**Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 18.02.2022**

<b>Agenda Item No. 01</b>	<b>4.86 Ha. Black Granite Mine of M/s. Sri Sai Shiva Stones, Sy. No. 169, 170, 171, 172, 173, 175, 176, 177, Tettalapadu (V), Thirumalayapalem (M), Khammani District - Environmental Clearance - Reg.</b>

The representative of the project proponent attended on Video Call and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the mine was determined earlier and subsequently, fresh lease was granted (in-principle) on 16.11.2019 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr. dt. 22.02.2020 of ADMG, Khammam District informing that there are 3 existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. It is observed from the letter that for 2 leases, ECs were granted before 15.01.2016 and remaining one lease was granted after 09.09.2013. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.86 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 7.23 Ha. and Net cluster area is 5.73 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, issued TORs (Auto generated) on 27.10.2020 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 17.12.2021 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing & representation that the issues emerged during public hearing are - employment to local people; Noise pollution from mining activity; conduct medical camps; Plantation along roads and in village, maintenance of vehicles, water sprinkling, etc.,

The nearest village to the proposed site is Tettalapadu (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.1 km; nearest water body i.e., Canal exists at 335m (N) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 60,890 m<sup>3</sup>/annum (Recovery Granite @ 6089 m<sup>3</sup>/annum and Waste @ 54801 m<sup>3</sup>/annum) of Black Granite and life of the mine is reported as 20 years (@6809 m<sup>3</sup>/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs.45.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.5.73 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs.2.77 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent attended on Video Call and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 29.05.2020 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr. dt.06.11.2020 of ADMG, Sangareddy District informing that there are 3 existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. It is observed from the letter that 2 leases were granted before 09.09.2013 and remaining one lease granted after 09.09.2013. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.00 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 27.54 Ha. and Net cluster area is 14.12 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

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The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, issued TORs (Auto generated) on 02.01.2021 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 17.11.2021 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing & representation that the issues emerged during public hearing are - employment to local people; dust pollution from mining; conduct medical camps; water sprinkling, greenbelt development, difficulty in grazing cattle, reduction in crop yield, laying CC roads, etc.,

The nearest village to the proposed site is Yerdanur Tanda which is existing at a distance of 0.65 km; nearest water body i.e., Small water pond exists at 65m (E) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 69,600 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal & 11,600 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Gravel and the life of mine is reported as 6.16 years for Rough Stone & Road Metal and 5.35 years for Gravel.

The total cost of the project is Rs.35.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.6.13 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs.2.65 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative Sri Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended before the SEAC and informed that there are few modifications in the proposal after uploading documents and hence they are withdrawing the proposal.

In view of the above, the SEAC decided to return the proposal.

The representative of the project proponent attended on Video Call and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed within 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, Kokapet (V) is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that few trees exists in the site. In this regard, the proponent informed that the intervening trees will be translocated to the boundaries of the site.

The proponent informed that they have obtained NOC dt. 18.01.2021 for height clearance from Airports Authority of India w.r.t. the proposed project and submitted a copy of the same. It is observed from the NOC that the site elevation is 549.6 mts AMSL and the permissible top elevation is restricted to 790.96 mts AMSL. The SEAC noted that the height of the building is within the permissible top elevation restricted by the AAI.

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The project is proposed in a total plot area of 17,895.78 Sq.m., for construction of Residential Apartments with total built-up area of 2,45,137.61 Sq.m.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from October to December-2021 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report, based on the Standard Terms of Reference for Townships and Area Development projects.

The SEAC considered the request of the proponent. After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Townships and Area Development projects" considering baseline data from October to December-2021 and submit EIA report.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 07.01.2022 SEAC informed the proponent to submit justification for the same along with revised layout plan duly marking the greenbelt area, existing & proposed utilities with area breakup. Accordingly, the project proponent submitted reply.

The SEAC examined the documents and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent attended on Video Call and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, it is observed from the Googlemap and topomap that Pamula Vagu flows adjacent to the site. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 09.12.2021 issued by Superintending Engineer, I&CAD, Irrigation Circle, Sangareddy. It is observed from the document that the applicant's land over an extent of Ac. 21-18 Gts. is not affected under MFL / Nala but an area of Ac. 00-29 Gts. is affected under 9m buffer and the balance land is Ac. 20-29 Gts. Accordingly, the proponent proposed the layout of the project.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 86,805.02 Sq.m., & Net Site area is 83,471.27 Sq.m., out of which green area is 8,366.77 Sq.m. (10.02%).

It was informed that the total built-up area of the project is 95,341.64 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Villas to accommodate 274 no. of Villas (G + 2 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided with 1 car parking and 2 wheelers parking spaces for each villa.

The total cost of the project is Rs.118.6 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.125.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs.15.0 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The SEAC also observed from the revised EMP budget that the EMP capital cost is Rs. 3.0 Lakhs and Recurring cost is Rs. 0.55 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent attended on Video Call and Ms. Lakshmi Rawat of M/s. AECOM India Private Limited, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 85,501 Sq.m., out of which, green area is 10,500 Sq.m. (12.2%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 67,336 Sq.m. The project consists of Data Center for Microsoft at HYD 01 with 2 DC Buildings (G + 4 Floors) & Utilities.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 14,162 Sq.m., (21.03%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.520.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.266.0 Lakhs and Recurring cost: Rs.37.0 lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the SEAC observed from the google map that the project site is adjacent to a water body. In this regard, the proponent informed that they have applied for NOC from the I&CAD Dept. w.r.t. water body and yet to receive the same.

The SEAC also observed that the proposed EMP cost is less than 0.2% of project cost which is insufficient and also noted that the Parking area is insufficient as per G.O.Ms.No.168, dt.07.04.2012 of the MA&UD Dept. Hence, the proponent was requested to revise and submit the details along with the NOC from the I&CAD Dept.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the proponent.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Bheemayaram (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.01 km; Nearest RF is Mulugu RF exists at 3.2 km from the boundary of the site.

Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.
