The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Pavan Kumar; and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions. Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA issued EC vide order dt.01.02.2020 to the project.

Now, the proponent informed that there are some changes in their proposal after finalization of drawings due to which there is increase in built up area and also few other changes. It was informed that they have started construction of the project and presently it is at cellar level. Hence, it was requested to issue amendment to EC with following changes:

The representative of the project proponent Sri S. Raja Reddy; and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions. Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 8679.53 Sq.m., Net plot area is 7708.59 Sq.m., out of which green area is 1038.80 Sq.m. (13.48%).

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It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 555,11.28 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments to accommodate 322 units. Maximum no. of floors proposed in the project are 2C+S+10 Floors.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 17079.06 Sq.m., 44.44% against required 33%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 60.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.82.0 Lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 18.0 lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri M. Veeraswamy ; and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions. Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was earlier granted on 11.01.2013 in favour of M/s. Girijana & Waddera Civil works Labour Contact Paraspara Sahakara Sangham Ltd., for a period of 10 years upto 10.01.2023. Subsequently, the ADMG, Warangal Rural vide Prods dt.13.04.2018 changed the name of the society from M/s. Girijana & Waddera Civil works Labour Contact Paraspara Sahakara Sangham Ltd., to M/s. Girijana Civil works Labour Contact Paraspara Sahakara Sangham Ltd. The lease was then transferred to M/s. Sri Durga Bhavani Stone Crubsher on 09.11.2018 for unexpired period of mine lease upto 10.01.2023. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. The proponent was carrying out mining operations, but the Mining Department has stopped giving permits and directed the proponent to obtain EC. Hence, the proponent applied for EC. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

It may be noted that the Mine Lease was initially granted before 09.09.2013 and hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. However, the proponent also submitted a copy of Ir.dt. 10.03.2021 of ADMG, Warangal Rural District informing that there are no existing quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 1.0 Ha. which is less than Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 1.0 Ha. and Net cluster is 1.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Venkatapuram (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.02 km; nearest water body i.e., field channel exist at 130 mts (SW); Nearest RF is Ingurthy RF exists at 4.86 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 21,306 m³/annum of Building stone & Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 11 years (@17889.6 m³/annum .

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 6.4 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.23Lakhs/annum.

During presentation, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit earlier production details certified by the Mining Department, EMP measures, Greenbelt development and CSR activities already implemented by the project proponent.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri R. Thirumla Rao; and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was earlier granted on 20.11.2003 in favour of Sri V. Ravinder Reddy for a period of 20 years. Subsequently, the lease was transferred to Smt. M. Lakshmi on 14.12.2015 for unexpired period of mine lease upto 08.01.2024. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted before 09.09.2013. The proponent was carrying out mining operations, but the Mining Department has stopped giving permits and directed the proponent to obtain EC. Hence, the proponent applied for EC. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

It may be noted that the Mine Lease was initially granted before 09.09.2013 and hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. However, the proponent also submitted a copy of lr.dt. 19.06.2020 of ADMG, Warangal Urban District informing that there is one quarry lease (5.250 Ha. – Lease granted before 09.09.2013 & its Renewal application under process) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 0.60 Ha. which is less than Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 5.850 Ha. and Net cluster is 0.60 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Tarlapalli (V) which is existing at a distance of 1.37 km; nearest water body exist at 0.4 km (NE) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 11,315.70 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 3 years (@ 11185.70 m³/annum).

The total cost of the project is Rs.50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.96 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.98 Lakhs/annum.

The SEAC noted that the ADMG, Warangal Urban vide lr.dt.07.04.2021 furnished year-wise permit particulars with details of permits issued for the period from 2012-13 to 2020-21. It was reported in the letter that mining operations were carried out and permits were issued during the period 2015-16 to 2016-17 only. No permits were issued in the remaining periods.

During presentation, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit EMP measures, Greenbelt development and CSR activities already implemented by the project proponent.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the proponent.

The representative of the project proponent Sri B. Harinadha; and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, Telangana issued EC vide order dt.23.10.2015 for mining 15,498 TPA of Black Granite with validity period of 4 years. The proponent also obtained CFO vide order dt.21.02.2017 valid upto 30.04.2021.

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Now, the proponent uploaded the proposal on 17.03.2021 for Extension of validity of EC. In this regard, the proponent informed that though they have carried out mining operations they have not extracted the mineral completely as proposed earlier. Further, it was informed that they have now applied for Extension and carried out mining operations considering the validity period of maximum 30 years as per provisions of EIA, 2006 & its subsequent amendments. Now, as per latest mining scheme / plan, the proponent slightly reduced the mining capacity to 15,492 TPA and thus the life of mine is 5.35 years. Hence, the proponent requested for extension of validity period of EC.

During presentation, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit earlier production details certified by the Mining Department, EMP measures, Greenbelt development and CSR activities already implemented by the project proponent.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the proponent.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 28.11.2019 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease is granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of lr.dt. 27.06.2020 of ADMG, Khammam District informing that there are two quarry leases (leases granted before 09.09.2013) falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.679 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 10.679 Ha. and Net cluster is 4.679 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village to the proposed site is Bavannapalem (V) which is existing at a distance of 0.77 km; nearest water body i.e., small water pond exist at 161 mts (SE); Nearest RF is Kannegiri RF exists at 1.1 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 1,00,440 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal and 11,160 m³/annum of Gravel. The life of mine is reported as 31 years.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 19.02.2021 observed that massive vegetation exists in the site and hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit additional land documents acquired for development of greenbelt.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted undertaking along with copies of land documents. The proponent submitted undertaking that:

1. Buffer zone of 7.5 mts with an extent of 0.44 Ha. shall be left around the mine area.
2. They have vacant patta land (own) situated at Sy.No.161/2, Amberipeta (V), Velgatoor (M), Jagitial District over an extent of Ac.2.03.
3. Additionally, they have patta land in Sy.No.161/1, Amberipeta (V), Velgatoor (M), Jagitial District over an extent of Ac.2.04. This is their brother's land (Name: Md. Sammad). This land also shall be dedicated to compensatory plantation in lieu of the greenery to be removed on the hillock. Totally Ac. 4.07 shall be dedicated to compensatory plantation.

The SEAC noted the reply furnished by the proponent and observed that the above land is located in different Village & Mandal and also it is about 4.0 km away from the mine lease area, as informed by the proponent.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC referred the project to the SEIAA for taking a decision.
