The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

**Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 08.07.2022**

The representative of the project proponent Sri Chandrasekhar and Sri P. Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 13.01.2022 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of lr.dt. 05.07.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District informing that there are no quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.95 Ha which is less than 5.0 Ha. The total cluster is 4.95 Ha and net cluster is 4.95 Ha which is less than 5.0 Ha. Hence, the project is considered under B2 Category as per provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT.

The nearest village Sriripuram (V) exists at a distance 0.56 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e., Chirumakka Cheruvu exists at 77 m (E); Nearest RF i.e., Rajiv RF exists at 2.4 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 4,70,355.60 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Stone & Metal and the life of mine is reported as 5.6 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 45.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.5 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.08 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 06.07.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District, it is observed from the letter that the proponent has not yet commenced any operations.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that a water body i.e., Chirumakka Cheruvu exists at 77 m from the proposed quarry lease. In this regard, the project proponent submitted an Undertaking vide lr. dt. 08.07.2022 to safeguard the lake area by allocating 10m buffer zone inside the lease area towards the lake side and a retain wall will be constructed to protect the lake.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri A. Narayana and Sri P. Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier the lease was granted on 23.05.2008 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years. Subsequently, the proponent obtained renewal (in-principle) LOI vide Notice dt. 23.05.2022. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Machannapalli (V) exists at a distance 1.16 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e., a water pond exists at 73.62 m (NE); Nearest RF i.e., Naginenipalli RF exists at 5.72 km from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 4,50,000 m<sup>3</sup>/annnum of Stone & Metal and the life of mine is reported as 10 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 35.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.58 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.07 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 13.04.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2008-09 to 2020-21. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2013-14 to 2018-19 except during 2008-09 to 2012-13 & 2019-21.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.06.05.2022 issued by Sarpanch of Maryala (V), Bommalararamam (M), Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 1,30,000/- for RO- Drinking water plant installation expenses and Girls Toilets repairs at ZPHS, Maryala (V), Bommalararamam (M), Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri N. Rama Krishan Reddy and Sri P. Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that earlier the lease was granted on 27.08.2009 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years (i.e., upto 22.10.2029). It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Turkapalli (V) exists at a distance 1.7 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e., Virla Cheruvu exists at 3.94 km (NE) and a water body @ 11m from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 1,079 m<sup>3</sup>/annnum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 14 years (@953.73 m<sup>3</sup>/annnum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 30.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 3.58 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.07 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 31.01.2022 of ADMG, Yadadri-Bhuvanagiri District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2009-10 to 2020-21. It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2009-10 to 2011-12, 2013-14 & 2015-16 except during 2012-13, 2014-15 & 2016-17 & 2020-21.

The SEAC observed from the google map that a water body exists at a distance of 11m from the mine lease area and hence, the proposal is not considered.

In view of the above and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for Rejection of proposal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P. Purnachand and Sri P. Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that initially the lease was granted on dt. 09.12.2004 in favour of Smt. S. Swapna (M/s. Buildmate metal industry) for a period of 15 years. Later, the lease was transferred on 18.02.2008 in favour of M/s. Rocks and Minerals Private Ltd., for the remaining lease period i.e upto 08.12.2019. Subsequently, the lease was renewed (in-principle) vide Notice dt. 03.01.2019 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 1,63,014 m<sup>3</sup>/annum of Stone & Metal. The proponent submitted a copy lr dt.15.09.2021 of ADMG, Sangareddy District with the year wise dispatch details from 2007-08 to 2020-21. The proponent carried out mining operations for the years 2019-20 & 2020-21 without obtaining prior EC i.e., even after renewal (in-principle) of Mine Lease.

Nearest human habitation is Kazipally (V) @ 1.73 km; Nearest water body i.e., Danara Cheruvu exists at 0.77 km (SSE); Nearest RF i.e., Kazipally RF exists at 0.6 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit final EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Smt. P. Spandana and Sri P. Hari Prasad of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The proponent informed that the lease was granted (in-principle) on 16.11.2021 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted after 09.09.2013. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Katikapally (V) exists at a distance 0.66 km from the proposed site; nearest water body exists at 0.69 km (NW); Nearest RF i.e., Gumadavelli RF exists at 50m (S) from the boundary of the site.

It is proposed to mine 1,97,576.06 m<sup>3</sup>/annnum of Rough Stone Road Metal & 10,398.74 m<sup>3</sup>/annnum of Gravel and the life of mine is reported as 8 years (@2,07,974.80 m<sup>3</sup>/annnum).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.10 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.08 Lakhs/annum.

The Proponent also submitted a copy of Ir.dt. 02.02.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District informing that there are 2 quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. It is observed from the letter that 1 lease (Ac.9.0) was granted before 09.09.2013 and another 1 lease (1.589 Ha.) granted after 09.09.2013 (lease granted for allied activity, not for quarrying purpose). The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha which is less than 5.0 Ha. It is observed from the cluster letter that only 2 leases exist within 500 mts. But, it is observed from the google map that another lease (adjacent to mine lease area) also exists within 500 mts from the mine lease area and the proponent informed that adjacent mine (8.09 Ha.) belongs to M/s. Rank Silicon. The SEAC also observed from the google map and topo map that reserved forest exists very near to the mine lease area on southern direction. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit the following:

- Revised cluster letter issued by the Mining Department covering details of all mines located within 500mts from the mine lease area.
- NOC from DFO, Forest Department duly mentioning distance of RF from the proposed mine lease area.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above information by the proponent.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 10.06.2022 informed the proponent to submit the status of Mine certified by the Mining Department, as the mine lease was granted in the year 2018

Now, the proponent submitted a copy of Ir. dt. 21.06.2022 of ADMG, Sangareddy District stating that the proposed quarry is not yet commenced since, the proponent doesn't obtain the EC and other statutory clearances from the Competent Authority.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 12.05.2022 informed the proponent to submit balance sheet of the industry to ascertain that their industry is in losses.

Now, the proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.08.06.2022 issued by Head Master of ZPHS, Aroor (V), Sadasivapet (M), Sangareddy District stating that they are receiving an amount of Rs. 10,000/- from S.S.Organics limited every month from August 2015 to till date. It was informed that those funds they are utilizing towards monthly wages to their Government School Volunteers.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.



- Colfosceril palmitate (used in treatment of Respiratory Distress Syndrome (RDS) in premature infants)

The SEAC noted that the industry has obtained CFE vide order dt. 11.07.2000 in the name of M/s. Astha Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., for manufacture of Glycrophosphates (Calcium, Magnesium, Sodium, etc).

It was informed that the unit was transferred to M/s. Prerana Foundation as part of settlement deed between Astha Laboratories and Prerana Foundation in 25.04.2019. Subsequently, M/s. Vital Synthetic Labs Pvt. Ltd., has taken over the unit in the year 2021 from M/s. Prerana Foundation. The unit applied for EC expansion in the new name of the company i.e., M/s. Vital Synthetic Labs Pvt. Ltd.,

The proponent submitted self certified Compliance Report.

The SEAC noted that the proposal is for expansion of API - Bulk Drugs & Intermediates Manufacturing unit.

The SEAC noted the G.O.Ms. No. 95, dt. 21.09.2007 of the EFS&T Dept., GoAP; G.O.Ms. No. 64, dt. 25.07.2013 & G.O.Ms. No. 24, dt.24.04.2019. of the EFS&T Dept., GoAP.
