The EC is valid only if the scheme of the mining plan is approved by the Commissioner of Geology & Mining or any officers nominated on his behalf. 2. The District Collector shall ensure that the DSR (District Survey Report) shall be finalized before execution of mining lease, as per EIA Notifications 2016 as amended in 15.01.2016 and the copy of the revised/approved DSR may be sent to SEIAA for record. 3. Mining activity should be reviewed by the District Collector after one Year and decide for further extension. 4.
