The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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Agenda Item No. 01	5.0 Ha. Road Metal & Building Stone Quarry of M/s. Rafi Stone Metal Industry, Survey No. 399, Malkapur Village, Chautuppal Mandal, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/404747/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Md. Rayce and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 31.12.2022 deferred the project and the proponent was again directed to acquire land for Compensatory Afforestation near the mine lease area and submit copies of land documents for the same alongwith undertaking for greenbelt as Compensatory Afforestation.

Accordingly, the project proponent submitted a copy of undertaking along with copies of land documents in the name of Perumalla Saidaiah & Syed Abid Hussain who are the partners of M/s. Rafi Stone Metal Industry, as per Re-constituted Partnership deed dt.10.03.2021. It is observed from the document that they will develop greenbelt in the Survey No.463/AA/E, 463/AU/AA, 464/AU/2, Kadthal Village & Mandal, Rangareddy District in an area of Acre 1.2 Gts. which is about a distance of 45 km from the proposed quarry lease area.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the Environment Consultant Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. AmplEnviron Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 31.12.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to acquire land for compensatory afforestation near the mine lease area and submit copies of land documents for the same.

Accordingly, the project proponent submitted a undertaking and copies of land documents informing that they will develop greenbelt in the adjacent land which belongs to their partner viz., Rachamalla Mallaiah (as per Partnership Deed dt.10.03.2021) in an area of Acres 3.2 in Sy.No.95/B of Baddipally (V), Kothapally (M), Karimnagar District, which is at a distance of 200 m away from the mine lease area.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Hence, the SEAC decided to inform the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

The representative of the Environment Consultant Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 09.01.2023 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit a copy of CSR activities carried out by the proponent along with evidence.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.25.10.2022 issued by the Sarpanch, of Grama Panchayath, Mustafanagar (V), Gambhiraopet (M), Rajanna Sircilla District, stating that project proponent donated material of worth Rs. 2,00,000/- for construction of roads in the village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri L.A.L Ravi Kumar; and Sri M.Venkatesh of M/s. Global Enviro Labs., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA in its meeting held on 04.02.2023 referred back to SEAC to ascertain the production quantity to till date and assess the penalty amount as per O.M.dt.07.07.2021.

The SEAC noted the decision of the SEIAA and re-examined the proposal.

The SEAC noted that the mining operations were started in the Mine lease area from 2012-13 without EC and applied for EC on 08.04.2018 during window period. Subsequently, the proponent applied for TOR under Violation on 06.02.2020 and Auto TORs were issued on 26.03.2020 and later Amenement to TOR w.r.t. Violation were issued on 24.09.2021 and obtained Auto TOR on TOR under violation on 06.02.2020. Accordingly, the proponent submitted EIA report on 08.12.2022. The proposal was earlier examined by the SEAC as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 and S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI. However, as per decision of the SEIAA, the SEAC considered the project under violation as per OM dt.07.07.2021 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 03.09.2022 of ADMG, Vikarabad District furnishing the details of Royalty & dispatch particulars during the period from 2012-13 to 2022-23 (upto 05.09.2022). It is observed from the document that dispatch permits were issued during 2012-13, 2014-15 to 2016-17 & 2018-19 to 2021-22 and Nil during 2013-14, 2017-18 & 2022-23 (upto 05.09.2022). It was reported that *the quarry lease period is in force upto 05.09.2022 and not obtained dispatch permits since there on and application for grant of renewal of quarry lease was filed on 05.03.2021. The quarry lease will be renewed and granted on receipt of EC, CFE & CFO in accordance with Notice issued by the DDM&G, Hyderabad on 29.08.2022.* In this regard, the proponent clarified that though they have not operated the mine and not obtained any dispatch permits during 2017-18 & 2022-23 (upto 05.09.2022), they have paid dead rents which is reflected in the statement. The SEAC noted that the proponent has paid Royalty (Seignorage fee) of Rs. 68,39,135/-

The SEAC considered the project as per the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 & O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. Standard operating Procedure (SOP) for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006. The SEAC noted that as per SOP, the total Penalty (where operations have commenced without EC) is 1% of the total project cost incurred up to the date of filing of application along with EIA/EMP report **PLUS** 0.25 % of the total turnover during the period of violation. Further, the percentage rates, as above, shall be halved if the project proponent *suo-moto* reports such violations without such violations coming to the knowledge of the Government either on inquiry or complaint.

The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 14.17 Ha and the rationalized project cost is Rs. 141.7.0 Lakhs considering Rs. 10.0 Lakhs/Ha. for Stone & Metal Mine, as per Methodology for calculating Penalty. Further, the SEAC considered total turnover as 2 times the Seignorage fee and hence, the turnover is Rs.1,36,78,270/-.

Since, the proponent suo-moto reported violations, the above percentage rates are halved and therefore the **Total Penalty is worked out to be Rs. 87,948/-**

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC subject to approval by the SEIAA for submission of Bank Guarantee for an amount of Rs. 7,09,000/- and Penalty for an amount of Rs. 87,948/-.

The representative of the Environment Consultant Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 08.09.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit NOC from Airports Authority of India for 5th Block.

In this regard, the project proponent informed that they have obtained revised NOC afresh from Airports Authority of India for all Blocks. The proponent submitted a copy of NOC dt. 13.01.2023 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 549.15 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 784.75 mts AMSL for Towers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and Club house. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri U. Srinivasa Rao and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 27.10.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit letter duly certified by Mining Department w.r.t Latest Production details mentioning the dispatch details and status of mine.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt.23.01.2023 of ADMG (FAC), Hanamakonda District furnishing the details of production & dispatch particulars during the period from 2007-2008 to 2021-2022. It is observed from the letter that that production was carried out and dispatch permits were issued during the period 2007-08 to 2012-13 and 2015-16 and Nil during the period from 2013-14 to 2014-15 and 2016-17 to 2021-2022. It was also mentioned in the letter that at present the quarry is not working.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 08	1.00 Ha. Colour Granite Mine of M/s. Narasimha Granites & Exports, Sy No: 46, Amudalapally Village, Shankarapatnam Mandal, Karimnagar District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/226005/2021 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Srinivas and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. AmplEnviron Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project proponent informed that the lease was initially granted on 30.12.2011 in favour of Sri Vamshi Krishna Granites (1.0 Ha.) for a period of 20 years for a period upto 12.04.2030. Later, the lease was transferred on 28.02.2013 in favour of the proponent for unexpired period i.e., upto 12.04.2030. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.00 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Rajapur (V) exists at a distance 0.88 km; nearest water body i.e Pond near Gudatapalli exists at a distance of 1.1 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 34,000 m³/annum of Colour Granite and the life of mine is reported as 12 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 10.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 1.77 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.33 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of letter dt.13.12.2022 of the ADMG: Karimnagar District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period from 2013-14 to 2022-23 (upto 30.11.2022). The SEAC observed from the letter that the dispatch permits were issued during the period 2013-14 and no production was carried out during the period from 2014-15 to 2022-23 (upto 30.11.2022).

During presentation, the SEAC observed from KML file that mining was carried out during the year 2019. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit initial mine lease documents along with earlier production details till date duly certified by the Mining Department.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The proponent submitted a letter dt. 31.01.2023 received on dt. 25.02.2023, informing that their project scheme has now been changed and hence they are withdrawing the proposal. (SIA/TG/INFRA/401206/2022). It was also informed that they have filed revised proposal afresh with other proposal number.

In view of the above, the SEAC decided to return the proposal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K.Kasivishwanadhan and Sri P. Hrai Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

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Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 10.01.2023 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit documents w.r.t reduced mine lease area issued by the Mining Department.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted a copy of Memo. dt.06.08.2019 issued by Industries and Commerce (Mines.I) Department. It was observed from the letter that while extension of quarry lease for further period of 5 years from 17.07.2018, it was reported that "the lessee has filed 1st renewal of Quarry Lease application for grant of quarry lease in the subject area within the stipulated time. Accordingly, the technical staff have taken up joint inspection & survey the Revenue Department to ascertain the lease area as per the executed sketch and also as per the ground position. After survey, it was noticed that the extent of quarry lease was reduced to some portion in the East side of the area and the joint inspection team recommended for renewal of the above said quarry lease for reduced extent which is available on the ground for a further period as per the rules in force".

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Amendment to TORs w.r.t. mine lease area as 12.83 Ha. instead of 13.406 Ha.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Mirza Mahamood Baig and Sri P. Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 29.09.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit initial mine lease documents along with earlier production details till date issued by the Mining Department and also status of Court cases.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted a copy of Proceedings dt.07.04.2000 issued by ADMG, Medak District and also submitted a copy of Writ Petition No. 490 of 2016 is dismissed as withdrawn as per order dt.19.11.2018 by the Hon'ble Court.

The project proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt.14.10.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy informing the following:

The said lease period was from 07.04.2000 to 06.04.2010. During the substance of the lease period the lessee conducted the quarry operations and obtained the dispatch permits.

As per the reports Sri Mirza Mohamood Baig has excavated about 10568.3 m³ of metal from the lease area against the permitted quantity of 43682.01 m³ of metal. They have further reported that Sri Mirza Mahabood Baig has encroached outside the lease area on Western side and extracted a quantity of about 49535.28 m³ of metal.

The Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Medak has issued show cause notice vide no. 3762/Q/2009, dt.06.01.2015 to Sri Mirza Mahamood Baig to under Rule 34(1) & 26(2) of AOMMC Rules 1966 for un lawful extraction and transportation of 62286.01 m³ of metal more than the permitted Quantity from lease area and for extraction and transportation of about 49535.28 m³ of metal from the area encroached outside the lease area followed by demand notice No.3762/Q/2009, dt.01.04.2015 issued and directed Sri Mirza Mahamood Baig to pay an amount of Rs. 55,91,064.50 towards Normal Seigniorage Fee and Rs.4,03,142.50 towards 5/10 times penalty totaling Rs.4,59,30,207.00.

Sri Mirza Mahabood Baig aggrieved over the demand notice filed Revision application before the government. The government vide Memo No.453/M.(2)/2015-2, dt.09.09.2015 disposed the revision application with a direction to Sri Mirza Mahamood Baig to pay Normal Seigniorage fee in addition to one time penalty in 12 equal installments.

Accordingly, the lessee has paid Normal Seigniorage fee of Rs.55,91,065-00 total Rs.1,11,82,130-00 vide challans.

In this regard, further it is to inform that as per the office records the lessee has not conducted the quarry operations and not obtained the dispatch permits from 01.01.2011 to 08.09.2021. After payment of all the mineral revenue dues he has obtained 63610.0 MT of the dispatch permits. Further, he has paid the renewal fee and obtained the LOI in the area.

The proponent submitted a copy of Lr. dt. 28.02.2023 of the ADMG: Sangareddy District furnishing details of dispatch permits issued during 2000-01 to 2022-23 (upto 28.02.2023). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during 2000-01 to 2022-23 (upto 28.02.2023) except during 2011-12 to 2021-22. It was also reported that the mining operations were not carried out after 06.04.2010.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended the project for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri S.J. Reddy and Sri. P.V Raju of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech (P) Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 31.12.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit a letter/NOC that the project is not linked to any case in Hon'ble NGT (OA. No.84 of 2021) and in Hon'ble Appellate Authority of TSPCB (Appeal No.2 of 2022).

Accordingly, the proponent submitted letter dt.31.01.2023 stating that with respect to the above referenced Proposal No. SIA/TG/MIS/80894/2022 (TOR), we hereby confirm and declare the following in line with the directions of the SEAC (as recorded pursuant to its meeting dated 31.12.2022):

- *that the above referenced Proposal deals only with the captioned Project i.e., 'Legend Chimes project – Phase I' as described above and the same is not linked to any case before the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in O.A. No. 84 of 2021.*

At any rate, we would also want to confirm to you that the said O.A. No. 84 of 2021 before the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) is linked to the 'Legend Chimes Echo' project which is Phase 2 of the Legend Chimes project (for which a separate Environmental Clearance and all other approvals were taken) by us. Further, the said O.A. No. 84 of 2021 is now definitively settled pursuant to the Judgment dated 30.03.2022 of the Hon'ble NGT as regards the 'Legend Chimes Echo' – Phase 2 project.

- *that the 'Legend Chimes project – Phase I' to which the captioned Proposal relates to is also not linked or related to the Appeal No. 2 of 2022 before the Hon'ble Appellate Authority of the Telangana State Pollution Control Board (TSPCB).*

As per the order of the TSPCB dated 14.12.2021, it records details in relation to the project to which the TSPCB's case relates to (i.e., 'Legend Chimes Echo' project which is

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Phase 2 of the Legend Chimes project). It is apparent from the review of the order of the TSPCB that the survey numbers related to the 'Legend Chimes Echo' project which is Phase 2 of the Legend Chimes project are different from the survey numbers / areas comprised in the 'Legend Chimes project – Phase I' to which the captioned Proposal relates to.

In view of the above and after detailed discussion, the SEAC again recommended to issue Additional TORs w.r.t. Violation for preparation of EIA report considering the baseline data from March - May 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and copy of NOC issued by the I&CAD Dept., in the EIA report and submit the same to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the Environment Consultant Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 03.01.2023 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit Self Compliance certificate report.

This drain has to be remodelled for accommodating the following suggested discharge for safe disposal of storm water during peak rainfalls. This surplus course is not mentioned in the voyants report so the required section of nala is designed for the MFD of 33.75 cumees calculated based on catchment area, intensity of rainfall through Rational formula.

The width of surplus course arrived is 4.50 m. The applicant has to leave 4.50m width for Nala 2 x 0.5m for wall + 2.0 m buffer on either side, total 9.50m width has to be left for entire alignment of Nala passing in his site. The area affected under Nala portion is 1360 Sq. mts and under buffer of Nala in applicants site is 1320 Sq.mts. Hence, the Net area available in applicants site is 20,533.82 Sq.m.

It is observed from the above document of the I&CAD Dept., that the proponent requested to issue a copy of WBC minutes of meeting w.r.t. their project. Then, renewal of lease was granted (in-principle) on 02.05.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 0.800 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 Category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 28,425.00 m³/annum of Road Metal & Building Stone. The proponent continued mining operations even after the year 2019 without obtaining EC, as per lr. dt. 27.10.2022 of ADMG, Siddipet District.

Nearest human habitation is Nagaram (V) @ 0.83 km (E); Nearest water body i.e Madudha waterbody exists at 2.04 km (N) and Nearest RF is Akunur RF exists at 2.26 km (N) from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t.
