The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

**Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 08.06.2022**

<b>Agenda Item No. 01</b>	<b>2.00 Ha. Rough Stone &amp; Road Metal Mine of Sri V. Chandra Reddy, Survey No. 186, Kasarabad Village, Suryapet Mandal, Suryapet District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.</b>
<b>Proposal No.</b>	<b>SIA/TG/MIN/273674/2022 (EC)</b>

The representative of the project proponent Sri V. Bharath Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs and Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 11.06.2008 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.00 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Kasarabad (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.5 km; nearest water body i.e., Musi river exists at 194 m (W) from the mine lease area. The proponent submitted an undertaking that no waste will be dumped into the river from their mining activity.

It is proposed to mine 42,150 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 8 years (@ 38,880 m<sup>3</sup>/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 20.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.48 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.77 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 25.04.2022 of ADMG, Suryapet District furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2008-09 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2008-09 to 2021-22 except during 2018-19 & 2019-20.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.26.09.2021 issued by School of Kesaram (V), Suryapet District which is about 2.5 km from mine lease area stating that the proponent has spent an amount of Rs 50,000/- for construction of incomplete compound wall and levelling the ground for the development of school.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri S. Bheem Reddy and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs and Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the proponent obtained EC vide order dt.20.01.2018 by the DEIAA, Nirmal District for mining 60,000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Building Stone and Road Metal Mine mentioning validity period of 3 years or expiry lease period of 15 years or which ever is earlier.

Now, the proponent informed that they found a typographical error w.r.t validity of EC as 3 years though lease was executed on 28.02.2018 for 10 years i.e upto 27.02.2028 and life of mine is reported as 14.9 (say 15 years). Hence, it was requested to issue corrigendum to EC mentioning validity period as 15 years.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 17.05.2022 of ADMG, Nirmal District furnishing the details of production and dispatch particulars during the period 2017-18 to May 2022. It is observed from the letter that no production was carried out in 2017-18 and from Feb 2021 to May 2022.

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The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.24.09.2021 issued by Primary School of Mamada (M), Nirmal District stating that the proponent has spent an amount of Rs 80,000/- for benches, chairs and table for the school.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of Corrigendum to EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Raj Kumar and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 23.05.2018 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 17.09.2019 of ADMG, Sangareddy District informing that there are 3 quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.65 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 25.19 Ha. and Net cluster area is 25.19 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA issued TORs (Auto generated) on 27.10.2020 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 26.04.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing & representations that the issues emerged during public hearing are employment to locals, development of greenbelt/plantation around the mine lease and along haul roads, maintain blasting timings and water sprinkling on haul roads etc.,

During presentation, the SEAC observed from the previous images (Google timelines) that no mining activity is started in the mine lease area.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Yerdanur Thanda which is existing at a distance of 950 m; nearest water body i.e., water pond (Cheruvu) exists at 700m from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 1,20,000 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Rough Stone and Road Metal mine and the life of mine is reported as 11 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 45.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.54 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.64 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 20.12.2021 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

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The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 17.02.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.10 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 2.10 Ha. and Net cluster area is 2.10 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Korlakunta (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.65 km; nearest water body i.e., Cheruvu exists at 440m (SE); nearest RF i.e., Wailal RF exists at 0.4 km (NE) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 1,05,811 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Building Stone and Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 7 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 25.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.78 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.25 Lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The SEAC noted that the project is for Rough Stone and Road Metal with Mine Lease Area of Acres 16.10 Gts (6.52 Ha.) which is more than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B1

Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 1,38,720 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Rough Stone and Road Metal.

The SEAC noted from Procds. dt. 24.07.2008 that quarry lease was granted in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent started mining operations from the year 2008-2009 as per lr. dt. 26.02.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Deshmuki @ 1.6 km; Nearest water body i.e., Seasonal Musi River exists at 4.2 km (N); nearest RF i.e., Kawadipalli RF exists at 3.1 km from the mine lease area.

Hence, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. 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The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from December 2021 to February 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017 & S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018 and OM dt. 07.07.2021 & 28.01.2022 undergo the process of Public Hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from October 2020 to December 2020 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Mine. The SEAC considered the request of the

proponent for utilizing the baseline data from October 2020 to December 2020 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals", undergo the process of public hearing in consultation with TSPCB and submit final EIA report along with minutes of public hearing & response of the proponent to the issues emerged in the public hearing to the SEAC for appraisal.

Accordingly, the proponent proposed layout of the project.
