Tamil Nadu Housing Board (TNHB) has proposed to Construct 606 TNGRHS flats at Survey Number 172 part, 173 part, 174 part, 175 part, 194 part (T.S. 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Discussed in detail, the Authority decided to issue Environmental clearance subject to the following additional conditions along with conditions stipulated by SEAC Technical Team Report:

- The Project Proponent shall maintain 5 nos of car parking facility exclusively for visitors and it shall be displayed.
- 2. The Project Proponent has to provide rain water harvesting collection tank to the capacity of 300 cu.m in order to recover and reuse the rain water during normal rains, release of bank guarantee and issue of CTO from TNPCB shall be considered only on completion of collection sump & allied piping.
- The EMP cost shall be printed in the Brochure / Pamphlet for preparation of the sale of the property and should also mention the component involved.
- There should be Fire fighting plan and all required safety plan.
- Vertical plant and tree cover/ gardening should be established to tide over rising temperatures and wind velocity as per structural engineering.
