This proponent also placed another order of Appeal No.131 of 2016 (SZ) Southern Bench NGT docket order dated 02.06.2016. That shows, he is a litigant rather than service provider. That apart, he addressed that he intends to clear all the bio-medical waste from two district in his application being a</p>
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proponent and this is contrary to the stand taken by the Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board through its workshop on 18.09.2018 titled as "Issues and Challenges in Safe Disposal of Bio Medical Waste", and was decided that the APPCB shall encourage establishment of at least one CBMWTF in each district. Thus, it is contrary to the concept of having one CBMWTF in each district, unlike the 1<sup>st</sup> proponent M/s Rayalaseema Environ Care confined to YSR Kadapa District. This proponent failed to submit the land documents, which is mandatory under Proposed Terms of Reference (TOR) as contemplate under Rule 7D and also TOR. Hence not considered.

Teja's Enviro Care:

This proponent is also proposed at Sy.No.1125 Suddamalla village, Ramapuram Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh, and made an application within the parameters of S.O.1142(E) Ministry of Environment and Forests Notification dated 17.04.2015 as prescribed under Rule 7(da) and proposed the said project in Suddamala Village, Ramapuram Mandal, YSR Kadapa District is 25 KM from Kadapa City. This proponent is a Managing Partner of Teja's Enviro Care and the PARTNERSHIP deed is not placed along with the proponent's application. That shows, the lack of sheer interest alongside failed to place the land documents to appraise the SEIAA. If the other partners do have any sort of problems due to their Partnership Firm then the Public at large will suffer. This proponent's application appears to be half hearted. Hence not considered.

SHORTLISTING as per my legal opinion:

I strongly canvass through this legal opinion that, M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care proponent is Smt.Kodathala Jayalakshmi being a woman. The Union of India and also the State of Andhra Pradesh is encouraging the WOMEN EMPOWERMENT IN DEVELOPING NATIONS through entrepreneurship. In India, it is lower side in comparison with the African Nations and other developing nations. The proponent M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care intending to purchase the land under the terms of Proposed Terms of Reference (TOR). The 1<sup>st</sup> criterion under the said TOR is placed hereunder for appreciation:

"1.Reasons for selecting the site with details of alternative sites examined/rejected/selected on merit with comparative statement and reasons/ basis for selection. The examination should justify site suitability in terms of environmental damages, resources, sustainability associated with selected site as compared to rejects site. The analysis should include parameters considered along with weightage criteria for short-listing selected site."

Thus, I am giving this legal opinion on sound principles of law that, M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care alone do have merit other than the two as discussed above in all aspects and M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care Entrepreneur is a Woman Entrepreneur and it would be a plus point for the said proponent in comparison with the other two proponents of M/s. AWM Consulting Limited and M/s.Teja's Enviro Care respectively.

Conclusion:

Thus, on the foot of the records placed before me and on the strength of the supporting laws, I am giving this opinion that M/ s Rayalaseema Environ Care may be considered for establishing a Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility in YSR Kadapa District. Hence this Opinion."

Subsequently the issue was examined by the SEAC in its meeting held 08.10.2020. The Committee observed the following:
