

Supplementary Agenda for the 44th Meeting of State Level Expert Appraisal Committee, Chandigarh (U.T.) scheduled on 2nd February 2021 at 11 A.M. under the chairmanship of Prof. Siby John, SEAC, Chandigarh, in the Conference Hall, 2nd Floor, Paryavaran Bhawan, Sector 19 B, Chandigarh for the appraisal of Environment Clearance (EC) of the project namely,

“Proposed Construction of Advanced Mother & Child Centre (Phase-I) by Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research at Sector-12, Chandigarh”. (SIA/CH/MIS/180532/2020).

The above mentioned project proposal was received online for the issuance of Environment Clearance (EC) via State Portal of Environment Clearance, submitted by Sh. Rajnish Puri, Hospital Engineer on behalf of Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research at Sector 12, Chandigarh.

The project proposal was considered by the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) in its 43rd meetings held on 12th January 2021. The PP was asked to submit the revised project report. On receipt of the revised proposal from the PP, the 44th meeting of the SEAC was held on 02nd February 2021. The committee observed that the project proponent has complied with the queries raised in the meeting on 12th January 2021 and submitted the Additional Details Sought (ADS) vide letter dated 18.01.2021. With the submission of documents namely Form 1, Form 1A and compliance to the ADS raised with supporting documents, the committee agreed in principle to recommend the case. However, the committee opinioned that the revised proposal i.e. Conceptual Plan, Environment Management Plan (EMP) along with Risk Assessment Plan, so submitted in physical form to be uploaded on the online portal of Environmental Clearance ‘Parivesh’, before the proposal is recommended to the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Chandigarh for the grant of Environmental Clearance.

In this regard, the revised proposal as mentioned above has been received online on 06.02.2021 in response to the ADS raised on 04.02.2021. Therefore, the case is recommended to SEIAA, Chandigarh with the uploading of final MOM of the 44th meeting of SEAC, Chandigarh.
