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

Rayalaseema Environ Care intending to purchase the land under the terms of Proposed Terms of Reference (TOR). The 1st criterion under the said TOR is placed hereunder for appreciation:

"1.Reasons for selecting the site with details of alternative sites examined/rejected/selected on merit with comparative statement and reasons/ basis for selection. The examination should justify site suitability in terms of environmental damages, resources, sustainability associated with selected site as compared to rejects site. The analysis should include parameters considered along with weightage criteria for short-listing selected site."

Thus, I am giving this legal opinion on sound principles of law that, M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care alone do have merit other than the two as discussed above in all aspects and M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care Entrepreneur is a Woman Entrepreneur and it would be a plus point for the said proponent in comparison with the other two proponents of M/s. AWM Consulting Limited and M/s.Teja's Enviro Care respectively.

Conclusion:

Thus, on the foot of the records placed before me and on the strength of the supporting laws, I am giving this opinion that M/ s Rayalaseema Environ Care may be considered for establishing a Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility in YSR Kadapa District. Hence this Opinion."

Subsequently the issue was examined by the SEAC in its meeting held 08.10.2020. The Committee observed the following:



The Revised Guidelines for Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facilities - issued by the CPCB, Delhi on 21st December, 2016- Rule 6(a) states that " A CBWTF shall preferably be developed in an notified industrial area without any requirement of buffer zone"

The APPCB " Guidelines for Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facilities" Rule 2(a) states that " Atleast one CBMWTF shall be allowed in each and every district of Andhra Pradesh for disposal of Bio-medical waste File No.APPCB-11/44/2020-TEC-EC-APPCB-Part(1)considering the increased bed strenght in future, coverage of veterinary hospitals under BMW Rules, reduction of the cost of the transport, biological waste & discarded medicines from the industries and better administrative control over the CBMWTFs.

" Further CPCB, Delhi issued Guidelines for Handling, Treatment and Disposal of Waste Generated during Treatment/Diagnosis/ Quarantine of COVID-19 Patients-Rev.4 on 21st July, 2020.



MINUTES of 159th MEETING OF STATE LEVEL EXPERT APPRAISAL COMMITTEE (SEAC), A.P., HELD ON 26th, 27th & 28th May, 2021 AT VIJAYAWADA, A.P.

New CBMWTFs are to be encouraged and the issuance of prior environmental clearance is to be expedited so as to ensure the proper collection and disposal of COVID-19 waste to reduce the impact of Novel Corona Virus(COVID-19) and also as per the guidelines issued by CPCB under BMW, Rules, 2016.

The entrepreneurs namely M /s.AWM Consulting Limited, Kurnoothala Village, Lakkireddy Mandal , YSR District; M/s.Teja'sEnvirocare, SuddamallaVillage,Ramapuram Mandal and M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care,Plot No.66, Phase-I, Mega Industrial Park, Komparthy, Kadapa have come up with proposals for setting up CBMWTF in YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh.

In this regard, SEIAA, A.P., obtained the legal opinion. The Standing Counsel vide letter No.Legal Opinion-EC-No.7/2020,dated 06.10.2020 has given the legal opinion that "M/s.Rayalaseema Environ Care may be considered for establishing a Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility in YSR Kadapa District.

Hence, the Committee after detailed deliberations recommended for issue Standard Terms of References (TOR) without public hearing to M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care, for establishment of CBMWTF at Plot No.66,Phase-I,Mega Industrial Park,Koparthy, Kadapa,YSR District, Andhra Pradesh."

The issue was examined by the SEIAA in its meeting held on 18.11.2020,19.11.2020 and 24.11.2020 and authority agreed with recommendation of the SEAC, A.P for issue Standard Terms of References (TOR) with public hearing to M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care, for establishment of CBMWTF at Plot No.66,Phase-I,Mega Industrial Park, Koparthy, Kadapa, YSR District, Andhra Pradesh. The TOR letter was sent the proponent in December, 2020. Subsequently, the SEAC, A.P., as per the committee recommendations, communicated the TOR with exemption of public hearing on 12.01.2021.

Meanwhile, M/s Teja's Enviro Care filed a writ Petition No.4863 of 2021 in the Hon'ble High Court of A.P. The following are the respondents in the case.

The Hon'ble High Court disposed the case directing the Respondents No. 2 to 4 to take an appropriate decision on the representation of the Petitioner preferably within four (4) weeks from the date of communication of this order. Such order shall be duly communicated to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

M/s Teja's Enviro Care, while enclosing a copy of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 09.03.2021 in Writ Petition No.4863 of 2021 submitted a representation dated: 18.03.2021 with a request to place their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

SEIAA addressed a letter with Letter No. SEIAAA/AP/KDP/IND/07/2017/357., dated 9.4.2021., to the project proponent informing that "as per the orders of the Hon'ble high Court

The APPCB RO Vizianagaram has inspected the mining unit and reported on 03-052021, that the petitioner had operated the mine from 2016 to February 2020 and also established and operated a crusher in the site without obtaining required clearances.

Earlier for providing one time opportunity for violation cases the MoEF&CC issued Notification No. 804(E) dated 14.03.2017 in this notification "The projects or activities which are in violation as on date of this notification only will be eligible to apply for environmental clearance under this notification and the project proponents can apply for environmental clearance under this notification only within six months from the date of this notification.. Later another period of 30 days was allowed for such cases to submit their applications vide ref 5th cited. In cases of violation, action will be taken against the project proponent by the respective State or State Pollution Control Board under the provisions of section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and further, no consent to operate or occupancy certificate will be issued till the project is granted the environmental clearance.

The MoEF&CC issued Office Memorandum vide letter dated 16.03.2018 " The project proponent , who have not submitted the proposals within six months window i.e., up to 13th September, 2017 in pursuance of this Ministry's Notification S.O.No. 804 (E) dated 14th March, 2017, are required to submit the proposals within 30 days(up to 13.04.2018) , to the EAC for category A projects or the SEAC/SEIAA in the respective States/UTs for category B projects.

This Petitioner Dr.G.Sudarsana Rao could not submit his proposal within the time frame to utilize the opportunity.

The Hon'ble High Court disposed the case filed by Dr.G.Sudarsana Rao in the Hon'ble High Court of A.P. vide WP 2536/2021, vide order dt.20-04-2021 directing the 5th respondent to consider the application submitted by the petitioner on 17.11.2020 for grant of environment clearanc and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law and communicate the same to the petitioner, within a period of six (06) weeks from today.

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The Standing Counsel communicated his opinion vide letter dated 09.05.2021 on the legal opinion stated is as follows:

1. Your good office SEIAA has requested me to place an opinion in connection with consideration of the proponent application who is also a writ petitioner in WP.No.2536 of 2021.

2. The MoEF & CC, GoI, New Delhi has extended the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) and State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) Andhra Pradesh till 19.06.2021 or till the constitution of new SEAC, SEIAA, Andhra Pradesh whichever is earlier.

3. One of the members of SEIAA has expressed her inability to accept the extension of her tenure on personal grounds and informed to the MoEF & CC, GoI, New Delhi directly on 19.02.2021 and the same was received by SEIAA on 11.03.2021 through MoEF, means there is no quorum.

4. Thus, it is requested your good office kindly issue a proceedings to one G.Sudarshana Rao, writ petitioner in WP.No.2536 of 2021 by informing that their application can be considered only after constitution of SEIAA & SEAC of Andhra Pradesh to avoid contempt of court proceedings within the stipulated time of six weeks as directed by the Hon'ble High Court.

5. Please communicate the said letter/proceedings to me to file an application in the disposal matter i.e., W.P.No.2536 of 2021 to avoid contempt of court proceedings and also to inform to the counsel on record of the same as stated supra.

6. Further, basing on the said proceedings addressed to the writ petitioner, I will also inform to the counsel on record on the foot of the said proceedings, otherwise, it amounts sheer contempt of court for violation of the court order.

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
