The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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Agenda Item No. 01	Mahaveer Crystal by M/s. K.B. Chandramouli HUF and Others, Sy. Nos. 136/A, 138/1D, Gudimalkapur, Asif Nagar, Hyderabad District. – Amendment to Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIS/279094/2022 (MODI-EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Saikiran and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt. 11.10.2021 for Residential Apartments Construction project with builtup area 2,36,392.2 Sq.m.

It was informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 22.02.2021 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 509.3 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 684.3 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

The SEAC observed that a nala flows adjacent to site. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of NOC dt.17.04.2021 issued by the EE, Hussain Sagar Lake Division, Hyderabad of I&CAD Dept. The SEAC observed from the document that there is a nala (box drain) existing on south side to the applicant site. 2m buffer zone is considered where there is no nala existing on ground based on the nala width of 44 links (i.e., 8.8 m) mentioned in the Revenue sketch and 9m is taken where there is a drain existing on ground which is more than 10 m width as per the records at south side. The area affected in the buffer zone is 9.2 Guntas as per the G.O.Ms.No. 168, dt. 07.04.2012. Accordingly, the proponent proposed the layout of the project.

Now, the proponent informed that the present proposal is for Amendment due to increase in builtup area, No. of units, Water requirement, Wastewater generation, Solid waste, STP Capacity, project cost and EMP Cost. It was also informed that the construction is under foundation stage. Hence, it was requested issue amendment to EC with the following changes:

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Agenda Item No. 02	1.51 Ha. Building Stone & Road Metal Quarry of M/s. Sri Ganesh Stone Crusher, Sy. No. 377, Suvarnapuram (V), Mudigonda (M), Khammam District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/278567/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Bhavesh Patel and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier the lease was granted on 13.06.1997 in favour of proponent for a period of 15 years. Further, the 1st renewal of quarry lease was granted on 23.03.2013 for a further period of 15 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was initially granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.51 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 27.05.2022 of ADMG, Khammam District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2013-14 to 2022-23 (upto May 22). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2013-14 to 2022-23 (upto May 22).

The SEAC observed that even after renewal of quarry lease, the proponent continued mining operations from 2013-14 without obtaining EC. Hence, it is considered as violation case. But, it is observed from the proposal is applied under EC.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, te SEAC recommended for Rejection of proposal.

Agenda Item No. 03	4.7 Ha. Rough Stone & Road Metal Mine of M/s. Swamy Constructions, Sy. No. 201, Amangal (V&M), Rangareddy District. - Environmental Clearance – Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/262572/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Sarada and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 03.07.2021 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 18.05.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District informing that there is one existing quarry lease (lease granted after 09.09.2013 but non working since execution of lease i.e., for more than 3 years) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.7 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 14.7 Ha. and Net cluster area is 4.7 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Shakibanda Thanda which is existing at a distance of 830m (SW); nearest water body exists at 1.73 km (SW); nearest RF i.e., Amangal RF exists at 3.7 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine an average quantity of 94,950.80 m³/annum (peak production – 1,30,572 m³/annum) of Rough Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 12.40 years (@94,950.80 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.80 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.10 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

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Agenda Item No. 04	4.0 Ha. Building Stone & Road Metal Quarry of of Sri N. Laxma Reddy, Sy. No. 72, Govindapur (V), Mominpet (M), Vikarabad District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/279287/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Laxma Reddy and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent obtained CFO vide order dt. 09.09.2017 valid upto 30.04.2022.

The proponent informed that earlier the lease was granted on 27.07.2010 in favour of proponent for a period of 10 years. Further, the 1st renewal of quarry lease was granted on 16.02.2022 for a period of 10 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Govindpur (V) exists at a distance 1.53 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e., Pedda Cheruvu exists at 1.14km; Nearest RF i.e., Ekammamidi RF exists at 5.6 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine an average quantity of 58,131.8 m³/annum (Maximum production – 59,916 m³/annum) of Building Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 22 years (@58,131.8 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 45.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.80 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.50 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 29.06.2022 of ADMG, Vikarabad District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2010-11 to 2020-21 (upto Sept 20). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2011-12 to 2020-21 (upto Sept 20) except during 2010-11.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificates dt.20.03.2019 & 10.06.2020 issued by Sarpanch of Govindapur (V), Mominpet (M), Vikarabad District stating that the proponent has donated an amount of worth Rs. 1,00,000/- for constrection of water tankers and Rs. 50,000/- for street lights.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 05	4.0 Ha. Road Metal & Building Stone M/s. Sai Vikas Stone Crushing Industries, Sy. No 64 & 76 (Patta Land), Deshmukhi (V), B.Pochampally (M), Yadadri - Bhuvanagiri District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/279532/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Ch. Suryanarayana and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier the lease was granted on 09.06.2008 in favour of proponent for a period of 15 years. Further, the 1st renewal of quarry lease was granted on 28.04.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Deshmukhi (V) exists at a distance 1.89 km from the proposed site; nearest water body exists at 1.68 km (NE); Nearest RF i.e., Kawadipalli RF exists at 3.2 km from the boundary of the site.

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It is proposed to mine an average quantity of 80,440.0 m³/annum (Peak production – 1,48,200.0 m³/annum) of Road Metal & Building Stone and the life of mine is reported as 11 years (@80,440.0 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.50 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 25.04.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2008-09 to 2020-21. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2008-09 to 2020-21.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificates dt.25.05.2022 issued by Sarpanch of Deshmukhi (V), B.Pochampally (M), Yadadri - Bhuvanagiri District stating that the proponent has donated furniture for Grampanchayat Office of worth Rs. 2,11,794/-.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 06	8.91 Ha. Velchal Laterite Quarry of Smt. G. Archana Reddy, Sy. No. 260 of Velchal (V), Mominpeta (M), Vikarabad District. – Extension of Environmental Clearance validity - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/279542/2022 (MODI-EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri G.Vishveshwar Reddy and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the initial lease was granted on 20.12.2016 for a period of 20 yrs. The proponent has obtained EC from SEIAA, TS on 03.11.2016 of Laterite Mine with production of 2,00,000 TPA which is valid upto 02.11.2021.

The proponent CFE obtained from TSPCB vide order dt. 03.12.2016 and CFO obtained from TSPCB vide order dt. 10.01.2017 valid up to 30.11.2021.

During presentation, the proponent informed that in the MoEF&CC Notification S.O.221(E), dt. 18.01.2021 it was mentioned that “9A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this notification, the period from the 1st April, 2020 to the 31st March, 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of prior Environmental Clearances granted under the provisions of this notification in view of outbreak of Corona Virus (COVID-19) and subsequent lockdowns (total or partial) declared for its control, however, all activities undertaken during this period in respect of the Environmental Clearance granted shall be treated as valid”. With this notification, EC validity is extended up to one year i.e., 02.11.2022, as informed by the proponent.

Now, the present proposal is for validity extension of EC for further period of 07 years with proposed production capacity of 2,00,000 TPA. As per lease execution order issued by ADMG, Tandur validity of mine lease is upto 19.12.2036. Hence, the proponent submitted proposal for extension of validity period of EC.

The proponent submitted a letter stating that their lease was not yet executed and they have not yet started mining operations. Due to health reasons they could not approach for Extension of Validity of Environmental Clearance. The SEAC considered the proposal as it was observed that the proponent submitted the proposal on 22.06.2022 i.e., within 30 days from the validity period of earlier EC (03.11.2016 to 02.11.2022) and condoned the delay.

The proponent submitted copy of lr.dt.27.06.2022 of the ADMG, Tandur, Vikarabad District furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2016-17 to 2021-22 (upto Nov 21). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2017-18 to 2021-22 (upto Nov 21) except during 2016-17.

It is proposed to mine 2,00,000 TPA of Laterite and the life of mine is reported as 7 years as per latest Approved Mining Plan.

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The proponent submitted a copy certificate dt. 10.06.2022 issued by the Sarpanch, Velchal (V), Mominpeta (M), Vikarabad District informing that the proponent has donated Rs.1,00,000/- for CC Cameras in Village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of extension of validity of EC.

Agenda Item No. 07	8.093 Ha. Laterite Mine of Sri. K. Veera Bhadra Rao, Sy. No. 60/2, Mallampalli (V), Mulugu (M), Mulugu District. – Extension of Environmental Clearance validity - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/279568/2022 (MODI-EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri K.Krishnakanth and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Envirotech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier the proponent applied the proposal no. SIA/TG/MIN/233289/2021 for Extension of EC. Accordingly, the SEAC examined the proposal

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- *Initial lease was granted on 04.09.1998 for a period of 20 yrs i.e., upto 03.09.2018. Later, applied for 1st renewal and lease was granted on 08.03.2019 for a period of 20 yrs. The proponent has obtained EC from SEIAA, TS on 09.10.2015 with a validity upto 08.10.2021 of Laterite Mine with production of 3,00,000 TPA.*
- *In the MoEF&CC Notification S.O.221(E), dt. 18.01.2021 it was mentioned that “9A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this notification, the period from the 1st April, 2020 to the 31st March, 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of prior Environmental Clearances granted under the provisions of this notification in view of outbreak of Corona Virus (COVID-19) and subsequent lockdowns (total or partial) declared for its control, however, all activities undertaken during this period in respect of the Environmental Clearance granted shall be treated as valid”. With this notification, EC validity is extended up to one year i.e., 08.10.2022.*
- *The proponent obtained CFE from TSPCB vide order dt. 21.02.2019 and CFO vide order dt. 09.09.2020.*
- *The mining plan is approved by the Deputy Director of Mines and Geology, Warangal for Laterite production of 3,00,000 TPA dt. 17.12.2021.*
- *As per the old mining plan, the life of the mine was given as 6 years i.e., upto October 2021. No mining operations were carried out since EC order granted.*
- *As per the revised mining plan life of the mine is extended up to 22 years.*

The proponent further informed the following and submitted supporting documents:

- *The lease was granted in 1998 in the name of Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao over an extent of 20.00 acres in Sy. No. 60/2, Mallampally (V), Mulugu (M), Mulugu district Telangana by the Director of Mines and Geology vide proceedings no: 1061/M/98, dated 04-09-1998 for a period of 20 years upto 03-09-2018.*
- *The mining operations commenced in 1998 and went on till 2011. Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao is paying dead rents on yearly basis.*
- *In the year 2006, Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha created fake documents and filed a case against the state government and Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao stating that the land belongs to Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha.*
- *While the case was going on, in the year 2010, court granted temporary injunction order to stop the mining operations.*
- *In 2011, the government enquired about the issue and resumed the land and taken over the land to their custody, as the land is ceiling surplus land belongs to G.M. Omer Khan who surrendered to government in the year 1991.*
- *In the year 2017, the case filed by Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha was dismissed by the court.*

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- Subsequently, again in the year 2018, M/s. Ganesh Mines & Minerals had filed writ petition in single bench of high court vide petition no 28339 of 2018 against the state government and Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao. Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha were impleaded in this case stating that the land belongs to them. Subsequently, the court dismissed the writ petition in 2018 after hearings.
- Again in the year 2019, M/s. Ganesh Mines & Minerals aggrieved by the single bench order and filed a writ appeal vide 14 of 2019 against state government and Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao in Divisional Bench at High Court. In the event of arguments the high court directed the District Collector of Mulugu District to provide a detailed report on the land situated at Sy. No. 60/2.
- Accordingly, the District Collector had filed affidavit in high court stating that land belongs to state government, being ceiling surplus land surrendered by surplus land owner Sri. G.M. Omer Khan as per the orders of honourable tribunal (land reforms) Warangal by order dated 18-02-1991 and also stated that created fake registered documents to grab the government land. Now, the land has been resumed by the government. On hearing the arguments of all the parties, the honourable high court dismissed the writ appeal no 14 of 2019.
- By the time, the 1st renewal of lease was granted in 08-03-2019 to Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao with a condition of subject to the outcome of writ appeal no 14 of 2019 and the mining department after having enquired about the land details with the revenue department and also the following court orders, the mining department issued 1st renewal work order to Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao for a further period of 20 years w.e.f from 04-09-2018 to 03-09-2038 dated 22-11-2021 vide proceeding no 1998/1/Q/2017 dated 22-11-2021.
- Subsequently, again Sri. Pindi Ravi and Smt. Pindi Rajitha filed a case against state government and Sri. K. Veerabhara Rao & family at 1st Additional Senior Civil Judge, Warangal dated 14-03-2022 claiming that the land is belongs to them. After the arguments in the court, the petition has been dismissed on 29-04-2022 stating that the land belongs to the government and petitioners are claiming the land with false, fabricated and bogus documents and also stated that the petitioners are not approached the court with clean hands and created the documents to grab the government land.
- Hence, with these issues Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao did not operate the quarry from 2011 to till date. Now, all the issues have been cleared by the honourable courts and state government. Sri. K. Veerabhadra Rao will start mining operations after obtaining Extension of Environmental Clearance and CFE / CFO.

Now, the proponent is requesting to grant EC Validity Extension for 22 years.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Ummayyanagar (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.0 km; nearest water body exists at 1 km (E); nearest RF i.e., Jakaram RF exists at 370m from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 3,00,000 TPA of Laterite and the life of mine is reported as 22 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.2 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.0 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 08.02.2012 of ADMG, Warangal District furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 1998-99 to 2010-11. It is observed from the letter that production quantity was carried out during the period 2000-01 to 2005-06, 2007-08 & 2009-10 to 2010-11 and no production was carried out during 1998-99 to 1999-2000, 2006-07 & 2008-09.

The proponent also submitted a copy of lr. dt. 08.02.2012 of ADMG, Warangal District & lr. dt. 01.04.2022 of ADMG, Mulugu District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 1998-99 to 2010-2011 & 2011-12 to 2021-22 respectively. It is observed from the letter that no permits were issued during 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2008-09 and from 2011-12 to 2021-22.

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The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.18.10.2021 issued by the Head Master, ZPHS, Mallampalli (V), Mulugu (M), Mulugu District stating that the proponent has donated Computer for School and other needs of students of worth Rs.30,000/-.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of extension of validity of EC.

Accordingly, the proposal was placed in SEIAA meeting held on 14.06.2022 and examined by the authority and observed the following:

The SEIAA discussed the recommendations of the SEAC in detail and noted that the previous EC dt. 09.10.2015 was expired on 08.10.2021. The proponent requested for extension of EC validity duly considering the S.O.221 (E), dt.18.01.2021. However, the request for extension is made after expiry of the EC, hence rejected.

Now, the proponent again applied the proposal with another proposal no. SIA/TG/MIN/279568/2022 for extension of EC validity and informed that they have earlier submitted the proposal for Extension of EC on 08.10.2021 i.e., before expiry of earlier EC. Hence, it was requested to consider their proposal and issue Extension of EC validity.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of extension of validity of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Anjaneyulu and Sri P.Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Private Limited, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted from Proceedings dt. 16.11.2017 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period upto 05.11.2023. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent also submitted a copy of Ir.dt. 02.06.2022 of ADMG, Medchal Malkajgiri District informing that there is one quarry lease (lease granted after 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 13.60 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 17.647 Ha. and Net cluster area is 17.647 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B1 category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 3,56,485 m³/annum of Stone & Metal and 2,00,215 m³/annum of Gravel. The proponent started mining operations from the year 2017-18 as per Ir. dt. 02.06.2022 of ADMG, Medchal Malkajgiri District, without obtaining prior EC.

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Nearest human habitation is Raja Bolaram Tanda @ 0.9 km; Nearest water body is Shamirpet Vagu exists at 3.8 km; Nearest RF is RF near mine exists at 20m from the mine lease area.
