Agenda item- 1.Conformation of the resolutions adopted the 3rd meeting of SEAC, Assam

Resolution 3/1: The Chairman SEAC, Assam read out the minutes of the 3rd meeting of SEAC, Assam held on 5th August, 2020 and the resolutions have been approved.

Agenda item- 2.

- 1. EC FOR COLLECTION OF ORDINARY EARTH from “CHOONCHALI GRANT ORDINARY EARTH MPA” under Kamrup East Division by Guwahati Medical & Research Centre(SEIAA. 1250/2020)**

Resolution 3/1:

After Scrutiny of the documents and due discussion the committee **Recommended** the project allowing to extract 12600 Cu.M of ordinary Earth within 2 years time i.e @ 6300 Cu.M per year strictly and adhering to the statutory conditions laid down by the Geology and Mining deptt, Assam.

- 2. EC for Ordinary Earth from “Maliata Gaon Patta Land Ordinary Earth & Stone MPA”under Kamrup (East) Forest Division by Sri Gajen Das.(SEIAA.1226/2020)**

Resolution 3/2:

The committee has **recommended** the project after due deliberation permitting to extract 3924 Cu.M of ordinary earth and weathered stone from the allotted mining area within 2 years time following statutory conditions laid down by the Geology and Mining Deptt, Assam.

3. E.C for Collection of sand from “Chaparmukh kopili Nodi Sand P.A –(1)” under Nagaon Forest Dev by *Iman Ali(SEIAA.1168/2020)*

Resolution 3/3:

On scrutiny of the records, it is revealed that the project **recommended** in operative since past one year. The committee desire a feasibility report from the DFO, Nagaon Forest Division along with his recommendation for consideration. Both the project proponent and DFO Nagaon Forest Division be informed for their necessary action in taking consideration of the project.

4. EC for Collection of brick earth from “Chatial (SBI) Brick Earth MPA” Under Nagaon Forest Dvn by *Sri Baranya Khaund.(SEIAA. 1169/2020)*

Resolution 3/4:

On Scrutiny of the documents, it is revealed that the NOC issued by the Sub- Division Office(civil), Kaliabor on 24/05/2013 is already expired on 31/03/2014. The project proponent be directed to furnished fresh NOC as well as Certificate showing non- agriculture land from the concern Revenue Authority for consideration of the project.

5. EC for Collection of Sand From “ Disang River Sand MPA” under Sivasagar Forest Dev .by *Sri Ujjal Baruah. (SEIAA. 1163/2020)*

Resolution 3/5:

The project is **recommended** by the committee after due discussion allowing to extract 1500 Cu.M of sand with 1 (one) year period strictly observing statutory conditions laid down by the Geology and Mining deptt, Assam in this respect.

6. EC For Ordinary Earth “NIZ HAJO CLAY MPA” under N.K Forest Division by *Apurba Kr Das. (SEIAA1204/2020).*

Resolution 3/6:

On Scrutiny of the documents , it is observed that the proposed site is close to the river bank . The committee **recommended** the project proposal to collect 16,000 Cu.m of ordinary clay for 2 (two) years period i.e 8000 Cu.M per annum . The extraction be strictly made atleast 100 mt. away from the

high bank of the river to avoid bank erosion. The DFO N.K Division should ensure that the mining operation be permitted strictly adhering to the statutory conditions.

7. **EC for Collection of Boulder Sand & Gravel from “Borgang Sand, Gravel & Boulder Contract Area No.6” under Sonitpur(East) Division by Sri Jiban Ch. Gogoi. (SEIAA.1316/2020)**

Resolution 3/7:

The project Proposal is **recommended** to extract 12875 Cu.m of sand , 10725 Cu.M gravel and 4300 Cu.M of Boulder within 5(five) years time strictly following the statutory conditions laid down but allowing 2(two)mt. depth of excavation . The DFO, Sonitpur East Dvn, is requested to ensure that the Mining operation is allowed strictly following to the statutory conditions laid down by the Geology & Mining Deptt. Assam.

Resolution 3/8:

On Scrutiny of the documents and after discussion the committee **recommended** the project allowing to extract 86918 Cu.M of river clay for 2 (two) years time i.e 43459 Cu.M annually strictly following the terms and condition laid down by the Geology & Mining, Assam. The depth of excavation should not be more than 1.5 mts along with the condition laid down by the DM, Kamrup (M) Communicated on 13/05/2020 against this project.

9. **EC for Extraction of Ordinary Earth From “Kalibari Rajah Chahar P.P. Land Ordinary Earth MPA” Under Sonitpur West Dvn by Md Anuwar Hussian. (SEIAA.1321/2020)**

Resolution 3/9:

On Scrutiny of the documents, it is seen that non agriculture land certificate has not been furnished.On discussion, the committee recommended the project for extraction of 71934 Cu.M of ordinary earth for 2 (two) years period subject to the production of non- Agriculture land certificate issued by the concerned Revenue Authority.

10. **EC for Collection of sand from : Barpani Sand Permit Area” under Nagaon Dvn by M/s Tribeni Construction ltd. (SEIAA.1323/2020)**

Resolution 3/10:

The committee after discussion **recommended** the project proposal for extraction of 12,500 Cu.M of sand for 1 year time Strictly following the terms and condition laid down by the Geology and Mining Deptt, Assam and mining should be done 50 mtr away from the high bank.The concern DFO

should monitor the mining operation from time to time to ensure adherence of the conditions laid down there in.


