## **Minutes of the meeting of SEIAA, Bihar, convened on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2018**

The meeting of SEIAA has been convened on short notice due to ensuing holidays in the month.

### **Followings were resolved :-**

#### **(1) Agenda Item No.-1**

**TRIVENI SMELTERS PVT. LTD., (Expansion Project), Mauza:-Raipura, Tehsil:- Fatuha, District:- Patna (Proposal No. - SIA/3(a)/536/18), Online Proposal No.:- SIA/BR/IND/27926/2018.**

The SEAC in its meeting of 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2018, 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2018 discussed the proposal and has recommended for issuance of "Term of Reference". The SEAC has also agreed to permit applicant for using existing baseline data generated by one M/s ShivShiva Steel Pvt. Ltd. an adjacent unit of other proponent which has generated the required data during March - May 2017:

This is a proposed expansion of existing production capacity of Induction Furnace (MS Ingot / Billet) from 1,08,000 TPA to 1,50,000 TPA Phase -I and from 1,08,000 TPA to 3,00,000 TPA Phase -II (total), Re-rolling Mill (TMT Bar/Rods) from 1,08,000 TPA to 1,50,000 TPA Phase -I and from 1,08,000 TPA to 3,00,000 TPA Phase -II (total).

The unit was monitored by Regional office of MoEF&CC, Ranchi on 03-07-2018 and report of the monitoring was received on 28-08-2018 in SEIAA, Bihar. Compliances of previous Environmental Clearance were found unsatisfactory. A monitoring was also undertaken on 04-08-2018 by the Authority of SEIAA and a range of non - compliances were noted.



The project proponent has been asked to SHOW CAUSE for non-compliances of earlier Environmental Clearance Ref. No.- 304, dated 13-07-2016 granted to the project proponent. Project Proponent has submitted its reply vide their letter SC/SEIAA/R/2018 dated 23-08-2018 which is found unsatisfactory. The project Proponent has not provided reasons for non - compliances rather it has informed assurances for future. The SEIAA is to take a final view on the reply of project proponent and resolved to consider the case after its final view on the replies.

**(2) Agenda Item No.2**

**Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility, Village:-Karai, Tehsil:-Bikram, District:- Patna, State:- Bihar, (Proposal No.- SIA/7(da)/458/17) Online Proposal No.- SIA/BR/MIS/18952/2017.**

Full locational details of proposed Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility are as follows:-

Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (Applicant -M/s S. R Solution) is located at Thana No. 141, Khata No. - 234, 242, and Survey plot no. - 1698, 1690, Village - Karai, Tehsil - Bikram, District - Patna. The proposed project site is situated in an area of 1.25 Acres having Latitude - 25° 32' 32.244" N and Longitude - 84° 57' 40.14" E. The total project cost of the proposed project is ₹1,50,00,000.00/-.

From the records / minutes of SEAC it appears that the proposal was considered by the SEAC in its meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2017. The SEAC decided to refer the matter to Bihar State Pollution Control Board, Patna for examining the siting criteria as required by the revised guidelines of MoEF&CC under the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rule, 2016. Vide letter B - 46, dated:- 02-02-2018, the prescribed Authority (here Bihar State Pollution Control Board) has clarified the position and has stated that:-

- a) A three member sub-committee exists in the State of Bihar which is empowered to select suitable site under the provision of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rule, 2016.
- b) All the three Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility working in the State had their site selected through inviting tenders by State Health Committee.
- c) Bihar State Pollution Control Board has felt it necessary to have one additional Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility for Patna, due to numbers of beds exceeding 10,000 in Indra Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences itself and present Common Bio-



Medical Waste Treatment Facility of Indira Gandhi Institute of Medial Sciences is to be shifted to a new location in Baria.

After deliberating on the issue in the light of provisions the SEAC has rejected the application as the site proposed to be used for establishing the facility have not been selected by due process provided under revised guidelines.

The SEIAA discussed the proposal in the light of rule 17 of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016, "Revised Guidelines for CBMWTF and Disposal Facilities - 21<sup>st</sup> December, 2016" published by Central Pollution Control Board, New Delhi and referred letter of State Pollution Control Board (prescribed Authority). Upon discussion it was felt that in the present case selection of prospective operator and site does not conform appropriately with the present rule, guidelines and clarification made available by the Prescribed Authority; hence resolved to reject the proposal as recommended by the SEAC however the applicant is at liberty to submits its application afresh after due selection process of the agency / site.

**(3) Agenda Item No.3**

**Vardhman Institute of Medical Sciences (VIMS), Village:-Pawapuri, Tehsil:-Giriyak, District:-Nalanda, State:- Bihar.**

The project proponent has already committed violation of the relevant provisions of the E(P) Act, 1986, the case requires to be considered under the category of violation.

Accordingly, the SEIAA resolved to


