The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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Agenda Item No. 01	GAMYA by M/s. Supadha Developers Private Limited, Survey Nos. 388/P, 389/P, 390/P & 391/P, Tellapur, Ramachandrapuram, Sanga Reddy District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/INFRA2/412037/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri J.Jagadish and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed with in 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, **Tellapur** (V) is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Auto generated) on 05.12.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded online.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 48,000.5 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 4,333.7 Sq.m. (10.7%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 3,32,036.4 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate total no. of 948 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Apartments with 6 Blocks (C + 2P + G + 30 Floors) and Amenities (C+ 2P + G + 4 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 81,418.6 Sq.m. (32.49 % against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 820.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 820.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 16.1 lakhs/annum for Construction Phase and capital cost: Rs. 114.1 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 157.1 lakhs/annum for Occupation Phase.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that a nala flows adjacent to the project site. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of Lr. dt.12.09.2022 of the Superintending Engineer, I&CAD Dept., Irrigation circle, Sangareddy District. It is observed from the document that the extent land in Sy.No. 389/P, 390/P, 391/P (Ac 12 - 31 Gts) situated at Tellapur (V), Ramachandrapuram (M), Sangareddy district is affected under inflow channel & affected under the 2 m buffer (Ac 0-24^{1/2}Gts) leaving balance land of Ac 12-06^{1/2} Gts, as per norms stipulated in G.O.Ms.No.168, dt.07.04.2012 of MA&UD Dept. Accordingly, the proponent proposed the layout of the project.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained (6) NOCs dt.07.04.2021 for Height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted copies of the same. It is observed from the NOCs that the site elevation is 565.75 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 680.75 mts AMSL for Tower-1; the site elevation is 566.55 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 681.55 mts AMSL for Tower-2; the site elevation is 567.3 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 682.3 mts AMSL for Tower-3; the site elevation is 567.9 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 682.9 mts AMSL for Tower- 4; the site elevation is 566.95 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 681.95 mts AMSL for Tower- 5; the site elevation is 565.75 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 680.75 mts AMSL for Tower-6. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Kranthi Kamireddy and Sri D. Sreekanth of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended before SEAC and informed that they proposed some other changes in the proposal after uploading the proposal in Parivesh. Hence, it was informed that they are withdrawing the proposal.

In view of the above, the SEAC decided to return the proposal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K.Bhoopathi and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Auto generated) on 31.12.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded online.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 1,17,964.9 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 13,360.6 Sq.m. (11.6%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 7,71,416.5 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential & Commercial Construction Project to accommodate 3345 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential apartments with 15 towers (2C + G + 27 Floors); Commercial block with 1 tower (2C + G + 3 Floors) and 2 Amenities (2C + G + 4 Floors) & (2C + G floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 2,13,024.7 Sq.m. (against required 1,23,221.2 m² considering 33% for Commercial & 22% for Residential).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 1740.30 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 2546.3 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 55.4 lakhs/annum for Construction Phase and capital cost: Rs. 343.2 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 544.2 lakhs/annum for Occupation Phase.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they have obtained NOCs (4 no.) dt.02.09.2021 & 06.09.2021 for Height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted copies of the same. It is observed from the NOCs that the site elevation is 619.45 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 739.45 mts AMSL for Tower-1, 11 & 12; the site elevation is 618.6 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 738.6 mts AMSL for Tower-2, 3 & 4; the site elevation is 618.45 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 738.45 mts AMSL for Tower - 5, 6, 7 & 8; the site elevation is 618.6 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 738.6 mts AMSL for Tower- 9, 10 & Clubhouse; the site elevation is 617.6 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 737.6 mts AMSL for Tower- 13, 14, 15, & 16. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI. The proponent submitted the Risk Assessment report & Disaster Management Plan.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Rakesh; and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt.11.03.2022 for construction of Residential Apartment (High Rise Building) project with total built up area of 67,293.47 Sq.m.

Now, the proponent informed that site area & built-up area are decreased due to which there are changes in site area, built-up area, parking area, No. of units, No. of Floors, Water requirement, Wastewater generation & Solid waste. It was also informed that construction is not yet started. The SEAC noted that the proponent submitted EIA report along with copies of documents. Hence, it was requested to issue amendment to EC with the following changes:

The representative of the project proponent Sri Kishan Agarwal and Sri P.V Raju of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech (P) Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- M/s. Sri Raj Iron & Steel Products Private Limited is situated in Sy. No. 770/P, 770/UU2, 770/UU/3, 771/AA, 771/P, 777/A2/2, 777/P, 780/AM2, 781/A, 781/AA, 781/E1, 781/EE1, 781/I, 781/EII, 781/E1, 781/LUU, 781/LU, 781/RUU, 781/RU2, 781/O, 781/O1, 781/O2, 781/U1, 781/UU1, 782/A, at Chandampet Revenue village/Rudraram Gram panchayat, Shankarampet Mandal, Medak District, Telangana.
- The industry obtained CFE (Order No:RCPM -819/PCB/ZO/RCP/CFE/2021-SML004001764763 Dated: 06.11.2021) from State Pollution Control Board for establishment of Induction furnace and rolling mill with a capacity of MS Billets 26,250 TPA and MS Strips of 500 TPD, MS ERW Pipes of 500 TPD and TMT Bars of 500 TPD.
- As annual capacity of MS Billets is less than 30,000 TPA, as per the EIA notification and subsequent amendments, it was not covered under EIA Notification. Now the unit made this application for expansion to reach Billets capacity of 3,90,500 TPA.
- The Construction work is now underway for the previous CFE requirements
- Now, the industry proposed to install Steel Melting Shop of Induction Furnaces with two Re-Rolling mill and ERW pipe mill. It is proposed to manufacture MS Billets with a capacity of (Phase I – 1,95,250 TPA, after Phase II – 3,90,500 TPA), MS Strips (Phase I – 2,68,380 TPA, Phase II – No Change), MS ERW Pipes (Phase I – 2,55,600 TPA, Phase II – No Change) and MS TMT Bars (Phase I – 1,80,340 TPA, Phase II – No Change).

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs on 28.02.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 03.11.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report.

The SEAC noted the contents of the EIA report and noted the details of the project after proposed Expansion as follows:

Total area is 27.906 Acres, out of which Green area is 11.68 Acres (41.85%).

Nearest human habitation is Rudraram (V) @ 1.01 km; Nearest water body i.e., Rudraram Cheruvu @ 1.25 km; Nearest RF i.e., Wadiaram RF @ 1.06 km from the industry.

Project Cost for proposed expansion is Rs. 18.0 Crores (for proposed expansion). EMP cost after expansion (Capital cost Rs.190.0 Lakhs) & Recurring cost is Rs.49.0 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 08	1.90 Ha. Road Metal & Rough Stone Quarry of M/s. Balaji Stone Crusher, Sy.No.161/1, Kondurg Village & Mandal, Rangareddy District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/413455/2023 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Janardhan Reddy and Sri D.Sreekanth of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that initial lease was granted on 11.08.2008 in favour of the project proponent for a period of 15 years i.e upto 10.08.2023 for 1.0 Ha. Another lease was granted on 17.08.2010 (0.900 Ha.) for a period upto 16.08.2025. The proponent informed that the two leases (1.0 Ha. & 0.900 Ha.) were amalgamated into a single lease of 1.90 Ha on 05.07.2022 for unexpired lease period upto 10.08.2023. Subsequently, renewal of lease was granted on 02.08.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.90 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Gangannagudem (V) exists at a distance 1.20 km (S); nearest water body near the project site exists at 0.48 km (SE) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 39,000 m³/annum of Road Metal & Rough Stone and the life of mine is reported as 5 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.0 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted copies of Certificates dt.21.01.2021 and dt.10.09.2022 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Kondurg Village & Mandal, Rangareddy District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 60,000/- for various developmental activities in the village and also spent Rs. 50,000/- for installation of CC Cameras in the village.

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After detailed discussions, the SEAC observed from the Google image that nearest water body is within a distance of 50mts. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit NOC from I&CAD Department duly mentioning the distance of mine lease area from the waterbody i.e tank.

The SEAC also informed project proponent to submit earlier production details duly certified by mining Department.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri T. Ashok Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 20.12.2007 in favour of proponent for a period of 15 years i.e upto 19.12.2022. Later, the renewal of lease was granted on 10.11.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village is Jayapalli (V) exists at a distance 0.3 Km (NW); nearest water body i.e Water pond (Cheruvu) exists at a distance of 210 mts (N); Nearest RF i.e. Kondamadugu RF exists at a distance of 1.0 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 30,450.4 m³/annum of Road Metal & Building Stone and the life of mine is reported as 16.6 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.99 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.27 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.23.11.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District, furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period from 2007-08 to 2022-23 (upto 23.11.2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2007-08 to 2022-2023 (upto 09.11.2022) and no permits were issued from 10.11.2022 to 23.11.2022.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.10.05.2022 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Jiyapalle Village, Bibinagar Mandal, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District stating that the proponent has spent Rs.2,00,000 /- for grass cutter and installation of CC Cameras in the village.

The proponent informed that another mine (Violation) exists within the mine lease area of the same proponent.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Auto generated) on 31.12.2022 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent prepared the EIA report and uploaded online.

Since, the proponent suo-moto reported violations, the above percentage rates are halved and therefore the Total Penalty is worked out to be Rs 4,14,502/-

After details discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC Clearance subject to approval by the SEIAA for submission of Bank Guarantee for an amount of Rs. 5,21,000/- and Penalty of Rs. 4,14,502/-.

The proponent submitted copies of ltr. dt.18.07.2022, 17.08.2022, 22.09.2022, 18.10.2022 & 12.12.2022. of the Head master Z.P.H.S Lakdaram (V), Patancheruvu (M), Sangareddy District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 12,000/- per month during July, August, September, October and December towards salaries of Scavengers.



The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Satyanarayana and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 28.10.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit production details, dispatch particulars, status of quarry duly certified by Mining department.

Accordingly, the project proponent submitted a copy of letter dt.05.01.2023 of the ADMG: Rangareddy District furnishing the details of year-wise production and dispatch permits for the period from 2002-03 to 2022-23 (upto November). The SEAC observed from the letter that the production of quartz was carried out during the period from 2002-03 to 2022-23 (upto November) except during 2014-15 and dispatch permits were issued during 2002-2003 to 2007-08, 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2015-16 – 2022-23 (upto November) and nil during 2008-09 to 2011-12 & 2014-15.

It is also observed that production of Feldspar was carried out during 2002-2003 to 2021-22 except during 2022-23 (upto November). And dispatch permits were issued during 2002-2003 to 2007-08, 2012-13, 2013-14 & 2015-16 – 2022-23 (upto November) except during 2008-09 to 2011-2012 and 2014-15. It was further reported that the leases has represented that they are not operating since June 2021 due to water logging of pits and also informed that they are dispatching the mineral from the dumped stock in the quarry area only.
