

MINUTES OF MEETING OF STATE EXPERT IMPACT ASSESSMENT AUTHORITY, SIKKIM HELD AT 11:00 AM ON 12.03.2024 IN TRAGOPAN HALL AT FOREST SECRETARIAT, DEORALI, GANGTOK.

In pursuance of the meeting notice vide no. 941/CCF/T/HQ/F&ED, dated 03.02.2024 of the Member Secretary, SEIAA, Sikkim, the meeting of the SEIAA, Sikkim was convened under the chairmanship of Sh. B.S Siktel, the Chairman, SEIAA, Sikkim at 11:00 am on 12.03.2024 in the Tragopan Hall, Forest Secretariat, Gangtok. The list of participants is at Annexure -I

1. Name of the proposal: Regional sanitary landfill facility at Mangan, North Sikkim.
2. Proposal No; SIA/SK/INFRA2/454716/2023

4. Land requirement and its land use classification: Forest land (2 hectare). Copy of final clearance/approval for diversion for the same under FC Act, 1980 has not been enclosed/reportedly not obtained. It is also mentioned that out of 2 hectares for forest land, 1500 sq.m will be used for solid waste management and rest will be used for green belt development.
5. Details of waste water management proposed:
 - a) Waste water generation per day : 3.4 KLD
 - b) Quantity of treated water proposed to use per day: 2.8 KLD
 - c) Quantity of treated water proposed to discharge outside the premises per day: 0.6 KLD

d) Purpose for which treated water is proposed to be used: Greenbelt development purpose

6. Details of proposed solid waste generation and management:

The project proponent (Urban Development Department, Government of Sikkim) made a power point presentation on the proposal as per the template provided along with the meeting notice, during the meeting dated 03.02.2024.

Discussion:

- a) RCC wall should be constructed across the boundary of the project site.
- b) Local Development Plan should be in the name of UDD Department.

- d) The Department should take Certification of organic compost from accredited body.
- e) The Urban Development Department should follow the guidelines of Municipal Solid Waste Management Rules, 2006
- f) The feasibility of RDF to be explored.
- g) Copy of layout plan need to be submitted by the User Agency.
- h) MoU need to be Submitted by the User Agency.
- i) The Details of Manpower need to be properly elaborated
- j) The User Agency should submit NOC of land use from competent authority.
- k) Carbon foot print contribution need to properly elaborated.
- l) Excessive amount of compost material in Leachate treatment plant need to be properly elaborated.
- m) Submit details of monitoring of water quality around the landfill site. Water analysis report not addressed briefly. The user Agency should collect data from CWC.
- n) Disaster Management Plan need to be elaborated properly.

Recommendation:

The Committee decided to Recommend the proposal. The Committee needs additional documents from the User Agency and should be complied in the EIA/EMP report.

Recommendation:




