The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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Agenda Item No. 01	2.00 Ha. Building Stone & Road Metal of M/s. Sri Sai Ram Stone Crusher, Sy.No .35, Kothgattu Village, Athmakur Mandal, Hanamkonda District. - Extension of Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/293562/2022 (Extension of EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri Chittireddy Ramireddy and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the earlier the lease was transferred on 15.12.2017 in favour of the proponent for unexpired period upto 08.01.2023.

The proponent obtained renewal of lease (in-principle) on 06.07.2022 in favour of the proponent for further period of 20 years and submitted a copy of Scrutinized / Approved Mining Plan.

During presentation the project proponent informed the following:

- As per the gazette notification 13.03.2013, No fresh EC is required for the project for mining projects or activity at the time of renewal of mining lease, which has already obtained EC.
- Same has been clarified in office memorandum dt.20.03.2015, stating that the project proponent which has a valid and sustaining EC for their mining projects either under EIA Notification 1994 or EIA Notification 2006, will not be required to obtain fresh EC at the time of renewal of the lease. This is subject to the maximum period of validity of EC being for mining lease for 30 years.
- As per the notification EC is not required during the renewal of quarry lease area, however as per the LOI, Department of Mines and Geology directed to obtain EC, CFE & CFO, hence applied for Extension of EC.

Earlier, the DEIAA, Warangal issued EC vide order dt.30.06.2018 valid upto 08.01.2023 for mining 21,831 m³/annum Building Stone & Road Metal. The proponent also obtained CFO vide order dt.30.08.2018 valid upto 30.06.2023.

Now, the project proponent submitted proposal on 03.11.2022 for extension of EC for the same production capacity i.e., 21,831 m³/annum. The SEAC noted that the project proponent submitted the proposal for extension within the validity period.

The nearest village is Kothagattu (V) exists at a distance of 1.14 km; nearest water body i.e., a Kunta exists at a distance of 91 m from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 21,831 m³/annum of Road Metal & Building stone and the life of mine is reported as 20 years.

The proposal is for Extension of validity for existing Environmental Clearance order as the existing EC is valid upto 08.01.2023 only.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr.dt.29.09.2022 of the ADMG, Hanamakonda District furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2013-14 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2013-14 to 2021-22.

The proponent submitted a copy of certificate dt. 20.10.2022 issued by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayath, Kothagattu (V) Atmakur (M), Hanamakonda District informing that the proponent has donated Rs. 90,000/- for development of various developmental activities in the Village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of extension of validity of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Niranjan and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt.24.04.2017 to mine 1,32,640 TPA of Laterite & 1,41,440 TPA of Dolomite. The proponent also obtained CFO vide order dt.13.06.2017.

Now, the proponent informed that, after few years of excavation of laterite & dolomite from quarry lease, hard rock is coming while excavation. It is not possible to do mining without drilling and blasting. The proponent is now proposing drilling and blasting in the existing quarry lease and submitted copy of revised Approved Mining plan along with copy of Lr. dt.26.07.2022 of the DDMG, Warangal. Hence, it was requested to issue amendment to EC to include drilling & blasting operations in the mining methodology mentioned in the EC order.

The project proponent also submitted a copy of certificate dt.01.12.2022 of the Sarpanch, Grampanchayat, Sivathanda (V) stating that the project proponent has doted Rs.20,000/- for roads & water developmental works in the village.

The SEAC considered the request of the project proponent and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Amendment to EC to include drilling & blasting operations.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Kiran Kumar and Sri Lakshimikanth Reddy of M/s. Vison Labs, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt.07.12.2019 for construction of Residential Apartments with total built up area of 1,13,361.29 Sq.m. The proponent also obtained CFE vide order dt.21.10.2022.

Now, the proponent informed that there are changes in the project profile as additional land is proposed and a stream is also passing across the project site. It was informed that construction is not yet initiated in the project site. Hence, it was requested to issue amendment to EC with the following changes:

The SEAC informed the proponent to submit copies of land documents along with a copy of NOC issued by the I&CAD Department.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri S. Pavan Kumar and Sri D. Srikanth of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech. Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

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Earlier, the SEIAA, TS issued extension of validity of EC vide order dt.14.06.2013 to mine 3600 m³/annum of Colour Granite, which is valid upto 9 years (13.06.2022). But, it was informed that due to financial & unavoidable circumstances, they unable to start the production and the EC expired on 13.06.2022. Subsequently, the proponent again applied extension of validity of EC without change in production capacity (3600 m³/annum) and the SEIAA vide order dt.26.07.2022 issued extension of EC, but mining capacity as 60,00 m³/annum & 60,000 m³/annum in the order.

Now, the proponent requested to issue amendment to EC with the following changes:

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Amendment to EC w.r.t. production capacity as 3,600 m³/annum.

Agenda Item No. 05	6.77 Ha. Rough Stone & Road Metal Quarry of M/s. Sivam Shankaram Metals, Sy.No: 157, Byathole Village, Kandi Mandal, Sanga Reddy District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/405945/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. V. Surendra and Sri D. Sreekanth of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was granted (in-principle) on 23.12.2019 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 29.11.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District, informing that the quarry lease was not yet opened and not obtained any dispatch permits till date. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 6.77 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs on 12.06.2020 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 22.07.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing that the issues are: greenbelt development – greenbelt development, health camps, employment to local people, CSR funds should be used for effected village. The proponent reported that they provided wet drilling methods, water sprinkling to arrest fugitive, have allocated Rs. 5.0 Lakhs towards budget for CSR and allocated Rs. 7.0 Lakhs budget for EMP.

The nearest village Byathole (V) exists at a distance of 0.53 km (NE); nearest water body i.e Nakka Vagu exists at 1.31 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 1,18,560 m³/annum of Rough Stone and Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 79 years (@1,14,192 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 70.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 7.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 5.50 Lakhs/annum.

After details discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The SEAC deferred the project, as the proponent did not attend the meeting.

Hence, the SEAC decided to inform the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

Agenda Item No. 07	2.75 Ha. Colour Granite Mine of M/s. Designer Rocks Pvt. Ltd., Survey No. 95/1, Devanpalle Village, Bheemgal Mandal, Nizamabad District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/406032/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri S. Shiva Prakash and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 22.05.2002 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. Subsequently, 1st renewal of lease was granted (In-principle) on 03.06.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project, which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Devulapalli (V) exists at a distance 220 mts (SW); nearest water body i.e water pond (Cheruvu) exists at a distance of 302 m (SE); nearest RF exists at 0.19 km (NW) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 17,802 m³/annum of Colour Granite and the life of mine is reported as 49 years (@5340.6 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.11 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.73 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 17.10.2022 of ADMG, Nizamabad District furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period from 2002-03 to 2022-23 (upto 14.06.2022). It is observed from the letter that production dispatch permits were issued during the period 2002-03 to 2022-23 (upto 14.06.2022).

The project proponent vide lr.dt.09.12.2022 of ADMG, Nizamabad District submitted the status of mine that the quarry lease is non working from 01.06.2022 to till date due to logged with the water. The lessee is obtaining dispatch permits for the blocks avail in the quarry site which are produced before expiry of quarry lease i.e., 14.06.2022.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.05.06.2022 issued by the Gramabhivruddhi Committee, Devanpalli Village, Bheemgal Mandal, Nizamabad District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 3,00,000/- for laying CC Road in the village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Manikya Reddy; and Sri A. Mohan Reddy of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earleir, the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt.16.02.2021 for active pharmaceuticals ingredients manufacturing.

Now, the proponent informed that in earlier EC order dt.16.02.2021 the details of solid waste in page no.5 solid waste generated table S.No.5 Spent Solvents quantity was mentioned as 3568.53 kg/day instead of 56084.17 kg/day. The proponent requested to issue corrigendum to EC by changing the Spent Solvent quantity to 56084.17 kg/day.

The SEAC considered the report of project proponent and decided to verify the details & submitted by the project proponent while obtaining EC.

Hence, after detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for detailed examination.

Agenda Item No. 09	4.0 Ha. Building Stone & Road Metal Mine of Sri.B.Venkateshwara Rao, Sy.No. 794, Ananthagiri Village, Munagala Mandal, Suryapet District. – TOR Violation - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/405132/2022 (TOR Violation)

The representative of the project proponent Sri N. Bhargav; and Sri A. Mohan Reddy of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted on 26.11.2007 in favour of the propcnent for a period of 10 years (i.e., upto 25.11.2017). Subsequently, 1st renewal of lease was granted (In-principle) on 06.12.2017 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 1,21,860 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal. The proponent continued mining operations even after 25.11.2017 without obtaining EC as per lr. dt. 10.08.2022 of ADMG, Suryapet District.

Nearest human habitation is Moglaikota (V) exists at 0.53 km (NE); Nearest water body i.e unnamed water body exsits at 0.23 km (W) from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit final EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

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Agenda Item No. 10	5.16 Ha. Building Stone, Road Metal & Gravel Quarry of M/s. Natural Rock Sand Products, Sy.No. 231/1, Eardanoor Village, Kandi Mandal, Sangareddy District. - TOR - Reg.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Sudharshan and Sri D. Sreekanth of M/s. Sri Sai Manasa Nature Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the quarry lease was granted (in-principle) on 28.09.2018 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 29.08.2022 of ADMG, Snagareddy District, informing that there are five existing quarry leases (granted after 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 5.16 Ha which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 9,72,454 MTA of Building Stone, Road Metal & 19,846 MTA of Gravel. The project proponent informed that they have not started mining operations in the mine lease area and the same is verified in the KML file and observed that it is a fresh mine.

Nearest human habitation is Eardanoor (V) @ 0.89 km (SW); Nearest water body i.e Koyyagundu Thanda water body exists at 1.92 km (SW) from the mine lease area.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from October – December 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Stone and Metal Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from October – December 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from October – December 2022 as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for “Mining of Minerals” and undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

Agenda Item No. 11	Residential Apartments by M/s. Primark Developers, Survey Nos. 151, 153, 161, 164, 165 and 171, Bahadurpally Village, Dundigal-Gandimisamma Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/INFRA2/405343/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Venkata Janardhan Reddy and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 54,636.26 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 6,829.53 Sq.m. (12.50%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 2,11,052.03 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 1016 no. of units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Blocks - A to O (C + S + 8 Floors); and Club House 1 & 2 (G + 5 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 65,282.73 Sq.m. (44.78% against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.275.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.2.7 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs. 42.0 lakhs/annum.

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During presentation, the SEAC observed that a water body exists adjacent to site. But, project proponent has not submitted any NOC from I&CAD Department.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of NOC from I&CAD Department.

During presentation the project proponent informed the following:

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The proponent also submitted a copy of Certificate dt.01.06.2021 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Nagilla Village, Madgul Mandal, Rangareddy District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 1,00,000/- for construction of temple in the village. The proponent also submitted undertaking letter for greenbelt development mentioning that they will develop greenbelt in their own land of 4.0 Acres which is at a distance of 50m and they will contribute for CSR through online and will maintain records of the same.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Satyanarayana and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 19.06.2021 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit evidence/document from the Mining Department w.r.t earlier production details though permits were not issued by the Mining department, as claimed by the proponent. The SEAC also informed the proponent to submit details of EMP measures, greenbelt development and CSR activities already implemented by the project proponent.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.01.10.2022 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Kothakota (M), Mahaboobnagar District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 1,00,000/- for various developmental activities of the village like repairing of roads, drinking water facility and for development of the school.

The project proponent submitted an undertaking letter for greenbelt development stating that they will develop greenbelt in their own land of Ac.1.5 which is at a distance of 100m away from the mine lease area and will also develop greenbelt in the mine lease area.

The SEAC observed that the proponent has not submitted earlier production details letter issued by the Mining department. Hence, the SEAC again informed the proponent to submit earlier production details duly issued by the Mining department.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC again deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Srinath Goud; and Sri Ravi Kiran of M/s. Pragathi Labs & Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

It is observed that, the SEAC placed the proposal in its meeting held on 24.09.2022 and deferred the project, as the proponent did not attend the meeting. The SEAC also informed the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting. Accordingly, the proponent uploaded willingness letter on 06.12.2022 and hence the proposal is being considered in this meeting.

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During presentation, the proponent informed the following:

- The mine lease period is 20 years, whereas order is valid for 6 years. As per the EC general conditions the proponent has to go for EC validity extension as validity period is less than lease period.
- Later, they found there are more proved reserves. Hence, a new Mining plan has been prepared (Mining Scheme – letter no. 1945/QS/VKB/2021 on 23.06.2022 for 5 years), and found reserves around 63,20,005 T, and the life of mine estimated 37 years.
- As per the new notification (MoEF&CC Notification S.O.221 (E) dated. 18.01.2021) the validity of EC increased for one more year.
- Based on the above notification this mine validity extended upto 20-03-23 from 20.03.22.

Note: "9A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this notification, the period from the 1st April 2020 to the 31st March, 2021 shall not be considered for the purpose of calculation of the period of validity of Prior Environmental Clearance granted under the provisions of this notification in view of outbreak of Corona virus (COVID-19) and subsequent lockdowns (total or partial) declared for its control, however, all activities undertaken during this period in respect of the Environmental Clearance granted shall be treated as valid."

- Since the existing EC validity is expiring on 20.03.2023 and life of mine is estimated upto 37 years, the proponent requested to consider by SEAC to extend the existing EC validity period with the same production quantity.

Earlier the SEIAA, TS issued EC vide order dt.21.03.2016 for mining @ 1,70,000 TPA of Laterite with validity upto 20.03.2022. The proponent also obtained CFO vide order dt.12.08.2021 with validity upto 31.07.2022.

Subsequently, the project proponent submitted proposal on 27.07.2022 for extension of the validity period with same production capacity. The SEAC noted that the proponent submitted proposal for extension of EC within the validity period considering S.O. 221 (E), dt.18.01.2021.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted on 20.09.2016 for 20 years upto 13.07.2036.

The proponent submitted copy of lr.dt.07.12.2022 of the ADMG, Vikarabad District furnishing dispatch particulars during the period 2015-16 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2016-17 to 2021-22 except during 2015-16.

The proponent submitted a copy certificates dt. 12.04.2022 & 26.10.2022 issued by the Principal, Govt. Junior College, Nawabpet (M), Vikarabad District informing that the proponent has spent Rs.1,50,000/- for leveling sports ground in the college; and also informed that they have donated Rs.50,000/- for the Stage & RO plant repairing and Ground cleaning of the college.

The proponent submitted undertaking dt.10.12.2022 that they will develop greenbelt in their own land to an extent of Ac.2.30 located at Sy.No.71 of Allapur (V), Dharur (M), Rangareddy District and submitted copies of land documents. The proponent submitted another undertaking that they will develop greenbelt in the land to an extent of Ac.1.20 located at Sy.No.115 of Madireddipally (V), Nawabpet (M), Vikarabad District which he has taken on lease for 38 years for development of greenbelt and submitted copies of Land Documents along with Lease Agreement.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of extension of validity for EC.
