A complaint for non-issuance of Environment Clearance to Sh. Hem Singh was received in this office on dated 15.9.2021 by Sh. Amar Chand S/o Sh. Hira Nand, Village Belu Dhank, P.O. Pandoa, Tehsil-Karsog, District-Mandi, HP. Then after the matter was examined by this office and a letter was written to State Geologist from the office of Member Secretary, HP SEIAA on dated 21.09.2021 and 01.11.2021 to examine the matter and submit their comments to this office so that the case of Sh. Hem Singh may be considered for grant of Environment Clearance.

A letter on dated 26.10.2021 was also received in this office from Sh. Hem Singh along with the copies of orders of Hon'ble High Court dated 21.09.2021 in CMP(M) No. 174 of 2021, informing that as per direction of Hon'ble High Court he can do mining in his own land.

Then after a letter was also received from the office of State Geologist vide letter no.Udyog-Bhu (khani-4) Laghu-102/2016-7342 dated 21.11.2021 regarding representation/complaint by Sh. Amar Singh where it has been informed that as per the recommendations of the Joint Inspection

Committee, after completing all the codal formalities a letter of Intent over an area measuring 06-14-16 Bighas has been issued to Sh. Amar Singh and which is valid up to 21.02.2022 and same has not withdrawn.

The case was listed before the SEAC in its 83rd Meeting. After deliberating on the information submitted by the project proponent and considering the facts placed before the committee, the SEAC decided to list the case in next meeting after compliance of the following observations:

Online proposal for granting Environment Clearance was submitted on dated 15/07/2020 and accepted by the SEIAA secretariat on dated 18/09/2020. The hard copy submitted by the project

proponent on dated 03/09/2020 for appraisal by SEAC. Then after, the project proponent submitted case for grant of Environment Clearance on dated 24.11.2021.

The case was appraised by SEAC in its 75th Meeting. After deliberating on the information submitted and considering the facts placed before the committee, the SEAC recommended grant of Standard ToR issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for approval by the SEIAA with the following additional conditions:

- 1) The project proponent shall undertake fresh air, water, soil, ground water quality analysis, no old data shall be used for the purpose of EIA.
- 2) The project proponent shall include under CER to provide two plastic waste shredder, two plastic waste compactors & two plastic waste bailing machine under CER to the concerned ULBs/ RLBs through Department of Environment, Science & Technology, GoHP.
- 3) The project proponent shall undertake and include the detailed analysis of GLC-2.5 with air modeling and shall prepare the wind-rose diagram of the site to plan the installation of PCDs.
- 4) The project proponent shall submit the wider view photographs and video of the mining site using drone camera from all angles depicting the entire picture of the mining site.

Therefore, the project proponent shall submit revised distance certificate from the adjoining mining site of Mr. Jitendra Kumar which has been granted Environment Clearance from MoEF&CC with clarification and justification duly issued from the level of State Geologist.

After submission of the compliance the case was again listed before the SEAC in its 82nd meeting. After deliberating on the information submitted and considering the facts placed before the committee, the SEAC recommended the issuance of Standard ToR issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for preparing EIA/EMP report with the following additional conditions:

1. The project proponent shall make provision for providing six plastic waste shredder, six plastic waste baling machine & six compactor to the concerned ULBs/ PRIs through Department of Environment, Science & Technology, GoHP.
2. The project proponent shall provide 8 solar lights through Department of Environment, Science & Technology, GoHP.

It is observed that the applicant has applied online for grant of EC but in view of the cluster mining case (total areas exceeded 5 hectares) the SEAC in its 82nd meeting recommended the case for grant of standard TOR as per the provision of EIA Notification 2006 and its subsequent provisions. Therefore, this application stands pending on PARIVESH portal for grant of EC. The project proponent may be advised to re-apply for TOR under TOR section on PARIVESH portal and withdraw EC application No. SIA/HP/MIN/230414/2021 from EC section of online portal.

The SEIAA in its 55th meeting approved the issuance of TOR to the proponent subject to the condition that the project proponent shall first withdraw EC application No. SIA/HP/MIN/230414/2021 from EC section of online portal and re-apply for TOR under TOR section on PARIVESH portal so as to remove the pendency on portal.


