-IA.II (M) dt. 28.10.2004, Environmental Clearance was required to be obtained at the time of renewal of Mining Lease in the year 2005-06.
- SCCL submitted an application in Form-1 for obtaining Environmental Clearance as per S.O. No. 804 (E), dt. 14.03.2017 under violation category.
- Due to exhaustion of coal reserves, the mining operations were completed on 09.10.2020.

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- At present Final mine closure activities are under implementation stage as per the approved Final Mine Closure Plan by MoC, GoI., and will continue up to 2023-24.
- Form-1 was submitted on 13.05.2017.
- Application for EC was submitted on 12.05.2023.
- EAC meeting for ToR was held on 30.05.2017.

**Statutory Clearances:**

- Mining Plan & Final Mine Closure Plan
- Mining Plan (1<sup>st</sup> Revision) & Final Mine Closure Plan was approved by MoC on 08<sup>th</sup> March, 2018.
- Mining Lease – Total Project area – 165.47 Ha
- 109.66 Ha (out of 4494 Ha) was obtained vide G.O.Ms.NO 1, dtd 12.01.2015 and valid for a period 20 years from 22.05.2010 3<sup>rd</sup> Renewal of North Godavari Mining Lease.
- 53.83 Ha (out of 2044.34 Ha) was obtained vide G.O.Ms.No. 9 I&C Dept, dated 16.04.2022 with validity up to 28.07.2030 2<sup>nd</sup> renewal of Indaram Mining Lease.
- 2.98 Ha (out of 938.85 Ha) was obtained Vide GO.NO. 42 I&C dated 11.02.2008, which is valid up to 27.06.2038 (30 years) Srirampur Mining Lease.

  - WLCP for Srirampur Area mines including RK No.8 Incline Underground Coal Mining Project was approved by PCCF (HOFF) & Chief Wildlife Warden, Govt. of Telangana for an amount of Rs.526.367 Lakhs for conservation of Schedule-I species.

Now, the proponent informed that the present proposal is for expansion for a production capacity of 0.16 MTPA within the same project area of 165.47 Ha as they want to regularize the Violation.

The proponent informed that they have obtained CFO vide order dt.05.08.2016 with validity upto 30.06.2021.

The SEAC noted that Public Hearing was conducted by TSPCB on 11.04.2023.

Public Hearing issues are: Implement pollution control measures; Conduct medical facilities; Conduct skill development training; employment to educated youth; CSR funds should be spent on effected villages; construct C.C.Roads, bore wells and street lighting; Greenbelt development in and around the project and surrounding villages; Provide tricycles to differently able people. The proponent informed: Implement all pollution control measures; about 2600 jobs were given to unemployed youth in outsourcing jobs; will arrange medical camps in surrounding villages; development of parks with open gym facility will be provided; Extensive plantation in the vacant land under harithaharam and vriksharopan abhiyan programmes; Tricycles will be allocated and distributed to differently able people.

The proponent informed that EE, RO, Nizamabad, TSPCB has filed a case under section 19 of the E(P) Act, 1986 vide CC No. 660/2020 for violation in the court of Hon'ble Junior Civil Court Mancherial on 10.09.2020 and levevied penalty of Rs. 1,00,000 and penalty was paid by the proponent and submitted copies of the supporting documents.

Project cost is Rs. 5.91 Crores; EMP Cost – Capital cost is Rs. 9.86 Lakhs and Recurring Cost is Rs. 16.0 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent informed that they have collected the baseline data from October 2020 – December 2020.

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The proponent informed the following:

- CSR activities are being carried out continuously in the surrounding habitats of SCCL.
- Emphasis is being given on roads & infrastructure, drains & sanitation, education, drinking water, etc.
- An amount of Rs.2135.784 Lakhs has been spent under SHAPE/CSR programmes up to 2021-22.

The SEAC noted that the proponent has obtained TORs on 13.05.2019 from MoEF&CC, New Delhi under expansion though they have not applied for additional production. It is further noted that the TOR issued before O.M. dt.07.07.2021 and O.M dt.28.01.2021. Hence, penalty is not applicable except Bank Gurantee.

The proponent informed that due to excess production (i.e from 1983-84 to 2020-21) they have violated the rules, to regularize they have applied for expansion. However, there will not be any increase in the production capacity.

The SEAC noted that there is no specific guidelines for calculating bank guarantee for coal mine, hence SEAC considered the BG submitted by the proponent.

The SEAC examined the same and found that the level of damage for the present project is Low. Accordingly, the amount of Bank Guarantee to be submitted for implementation of Remediation plan, Natural Resource Augmentation Plan and community Resource Augmentation plan is worked out to be Rs. 52.0 lakhs and the details are as follows:

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Environmental clearance (Expansion) subject to approval by the SEIAA for Submission of Bank Guarantee for an amount of Rs. 52,00,000 (Fifty two lakhs only).

The representative of the project proponent Sri Shivek Gupta and Sri Venkat Reddy of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Auto- generated) on 20.01.2023 for preparation of EIA Report exempting Public hearing as per S.O.3250 (E) dt.20.07.2022 under which EC will be granted along with exemption from public hearing for industry whose Rolling mill capacity is more than 5000 TPA. The proponent obtained CFE vide Order dt.28.04.2006; CFE for Expansion vide Order dt.18.09.2017 and CFE for Expansion vide Order dt.28.02.2020. The proponent also obtained CFO vide Order dt.19.05.2022.

The SEAC noted that the proposal is for existing Rolling Mill for M.S. CTD bars/TMT bars/ M.S. Rounds manufacturing unit.

The following are the proposed project details:

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The SEAC noted the details of the project as follows:

The SEAC noted that the total area is Acres 5.44, there is no sufficient vacant land available for development of greenbelt. In this regard, the proponent submitted undertaking Ir.dt.31.05.2023 on the following:

- They will develop greenbelt in addition to the existing vacant land within the premises i.e Acres 1.0 which is adjacent to the existing plant, the land belongs to their company i.e Dhanlaxmi Iron Industries Private Limited. The proponent submitted sale deed land documents for the same.
- They will not take any construction activity in the land proposed for Greenbelt development in Acres 1.0 land.

Nearest human habitation is Bonthapally (V) @ 0.05 km; Nearest water body i.e Nallakunta Cheruvu exists at a distance of 0.32 km; Nearest RF i.e., Bonthapally RF @ 2.05 km from the industry.

Project Cost is Rs. 20.77 Crores. EMP cost - Capital cost Rs. 127.0 Lakhs & Recurring cost is Rs. 12.9 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent informed that they have submitted a copy of Certificate dt.30.04.2015 issued by the Executive Officer, Gram Panchayath, Bonthapally Village, Jinnaram Mandal, Medak District informing that the proponent spent Rs. 12,00,000 for construction of 2,50,000 Litres Capacity Water tank in the village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Satish and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 05.05.2023 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Ir.dt.11.05.2023 issued by ADMG, Sangareddy District informing that there are no quarry leases existing within 500mts from the proposed mine lease area. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.214 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Kodekal (V) exists at a distance of 1.6 km (NE); nearest water body i.e Baswapur Cheruvu exists at a distance of 1.9 km (SW) and Nearest RF is Chatkuri RF exists at a distance of 4.2 km (SE) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine maximum production of 35,718.9 TPA of Fullers Earth (White) and the life of mine is reported as 5 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 10.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 1.96 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.33 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri J.V.L. Ganapathi and Sri J. Rahul of M/s. EPTRI, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

**Project Details:**

- Coal mining operations in RK-5 started in the year 1974.
- Environmental Clearance was granted on 24.10.2008 for a capacity of 0.50 MTPA in the project area of 376.20 ha.
- In order to meet the demand from the coal based industries in the region, excess production of 4.27 Lakh tonnes was produced from RK-5 Incline for six years period from 2008-09 to 2013-14 beyond the sanctioned EC capacity and hence is considered under violation category as per EIA Notification, 2006.
- SCCL submitted Form-1 to MoEF&CC on 13.07.2013 for obtaining EC under violation category, but the proposal was delisted by MoEF&CC for want of credible action by the State Government.
- Form-1 was submitted on 09.04.2018.
- EAC meeting for ToR was held on 28.03.2019.
- ToRs was issued on 21.10.2019 by MoEF&CC, GoI.
- Application for EC was submitted on 15.05.2023

**Statutory Clearances:**

Mining Plan & Mine Closure Plan:

- MoC, GoI, has approved Mining Plan for RK-5, Dt.26-02-2008.

The SEAC noted that Public Hearing was conducted by TSPCB on 16.02.2023.

Public Hearing issues are: Implement pollution control measures; Conduct medical facilities; Conduct skill development training; employment to educated youth; CSR funds should be spent on effected villages; construct C.C.Roads, bore wells and street lighting; Greenbelt development in and around the project and surrounding villages. The proponent informed: Implement all pollution control measures; about 2600 jobs were given to unemployed youth in outsourcing jobs; will arrange medical camps in surrounding villages; development of parks with open gym facility will be provided; Extensive plantation in the vacant land under harithaharam and vriksharopan abhiyan programmes.

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The proponent informed that EE, RO, Nizamabad, TSPCB has filed a case under section 19 of the E(P) Act, 1986 vide CC No. 659/2020 for violation in the court of Hon'ble additional Junior Magistrate of F.C, Mancherial on 04.11.2020 and levied penalty of Rs. 1,00,000 and penalty was paid by the proponent and submitted copies of the supporting documents.

The proponent submitted Certified Compliance Report dt. 11.10.2022 on earlier EC conditions issued by the Integrated Regional office of MoEF&CC, GoI, Hyderabad.

Project cost is Rs. 32.20 Crores; EMP Cost – Capital cost is Rs. 54.20 Lakhs and Recurring Cost is Rs. 122.80 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent informed that they have collected the baseline data from October 2022 – December 2022.

The proponent informed the following:

- CSR activities are being carried out continuously in the surrounding habitats of SCCL.
- Emphasis is being given on roads & infrastructure, drains & sanitation, education, drinking water, etc.
- An amount of Rs.2135.784 Lakhs has been spent under CSR programmes up to 2021-22.

The SEAC noted that the proponent has obtained TORs on 21.10.2019 from MoEF&CC, New Delhi under expansion though they have not applied for additional production. It is further noted that the TOR issued before O.M. dt.07.07.2021 and O.M dt.28.01.2021. Hence, penalty is not applicable except Bank Guarantee.

The SEAC considered the project under violation and to process it as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 & S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI.

The SEAC noted that there is no specific guidelines for calculating bank guarantee for coal mine, hence SEAC considered the BG submitted by the proponent.



Subsequently, renewal of lease was granted (in-principle) on 05.09.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 5.0 Ha. which is equal to 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Malkapur (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.43 km (W); nearest water body i.e Malkapur lake exists at 0.65 km (W) & nearest RF is Malkapuram RF @ 138 mts (SE) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 2,51,160.0 m<sup>3</sup>/annum (Average Production) of Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 17 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.80 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.90 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt.25.10.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District furnishing the details of permitted quantity particulars during the period 2007-08 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that permitted quantity particulars were issued during the period 2008-09; 2009-10 and from 2017-18 to 2020-21 & Nil during the period 2007-08; 2010-11 to 2016-17 & 2021-22.

The proponent submitted a copies of Certificates dt.21.08.2022 & 15.06.2022 issued by the Sarpanch of Malkapur (V) & Kaithapur (V) , Choutuppall (M), Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District stating that the proponent has donated Metal of worth Rs. 1,50,300 /- for developmental activities (water filter, School & Temple) of the village.

The proponent also submitted copy of land document for developing greenbelt in their own patta land with an extent of Acres 4-01 Gts at Sy.No. 386, Malkapur(V), Choutuppall (M), Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District which is at a distance of 1.3 km from the mine lease area.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The SEAC noted the lease was granted (in-principle) on 26.02.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent also submitted a copy of lr. dt.05.01.2023 of ADMG, Rangareddy District informing that there are three other quarry leases of Sri. Mohd. Abdul Arshad (4.0 Ha. - lease granted before 09.09.2013); Sri Mohd Ajass Ali (3.86 Ha. – lease granted after 09.09.2013) and Sri Pochampally Ram Reddy (4.83 Ha - lease granted after 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 3.50 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 16.19 Ha. and Net cluster area is 12.19 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 1,14,333.60 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Rough Stone and Road Metal and life of mine is 7.50 years.

Nearest human habitation is Chowdergudem (V) @ 1.07 km (W) and Nearest water body exists at 0.23 km; Nearest R.F exists at Elakcherla R.F 7.30 km (W) from the mine lease area.

The proponent informed that they collected the baseline data from February – April 2023 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Stone and Road Metal. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from February – April 2023 for preparation of EIA report.

The proponent also submitted copy of land document dt.15.04.2018 for developing greenbelt in their own patta land with an extent of Acres 2.0 at Sy.No. 174/19, Toompally (V), Jilled Chowdergudem (M), Rangareddy District which is at a distance of 0.57 km from the mine lease area.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from February – April 2023, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for “Mining of Minerals” and undergo the process of Public Hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri. A.Ravinder Smt. T. Rajini of M/s. EHS360 Labs Private Limited, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 19.03.2019 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report. The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 03.04.2023 of ADMG, Sangareddy District informing that there are 9 other quarry leases of (5.0 Ha.; 4.9 Ha.; 4.5 Ha.; 4.71 Ha.; 4.5 Ha.; 12.08 Ha.; 2.93 Ha.; 2.0 Ha. & 10.0 Ha. – all the leases are granted after 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from proposed mine lease area. The proponent total land is 20.0 Ha. out of which the ADMG as issued for mining to an extent of only 5.26 Ha. The proponent informed that during the re-survey the land was reduced from Ha. to 5.26 Ha. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 5.26 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 55.88 Ha. and Net cluster area is 55.88 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

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The nearest human habitation is Yerdanoor @ 0.731 km (SW); Nearest water body i.e., Naka Vagu exists at a distance of 1.43 km (N) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine an average of 4,23,300 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 11 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 60.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 6.9 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.25 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC observed from the KML file, that water body is adjacent to the proposed site and also entering into the proposed site and hence the SEAC informed the proponent to obtain NOC from I&CAD Department.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the project proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Mohan Reddy Smt. T. Rajini of M/s. EHS360 Labs Private Limited, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the initial lease was executed on dt.09.08.2007 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years i.e upto 08.08.2022 for 2.0 Ha. Another lease was granted on 24.11.2014 in favour of the proponent for 4.0 Ha for a period of 15 years i.e upto 23.11.2029. Later, amalgamation of the two quarry leases into single quarry lease with total extent of 6.0 Ha. was granted on 18.12.2014 with co-terminus of 1<sup>st</sup> lease period i.e upto 08.08.2022. Then, part surrender of lease of 2.0 Ha. The, LOI was granted (in-principle) on 15.10.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha., the project has to be considered under B2 Category, but the proponent has carried out mining operations after expiry of the mine lease. hence it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 2,24,074.40 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Stone & Road Metal. The Mine was operated as per lr. dt. 17.10.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District, without obtaining prior EC.

The nearest village Jainpalle (V) exists at a distance 1.36 km (SE); nearest water body i.e Jainpalle Lake exists at a distance of 650 mts (SE), SEAC noted another waterbody is existing at a distance of 70 mts and Naginenipalli RF exists at 844 mts (W) from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they collected the baseline data from February – April 2023 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Stone and Road Metal. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from February – April 2023 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the above baseline data, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit final EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

Earlier the SEIAA in its meeting held on 23.05.2023 noted that the mine lease was granted on 31.07.2007 for an extent of 5.67 Ha. for a period of 20 years. Subsequently, the lease was transferred on 01.11.2016 in favour of the proponent for unexpired period upto 18.12.2027. The mine lease area was reduced to 4.28 Ha. after surrender of 1.39 Ha. from 03.03.2023 onwards. Hence, the matter was referred back to SEAC to ascertain whether the mine falls under violation category or not as per the EIA Notification, 2006 & its amendments.

The SEAC noted that the proponent has operated mining from 2007 without obtaining EC though it is categorized B2 but attracts EIA as the mine area is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, rejected.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for rejection of EC.

The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.63 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village Sivanagar (V) exists at a distance of 1.65 km (NE); nearest water body i.e undefined water body at a distance of 85 m and nearest RF is Kodakanchi RF exists at a distance of 1.3 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 1,19,844 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal & 18,780 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Gravel and the life of mine is reported as 7 years for Building stone and Road metal & 7.8 years for Gravel.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 9.1 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.4 Lakhs/annum.
