The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 29.09.2022

Agenda Item No. 01	Sanjana Aranya by M/s. Sahiti Suharika Estates Private Limited., Survey No. 691/, Gundlapochampally, Medchal Mandal, Medchal – Malkajgiri District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIS/287188/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Rajashekar Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the project proponent obtained EC vide order dt.03.07.2021 from the SEIAA, TS for Residential Apartments with Blocks (S + 5 Floors) & Amenities (S + 3 Floors). Now, the proponent proposed expansion of the project by increasing a floor due to TDR. The proponent informed that level difference in site is about 10 feet i.e about 3m. Hence, they proposed to increase a floor in residential block; as the stilt floor as now became cellar due to level difference in site. It was informed that the present status of the project is under construction i.e Cellar under process and it is not yet completed.

The proponent submitted Structural stability certificate dt.03.05.2022. Earlier the structure was designed for stilt floor + 5 upper floors. Subsequently, the design has been revised for cellar + ground floor + 5 upper floors ensuring structural stability and safety for the building as per NBC standards.

The details of the project after expansion as following:

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 12,620.4 Sq.m.; Net plot area is 12,557.3 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 1456.3 Sq.m. (11.6%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 38,273.8 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 336 no. of units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Apartments (C + G + 5 Floors) & Amenities (G + 3 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 10,704.5 Sq.m., (38.8 % against required 33%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 46.4 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 140.3 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 6.1 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs. 12.5 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs. 58.7 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

The SEAC observed that though expansion is proposed, they did not submit any certified compliance report on EC conditions. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit Certified Compliance Report issued by the RO of MoEF&CC, GoI, as per O.M. dt. 08.06.2022 of the MoEF&CC, GoI, as the EC was issued on 03.07.2021

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The SEAC deferred the project, as the proponent did not attend the meeting.

Hence, the SEAC decided to inform the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

Agenda Item No. 03	GKRS Splendora by M/s. GKRS Properties LLP., Survey No. 18/A1/2, Bandlaguda Jagir, Gandipet, Ranga Reddy District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.

The representative of the project proponent Sri B. Madhusudhan and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed with in 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, **Bandlaguda Jagir (V)** is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

During presentation, the proponent informed that, presently temporary sheds for labourers of adjacent project exists in the site which will be dismantled as per C&D Rules 2016 and proposed project will be taken up.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 10,218.2 Sq.m., Net plot area is 9,549.7 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 1,115.9 Sq.m. (11.7%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 65,406.0 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 275 no. of units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Apartments with single block (3C + S + 19 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 21,143.7 Sq.m., (43.96% against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.56.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.207.7 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 5.2 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs.25.7 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs.47.8 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Purnachand and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was granted (in-principle) in favour of the proponent on 17.06.2020 for a period of 20 years. The SEAC noted that the lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent also submitted copy of cluster lr. dt. 07.07.2021 of ADMG, Sangareddy informing that there are two quarries (lease granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500 mts. Total cluster area is 33.76 Ha. & Net cluster area is 24.69 Ha. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 24.69 Ha which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan. It was reported in the lr. dt. 16.09.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District that the area is under non working condition.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA issued TORs (Auto Generated) on 27.10.2020 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 22.07.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing & representations that the issues emerged during public hearing are employment to local people; take adequate measures to control air pollution & noise pollution during mining operations, Speed restriction to material carrying vehicles in the village to avoid accidents; provide medical camps & to develop greenbelt etc. The proponent reported that they will allocate CER/CSR budget for local villagers only. The proponent informed that they will develop greenbelt in an area of 0.2 Ha and avenue plantation along the connecting roads.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 29.09.2022

The nearest villages to the proposed site are Mantrikunta (V) & Madharam (V) which are existing at a distance of 684 m & 785 m respectively. Nearest water body i.e., a small water pond exists at 110 m (S) & Nearest RF is Kazipalli RF exists at 1.0 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 4,18,842 m³/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 22 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs.100.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 11.68 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.40 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri A. Ashok and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 13.03.2008 in favour of Smt. V. Rama for a period of 15 years i.e upto 12.03.2023. Then, the lease was transferred on 16.02.2017 in favour of the proponent for un-expired period upto 12.03.2023. Later, 1st renewal of lease was granted (in-principle) on 15.07.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.04 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Peddaparvathapuram (V) exists at a distance 600 m from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e water pond (Cheruvu) exists at 240 m (NW) from the boundary of the site. Nearest RF is Parvathapuram RF exists at 0.85 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 1,36,640 m³/annum of Road Metal and Building stone and the life of mine is reported as 11 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.41 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.38 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 22.06.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri- Bhuvanagiri District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2007-08 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2008-09 to 2011-2012; 2015-16 to 2019-20 & 2021-22 except during the years 2007-08; 2012-13 to 2014-15 & 2020-21.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.30.07.2021 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Peddaparvathapur (V), Bommalararamam (M), Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District stating that the proponent conducted eye camps/eye checkups and submitted a copy of bill for purchase of Rs. 46,000 for frames & pair lenses and donated them for those who needed in the village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Dasari Tejo Ananth; and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, The SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt.20.07.2022 for Residential Apartments Construction project with total Built-up area 51,288.8 Sq.m. in site area of 5570.0 Sq.m

Now, the proponent informed that plot area as per document is 6,576.13 Sq.m (Gift deed vide doct. No. 299 of 2015), already they obtained EC with 5,570.0 Sq.m., however as per the final land survey it was found there is an increase of 196.8 Sq.m. Thus the total site area is 5,766.8 Sq.m. Accordingly, they modified the plans and submitted the EC Amendment application with increase in site area of 196.8 Sq.m. (EC obtained 5,570.0 Sq.m to Proposed 5,766.8 Sq.m) and No. of units from 100 to 102 units. It was also informed that the units were mentioned as 100 instead of 102 units due to typo-graphical error made by the project proponent. It was further informed that construction has not initiated. Hence, it was requested to issue amendment to EC with the following changes:

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 26.05.2022 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 533.9 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 763.9 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of amendment to EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Rakesh Koti & Sri B. Nagesh Kumar; and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 90,350.9 Sq.m., Net plot area is 89,828.5 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 9,035.4 Sq.m. (10.1%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 42,248.3 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Construction Project to accommodate 141 no. of units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential - 13 Blocks (G + 2 Floors); 6 Amenities Blocks (G + 1 Floor) & Security Cabin (Ground floor).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 9,466.1 Sq.m., (22.41% against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.142.8 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.169.81 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 8.35 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs.13.63 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs.38.84 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Smt B. Geetha Reddy; and Sri P. Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted on 31.03.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 09.06.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District informing that there are 3 quarry leases (1.62 Ha lease granted after 09.09.2013; and 3.0 Ha. & 1.0 Ha lease granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 0.86 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 6.48 Ha. and Net cluster area is 2.48 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Khairatapur which is existing at a distance of 1.24 km; nearest water body i.e Yamanon Vagu exists at 2.53 km (S); Nearest RF i.e., Malkapuram RF exists at 0.1 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 29,150 m³/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 6 years (@23,180 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.08 Lakhs/annum.

It is observed from Notice dt. 31.03.2022 of DMG, Hyderabad that the project proponent applied for 1.56 Ha. of quarry lease, but quarry lease was considered for (in-principle) grant of only 0.86 Ha of area for 20 years. It was also reported in the letter that quarry lease for 0.86 Ha. was granted in-principle subject to submission of scrutinized quarry plan within a period of 6 months along with CFE from TSPCB and Environmental Clearance from MoEF&CC for quarry lease demarcated area of 2.210 Ha. The SEAC expressed ambiguity w.r.t. extent of mine lease area as 1.56 Ha. / 0.86 Ha. / 2.210 Ha., as the EC application was uploaded for 0.86 Ha only. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit clarification on mine lease area along with support documents and correction in letter

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri V. Raveendra Reddy and Sri Mohan Reddy of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 20.08.2009 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years i.e upto 19.08.2019. Later, 1st renewal of lease was granted on 04.07.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Garlavoodu exists at a distance 0.93 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e Nagarjuna sagar left canal exists at 2.22 km (NE); Nearest RF is Kannegiri RF exists at 5.0 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 20,000 m³/annum of Building stone and Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 9 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 25.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.10 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.80 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 11.07.2022 of ADMG, Khammam District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2007-08 to 2019-20 (upto 19.08.2019). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2013-14; 2014-15 & during 2017-18 to 2019-20 (upto 19.08.2019) and except during the years 2007-08 to 2012-13 & 2015-16 to 2016-17.

The proponent submitted a copy of receipt dt.15.09.2022 issued by the Head Master, ZPHS of Jannaram (V), Enkoor (M), Khammam District stating that the proponent donated Rs. 25000/- for Almarah's in Science Lab equipments and sports material for the students of the school.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC noted that the proponent submitted earlier production details upto 19.08.2019 only and informed the proponent to submit status of the mine after 19.08.2019 to till date issued by the mining department.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Pachava Krishna and Sri P. Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that 3 leases (1.0 Ha.; 0.315 Ha. & 1.650 Ha. - prior to 09.09.2013) were amalgamated into a single lease of 2.965 Ha on 04.08.2014 for unexpired lease period upto 22.02.2023. Later, 1st renewal of lease was granted on 15.07.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. The proponent also submitted a copy of lr. dt. 19.05.2022 of ADMG, Nalgonda District informing there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from proposed quarry. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.965 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Rayapuram (V) exists at a distance 1.20 km; nearest water body i.e a lake near mine lease exists at 1.18 km (E) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 1,20,455 TPA of Building stone and Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 10 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.10 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.08 Lakhs/annum.
