1. **Case No. 5788/2018** Prior Environmental Clearance for **Modernization of Manganese Mine** (opencast mechanized method) in an area of 4.99 Ha (4961 TPA of Mn + 2126 TPA of rejects + 4687 TPA of waste) at khasra no. 274 at village – Sonogaon, Tehsil – Tirodi, Dist. – Balaghat (MP) by Shri Dinesh Devendra Agrawal, Khasra no. 274, Village – Sonogaon, Tehsil – Tirodi, Dist. – Balaghat (MP).

- (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of Modernization of Manganese Mine in MLA of 4.99 ha. The activity is mentioned at S.No. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National Park /Sanctuary/Biosphere Reserve etc. thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1' by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease period upto 23.02.2062 with production capacity of ROM 7087 TPA (4961 TPA Mn + 2126 TPA rejects).
- (2) The lease was initially granted to Shri Gopalikisan Agrawal. After expiry of the lease, Govt. has been issued the lease in favour of Shri Dinesh Agrawal for 50 years from 24.02.2012 to 23.02.2062 and the lease area comes under Govt. waste land over an area of 4.99 Ha. This is a case of modernization of mining lease. The Mining Plan with progressive mine closure plan has been approved by IBM, Jabalpur Vide Letter No. - MP/Balaghat/Manganese/RMP-14/2018-19 5804 dated 31.07.2018.
- (3) SEAC in its 421st SEAC meeting dtd 28.01.2020 has recommended the case with 31 special conditions for issuance of EC.
- (4) It was noted that as per DFO L.No. 6129 Balaghat, dtd. 13.08.2013, the National Park/Sanctuary/Biodiversity area is not located within 10 Km., radius from the mining site. Hence, the General Conditions are not attracted.
- (5) It was noted that forest boundary is situated in less than 250 m distance from the ML area. PP has submitted NOC from Committee constituted under the chairmanship of Divisional Commissioner Jabalpur.
- (6) PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.

- (7) It was noted that the water requirement is 10.0 KLD (3.0 KLD for Dust Suppression + 5.0 KLD for Green Belt + 2.0 KLD for Drinking & Domestic purpose) which shall be met from bore well and tankers.
- (8) The proposed plantation programme was examined and it was found that total 2400 saplings shall be covered under plantation program.
- (9) It was also noted that the Public Hearing was carried out on 27.08.2019 at Mine Parisar village – Sonagaon, Tehsil – Tirodi, Dist. – Balaghat (MP) under the Chairmanship of SDM, Balaghat.

After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 421st SEAC meeting dtd 28.01.2020, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:

- I. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
- II. Lease agreement shall be carried out before execution of mining operation.
- III. Plantation programme as mentioned in EIA/EMP and presented during presentation in SEIAA & SEAC shall be followed in content and spirit.
- IV. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as 'no mining zone' in the periphery of mining lease area and will develop a green belt. Three rows plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year with proper watering arrangement.
- V. PP will plant 3 years old 2400 saplings of suitable tree species like Neem, Peepal, Bargad, Dalbergia Sissoo, Amla, Gulmohar, Mango, Ashok, Imli etc. at lease boundary, approach road, haul road, reclaimed area, undisturbed area, buffer zone etc.
- VI. The mining operation shall be restricted to above ground water table and in no case it should intersect the ground water table. In case of working below the ground water table, approval of the Central Ground Water Board shall be obtained.
- VII. The over burden and waste will be stacked for five years and simultaneously backfilled in the mined out area where plantation will be raised on it.
- VIII. No overburden will be dumped outside the mine lease area.
- IX. Regular water quality monitoring shall be carried out by PP before discharging it into the nearby agriculture fields from authorized laboratory in consultation with Regional Officer, MPPCB. Regular air and noise quality monitoring shall also be carried out at regular interval from authorized laboratory in consultation with Regional Officer, MPPCB.
- X. PP shall ensure generation of employment opportunities nearby Village on priority bases.

- XI. Payments of wages to the workers shall be done in consonance with the provisions in the labour laws.
- XII. Proper infrastructure with shelter, drinking water, toilet and first-aid facilities shall be provided for the laborers. A provision should be made to construct a pakka rest shelter along with toilet and drinking water facility.
- XIII. PP should also carry out regular sprinkling in the mining lease area to arrest dust emission from mining activities affecting the nearby agriculture fields.
- XIV. Mining shall be limited to the area as shown in surface plan and as per the approved mining scheme.
- XV. PP shall ensure the proper water supply arrangements for plantation especially in summer season.
- XVI. PP shall ensure proper implementation of plantation, dust suppression, construction of approach road and maintenance of existing pakka road as part of Environmental Management Plan. Additional budget provision shall be made as part of EMP.
- XVII. PP must ensure implementation of the following activities with separate budget provision of Rs. 3.0 Lakhs/year under CER as committed:
 - a) 1st year –
 - ❖ Provisions for amenities like coolers, fans, mats, stools & benches at Govt. Higher Senior Secondary School & Govt. Primary School of village - Sonegaon.
 - ❖ Provisions for Water purifier & its maintenance (1 nos.) at CHC center of village - Sonegaon & public bus stop of Village - Sonegaon & Pipariya.
 - ❖ Provisions for Construction and maintenance of village roads adjacent to project site.
 - ❖ Provision of 0.5 KW Solar Panels with other accessories & its maintenance in Gram Panchayat of village - Sonegaon.
 - ❖ Provision of Rain Water Harvesting Structure with closed drains & maintenance at Gram Panchayat of Village - Sonegaon.
 - b) 2nd year –
 - ❖ Provisions for repairing & maintenance of boundary wall & colouring of school building at Govt. Higher Senior Secondary School & Govt. Primary School of village - Sonegaon.
 - ❖ Provision for Health Check-up camps (Eye & General Health Check-up) at Gram Panchayat of Village - Sonegaon.
 - ❖ Provisions of Rain Water Harvesting Structure with closed drains & maintenance at Gram Panchayat of Village - Sonegaon

- ❖ Provisions for prize distribution & distribution of educational books, stationary, uniforms to meritorious students of class 8th, 10th & 12th of Govt. Higher Senior Secondary School of Village - Bothwa & students of class 5th & 8th at Govt. Primary School of Village - Bothwa (3 students/each class).
 - ❖ Provisions for repairing & maintenance of boundary wall & colouring of CHC center building of Village - Bothwa
- c) 3rd year –
- ❖ Provisions for Imparting vocational training at Gram Panchayat Dhankosa for technical skills, self employment training for women and youngsters of near villages.
 - ❖ Provisions for skill upliftment of women of nearby villages by distributing Sewing Machines and contributions of indoor game facilities at anganwari kendra of nearby villages i.e. Bothwa & Dhankosa.
 - ❖ Blankets & seed distribution to peoples of nearby villages.

The modification to the above activities can be made with the permission of the district administration and need based activity for the development of nearby villages shall be implemented by PP in consultation with the District Collector and Gram Panchayat.

- XVIII. PP should ensure to submit half yearly compliance report, Plantation and CER activity report along with photographs of all activities in MP-SEIAA. If PP is failed to upload or submit two consecutive half yearly compliance reports of EC conditions to concerned authority (SEIAA and Regional Office, MoEF&CC, Gol, Bhopal) than prior environmental clearance issued to PP will automatically be treated as cancelled/ revoked as per OM No. 930/SEIAA/2019 dated 30.05.2019 issued by MPSEIAA.

- IX. Mining shall be limited to the area as shown in surface plan and as per the approved mining scheme.
- X. PP shall ensure the proper water supply arrangements for dust suppression, regular sprinkling, plantation and drinking purposes especially in summer season.
- XI. PP shall ensure proper implementation of plantation, dust suppression, construction of approach road and maintenance of existing pakka road as

- b. To provide chairs and toys for kids in village Aanganwadi.
- c. Installation of 02 handpump and construction of hand pump in common village area.

- (9) It was also noted that the Public Hearing was carried out on 20.11.2019 at Mine Parisar Village- Dabalikhurd, Tehsil - Nepanagar, Dist. Burhanpur under Chairmanship of Upper Collector, Burhanpur. The major comments of applicants during public hearing are water for irrigation, access on approach road, Controlled blasting, employment of local people, construction & maintenance of existing / approach road connecting the mine & main road, Plantation on road side, regular health check-up of mine workers & water sprinkling to suppress the dust emission.

The case was considered in 492nd SEIAA meeting dtd. 07.07.2018 and recorded that:-

- i. *The proposed project is for development of integrated township which will comprise of development of residential plots (3,38,746.24 sq. m.), group housing area (11,526.24 Sq. m.), commercial areas (39,342.94 Sq. mt.) and amenities like bank (2561.39 Sq. m.), police chowki (1153.93 sq. mt.), health centre (3,580.50 sq. m.), hospital (13,626.07 sq. m.), community hall and library (5,173.33 sq. m.), nursery, primary & high schools (16651.7 sq. m).*
- ii. *As per the Joint Director T & CP, Katni (vide letter no.259 dtd 23.05.15) total land area is 8,56,000 sq.m., at Village Jhijhri, Tehsil & Distt. Katni (MP). The project comes under 8 (b) category (B) of schedule of EIA Notification, 2006 because total land area is more than 50 ha.*
- iii. *The case was discussed in SEAC meetings 286th dated 28.01.17 and recommended the ToR and decided to site visit to see the site conditions specially the proximity of river, site drainage etc, after which additional ToR may be issues, if necessary. The same was approved by SEIAA in 410th meeting dtd. 17.02.17 accordingly a ToR letter issued to PP vide letter dtd. 09.03.17. As per decision the site visit carried out on 24.04.17 and the site visit observation was discussed in 289th SEAC meeting dtd. 28.04.17 and the important observations of the committee are as follows:-*
 - a. *It was found at the time of site visit, there was no evidence of construction, hence there is no violation.*

 - iii. *The waste water generation is 3910 KLD and PP has proposed sewage treatment plants of 4500 KLD cumulative capacity. There will be 4 nos. Of STP 1200 KLD(02 nos.), 1100KLD & 1000 KLD. The available treated water is 3714 KLD, out of which 1950KLD shall be reused & recycled and remaining 1105 KLD proposed to discharge in municipal sewer line. **PP has submitted NOC (dtd 27.01.2018) of Municipal Corporation, Katni for linking extra treated waste water in the sewer line.** The dual plumbing system is being proposed for flushing. All treated water will be utilized for flushing, horticulture and site maintenance etc.*
 - iv. *The Municipal Solid waste 5174 KG per day shall be generated from proposed site. The generated biodegradable and non biodegradable waste will be segregated at source within the campus. Recyclable waste is proposed to be sold to vendors for recycling. All non recyclable waste including sludge from STP will be disposed off at trenching ground of Municipal Corporation, Katni. **PP has submitted letter dtd. 27.01.2018 issued from Katni Municipal Corporation for disposal of solid waste.***
 - v. *PP has submitted roof top rain water harvesting system for ground water recharging and has proposed **50.nos** of recharging pits. PP has not submitted storm management plan and location of the proposed recharging pits.*
