Minutes of the 19<sup>th</sup> meeting of the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC), Assam held at 11-00 a.m. on 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2021 in the Conference Hall of the Pollution Control Board, Assam, Guwahati-21.

At the onset the Chairman, SEAC, Assam welcome all the members present, briefed the objectives of the meeting and started the proceedings. The meeting opened for deliberation as per the agenda items:

**Agenda item- 1. Confirmation of the resolutions adopted the 18<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC, Assam.**

**Resolution 19/1:**

The minutes of the 18<sup>th</sup> meeting of SEAC, Assam held at Mathanguri, Manas National Park on 18<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 was placed on the table for perusal of the Hon'ble Members and necessary discussion. After a brief discussion the minute of the 18<sup>th</sup> meeting is approved unanimously.

**Agenda item- 2.**

- 1. Proposal of EC for collection of Ordinary Sand from “Digaru Sand MPA at No 5 at Digaru river bed” under Kamrup East Division proposed by M/s Allied Construction. SEIAA.1675/2021(Proposal no. SLA/AS/MIS/186711/2020)**

**Resolution 19/2:**

The project proposal asking EC for mining of ordinary sand from the “Digaru Sand MPA at No 5 at Digaru river bed” under Kamrup East Division proposed by M/s Allied Construction is thoroughly discussed in the SEAC meeting. The recommendation of the DFO, Kamrup East Division, NOC issued by the ADM, Kamrup (Metro); approved mining plan and JVR have been scrutinized. Considering all the aspects, the committee recommended for approval of the project to excavate 22500cu.m ordinary sand from the approved location *within two years*. It is also recommended to extract 11250 cu.m sand *manually* from the said location per annum strictly following the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Kamrup East Division, Basistha is requested to allow mining at the approved location only. He is also requested to ensure due surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrence of irregularities during the mining period.

2. Extension proposal of EC for mining of Sand & Gravel from "Rowta S/G Mahal" under Dhansiri Forest Division proposed by Krishna Narzari. (SEIAA.1630/2021, (Proposal no. SIA/AS/MIN/188152/2020))

**Resolution 19/3:**

The proposal for extension of EC against mining of sand and gravel from "Rowta S/G Mahal" under Dhansiri Forest Division proposed by Krishna Narzari is discussed in the SEAC meeting. Necessary scrutiny of the documents is made including the earlier EC and the approved mining plan. The committee after thread bare discussion and considering the recommendation of the DFO, Dhansiri Division recommended for approval of the extension proposal for mining of 4250 cu.m sand and 8500 cu.m gravel from the proposed location within 24-09-2022, till expiry the validity of the mining period. The annual extractable quantity of 2125 cu.m sand and 4250 cu.m gravel is recommended for mining. The proponent shall have to keep a distance of 5.0 meter from the right bank of the river as mining restricted zone to avoid river bank erosion. Further, the proponent shall have to strictly follow the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Dhansiri Division will ensure due surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrence of irregularities. He will also ensure that mining be allowed at the approved location only.

**Resolution 19/4:**

The proposal of EC for mining of sand from "JD-Jhanji Tamulichinga (Bonai) MCA for Sand under Jorhat Forest Division proposed by M/s Shivam Travel Agency is discussed in the SEAC meeting. Scrutinized the records. Due discussion is held on the proposal. Considering the approved mining plan as well as recommendation of the DFO, Jorhat Division, the committee recommended for approval of the proposal pertaining to Tamulichinga MCA to extract 15000 cu.m sand from the approved location within two years. The proponent be allowed to extract 7500 cu.m sand per year from the said location strictly following the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Jorhat Division will ensure strict surveillance on the mining operation to check occurrence of irregularities during the mining period. He is further requested to ensure that mining be restricted only at the approved location.

Due deliberation is held and considering the approved mining plan, recommendation of the concerned DFO, the committee recommended for approval of the extension proposal for another three (3) years (i.e up to 18-01-2024) to extract 12690 cu.m sand from the approved location. The annual extractable quantity is approved 4230 cu. m sand. The proponent shall





have to strictly adhere to the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Nagaon South Division will ensure necessary surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrence of irregularities during the mining operation. The DFO will ensure that mining be allowed only at the approved location.

Considering the approved mining plan and recommendation of the DFO, Sivasagar Division the committee recommended for approval of the project to extract *1000 cu.m sand in one-year period from the approved location maintaining two (2) meter excavation depth.* Further, *site excavation must be at least five (5) meters away from the bank.* In addition to the above, the proponent shall have to adhere to the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Sivasagar Division will ensure due surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period.

After due deliberation and considering all the aspects, the committee recommended for approval of the proposal to *excavate 3100cu.m brick earth from the approved location within two years allowing excavation depth up to six (6) feet* from the general ground level for development of fishery as indicated in the closure plan. Accordingly, the committee approved *1550cu.m brick earth* to be extracted *per year* from the approved site. The proponent shall have to strictly follow the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Dhubri Division will ensure due surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities and to ensure that the mining is allowed in the approved site only. The DFO, Dhubri Division is also requested to monitor whether fishery is developed in future or not.

He will also ensure that the mining be allowed only at the approved site and not beyond the limit of the approved location.



6000 cu.m brick earth within two years from the proposed location. Mining/ excavation depth is approved not beyond six (6) feet from the ground level as the closure plan indicates that mining area will be developed as fishery. The annual extractable mining material is approved 3000 cu. m. The proponent shall have to strictly follow the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Kamrup West Division will ensure due surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities and to ensure that the mining is allowed in the approved site only. The DFO, Kamrup West Division is also requested to monitor whether fishery is developed in future or not as stated in the progressive mine closure plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Dhansiri Forest Division will arrange necessary surveillance on the mining operation allowing to mine strictly in the approved location and to check occurrences of irregularities during the mining period.
