The members present declared that there are no conflicts of interest with the projects being considered in this meeting. After general introductory remarks by the Chairman, SEAC, the Committee took up items agenda-wise. The decisions of the SEAC on each case are recorded below.

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Agenda Item No. 01	Residential Apartment Construction Project by Sri. Linga Sunil and Others, Survey Nos. 357, 357/C and 357/Part, Jeedimetla, Quthbullapur Mandal, Medchal – Malkajgiri District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/INFRA2/406618/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sr. B. Ranga Rao and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

During presentation, the proponent informed that, earlier they obtained permission from GHMC vide building present order dt.18.12.2021 for construction of Residential Apartments (2 Cellar + Stilt + 5 Upper Floors with total built-up area of 14,580.0 Sq.m. and started construction activities.

Now, the proponent proposed expansion of the project by increasing the total built-up area which is more than 20,000 Sq.m. Hence, it was requested to issue EC for expansion. It was informed that presently, foundation work is under construction.

The proponent submitted Structural stability certificate dt.13.12.2022 stating that the proposed Residential Apartment project comprises of one Residential tower with amenities within the tower. Residential buildings comprise of 2C + Stilt + 10 Upper Floors of Sri Linga Sunil and Others, Sy. No. 357, 357/C and 357/Part, Jeedimetla, Quthbullapur Mandal, Medchal – Malkajgiri District. Earlier the structure was designed for 2C+S5 Floors subsequently the design has been revised for 2C+S+10 upper floors ensuring structural stability and safety for the building as per NBC standards. The structure is reinforced concrete framed structure with RCC wall and slab system for its residential floors and is complying with the Bureau of Indian Standard norms and design is safe and suitable for the purpose for which it is intended. It has been designed in accordance with IS: 456 and IS: 875 and the structure falls under seismic zone II as per seismic code IS: 1893 (Part-1)-2016, the design has been done for same and shall be detailed accordingly.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 4,148.8 Sq.m., Net plot area is 4,059.9 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 409.9 Sq.m. (10.1%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 24,690.2 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Apartments Construction Project to accommodate 135 no. of units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Apartments (2C + S + 10 Floors) including Amenities.

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 7,325.6 Sq.m., (42.19 % against required 33%).

The total cost of the project is Rs.47.44 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.103.8 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 2.7 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs.10.6 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs.24.2 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 02	3.82 Ha. Black Granite Mine of M/s. Satya Sai Granites, Sy.No: 1024, Cheruvumadhavaram Village, Nelakondapally Mandal, Khammam District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/406626/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri N. Saradhi Kumar and Sri Mohan Reddy of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 08.04.2011 in favour of M/s. Sri Sai Stones for a period of 20 years i.e upto 07.04.2031. Then, the lease was transferred on 27.01.2014 in favour of M/s. S.V.S Archean & Dolorite for un-expired period of lease i.e upto 07.04.2031. Later, the lease was again transferred on 27.12.2019 in favour of the proponent for a period i.e upto 07.04.2031. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project.

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The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 3.82 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Cherumadhavaram exists at a distance 0.96 km from the proposed site; nearest water body i.e a stream exists at 0.8 km (ESE); Nearest RF is Atlapragada Kondru RF exists at 1.04 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 4,479.84 m³/annum of Black Granite and the life of mine is reported as 19 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 40.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 4.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 4.50 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 16.11.2022 of ADMG, Khammam District furnishing the details of dispatch particulars during the period 2011-12 to 2022-23 (upto October 2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2011-12 to 2022-23 (upto October 2022).

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.28.10.2022 issued by the Head Master, ZPSS of Cheruvumadhavaram Village, Nelakondapally Mandal, Khammam District stating that the proponent donated Rs. 15,000/- for the developmental activities in the school.

The SEAC observed that CSR activities done by the proponent is inadequate. Hence, the SEAC informed the proponent to acquire land for Compensatory Afforestation near the mine lease area and submit copies of land documents for the same and adequate CSR activities along with evidence fo the same.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

The SEAC deferred the project, as the proponent did not attend the meeting.

Hence, the SEAC decided to inform the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

Agenda Item No. 04	0.857 Ha. Black Granite Mine of M/s. Gayathri Granite Industries, Survey No. 306/A/1, Ramavaram Village, Kodakandla Mandal, Jangaon District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/404027/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Vinod Kumar and Sri Chandrasekhar Reddy of M/s. Space Enviro Solutions, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that earlier, the SEIAA, AP (Combined State) issued EC on 08.05.2013 for mining 3,052 m³/annum of Black granite with validity upto 5 years. Subsequently, the EC expired on 07.05.2018. Hence, the proponent submitted proposal afresh.

During presentation, the proponent informed that they obtained CFE vide order dt.04.05.2016 and also CFO vide order dt.12.07.2016 issued by the TSPCB.

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The SEAC noted the earlier lease was transferred vide Ir dt.12.02.2008 from M/s. Ananth Granites to M/s. Gayatri Granite Industries for un-expired period of lease upto 02.03.2013. Subsequently, 1st renewal of lease was granted (In-principle) on 19.05.2017 for a period of 20 years w.e.f 03.03.2013 upto 02.03.2033. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 0.857 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Eddulapur Thanda exists at a distance 1.06 km; nearest water body i.e Yesvantapuram vagu exists at a distance of 6.0 km (W) from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 3,407.76 m³/annum of Black Granite Mine and the life of mine is reported as 10 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.53 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 3.18 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.10.10.2022 issued by the Sarpanch, of Grama Panchayath, Ramavaram Village, Kodakandla Mandal, Jangaon District, stating that project proponent donated material of worth Rs. 1,75,000 /- for leveling of school ground, graveyard, etc.

The proponent submitted a copy of Ir. dt. 06.08.2022 of ADMG, Jangaon District furnishing the details of production & dispatch particulars during the period from 2013-14 to 2022-2023 (upto July 2022). It is observed from the letter that dispatch permits were issued during the period 2013-14 to 2017-18 and Nil during the period from 2020-21 & 2021-22, whereas production was carried out during 2013-14 to 2017-18 and no production during 2018-19 to 2022-23 (upto July, 2022).

But, the SEAC observed from the ADMG letter of production details that it was issued, not issued by the ADMG. The SEAC also observed from KML file that the proponent carried out mining operations even after the year 2018 without obtaining prior EC.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC informed the proponent to submit revised letter duly certified by Mining Department duly issued by the concerned ADMG w.r.t Latest Production details mentioning the dispatch details and status of mine.

In view of the above, the SEAC deferred the project for consideration after submission of above mentioned information by the proponent.

Agenda Item No. 05	2.02 Ha. or 5.00 Acres. Road Metal Quarry of Sri Mohd. Hassan, Sy. No. 82 of Regondi Village, Peddamul Mandal, Vikarabad District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Md. Hussain and Smt. Srilatha of M/s. Pridhvi Enviro Tech Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 16.06.2003 in favour of the proponent for a period of 15 years i.e upto 19.06.2018. Subsequently, renewal of lease was granted (In-principle) on 29.04.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.02 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Rukmapur (V) exists at a distance 0.45 km (W); nearest water body i.e Kangna river exists at a distance of 0.7 km (SE); Nearest RF is Kamapur RF & Rasnam RF exists at 1.3 km from the mine lease area.

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It is proposed to mine 1,00,000 TPA (66,666 m³/annum) of Road Metal and the life of mine is reported as 21 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 25.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 2.8 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.8 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of Certificate dt.01.11.2022 issued by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Regondi Village, Peddamul Mandal, Vikarabad District stating that the proponent has donated material of worth Rs. 50,000/- for various developmental activities in the village.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 25.10.2022 of ADMG, Vikarabad District furnishing the details of production during the period from 2003-04 to 2018-19. It is observed from the letter that production was carried out during the period 2003-04; 2004-05 & from 2006-07 to 2018-19 and Nil during the period 2005-06. It was also reported that quarry lease period is for 15 years w.e.f. 20.06.2003 and consequentially proponent applied for renewal of quarry lease w.e.f.19.06.2018 and as the quarry lease in non working and the same will be renewed and granted on receipt of EC, CFE & CFO in accordance with notice dt.29.04.2022 issued by DDMG, Hyderabad.

The SEAC noted from the KML file that, mining was carried out after 19.06.2018, but ADMG lr. was issued stating that no mining was carried out after 2018.

The SEAC considered the letter of the ADMG and after detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 06	2.0 Ha. Stone & Metal of M/s. K&N Stone Crusher, Sy. No.355 of Gudeballur Village, Maganoor Mandal, Mahabubnagar District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/406637/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri S. Saduddin Khan and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 01.08.2013 in favour of Sri. C. Anjaneyulu for a period of 10 years. Subsequently, the lease was transferred on 24.11.2015 in favour of the proponent for un-expired period upto 31.07.2023. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 2.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village i.e., Maganoor (V) & Gudeballur (V) exists at a distance 2.8 km; nearest water body i.e Maganoor Cheruvu exists at a distance of 1.5 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 52,699.20 m³/annum of Stone and Metal and the life of mine is reported as 7 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 50.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 5.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 2.55 Lakhs/annum.

The proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt. 10.10.2022 of ADMG, Narayanpet District furnishing the details of production during the period from 2013-14 to April-22 (upto 10.10.2022). It is observed from the letter production was carried out during the period 2013-14 to 2022-21 & April-22 (upto 10.10.2022) and Nil during the period 2021-22.

The proponent submitted a copy of Resolution dt.20.10.2022 passed by the Gram Panchayat, Certified by the Sarpanch of Grama Panchayath, Gudeballur Village, Maganoor Mandal, Mahabubnagar District stating that the proponent has donated Rs. 40,000/- for repairing of roads & drinking water facilities in the village.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

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Agenda Item No. 07	Residential Building by Smt. Dr. Vandana Rathod & Smt. Namratha Singh, Sy. No. 118/Part, Situated at Adibatla (V), Ibrahimpatnam (M), Ranga Reddy District. - Environmental Clearance - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/INFRA2/406664/2022 (EC)

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Ram Reddy and Sri Lakshimikanth Reddy of M/s. Vison Labs, Hyderabad attended before the SEAC.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that few trees exists in the site. In this regard, the proponent informed that the intervening trees will be translocated to the boundaries of the site. The SEAC noted that total plot area is 9,294.56 Sq.m., Net plot area is 8,764.52 Sq.m., out of which green area is 898.12 Sq.m. (10.25%).

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 42,883.31 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Building Construction Project to accommodate 279 units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are 3 Blocks - A, B & C (1C + 1S + 9 Upper Floors) each and Amenities Block (G + 4 Floors).

It is also noted that Parking area to be provided is 8,501.47 Sq.m., (24.73 % against required 22%).

The total cost of the project is Rs. 77.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 115.0 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 30.0 lakhs/annum.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri K. Ravi Krishna and Sri G.V. Reddy of M/s. Team Labs & Consultants, Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The project is proposed with in 10 km radius of Himayat Sagar and Osman Sagar Lakes. But, **Kollur** (V) is not included in the list of 84 villages in the 10km catchment of above lakes as mentioned in the G.O.Ms. No: 111, MA, dt. 08.03.1996.

The SEAC noted that total plot area is 41,713.8 Sq.m., Net plot area is 39,624.7 Sq.m., Out of which green area is 6,620.5 Sq.m. (16.7%)

It was informed that the total built up area of the project is 29,641.8 Sq.m. The project consists of Residential Villas Construction Project to accommodate 88 no. of units. Maximum No. of floors proposed in the project are Residential Villas (G + 2 Floors) and Amenities (G + 3 Floors).

It was informed that adequate Parking area will be provided in each Villa for 2 parking spaces.

During presentation, the SEAC observed that site is adjacent to waterbody. In this regard, the proponent submitted a copy of Lr. dt.30.11.2021 of the Superintending Engineer, I&CAD Dept., Irrigation circle, Sangareddy. It is observed from the document that the applicant's land is Ac 16-33 Gts, out of which Ac. 0-07 Gts of land is affected under FTL of the Tank & Ac.0-24 Gts. Is affected under Buffer zone leaving the applicant's balance land of Ac 16-.02 Gts, as per the norms stipulated in G.O.Ms.No.168, dt.07.04.2012 of MA&UD Dept. Accordingly, the proponent proposed the layout of the project.

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The total cost of the project is Rs.90.0 Crores. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs.112.66 Lakhs during construction phase and Rs. 6.24 lakhs during occupation phase, Recurring cost: Rs.7.85 lakhs/annum during construction phase and Rs.68.79 lakhs/annum during occupation phase.

After detailed discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.

Agenda Item No. 09	2.085 Ha. Road Metal & Building Stone Quarry of M/s. Vij Mohan Constructions Pvt. Ltd., Survey No: 811, Raghavapur village, Siddipet Rural Mandal, Siddipet District. - TOR Violation - Reg.

The SEAC deferred the project, as the proponent did not attend the meeting.

Hence, the SEAC decided to inform the proponent to submit a letter stating willingness to consider their proposal in the SEAC meeting.

Agenda Item No. 10	3.0 Ha. Building Stone & Road Metal Quarry of Sri. D KONDAIAH, Sy.No:471, Akupamula Village, Munagala Mandal, Suryapet District. - TOR Violation - Reg.
Proposal No.	SIA/TG/MIN/405457/2022 (TOR Violation)

The representative of the project proponent Sri D.Kondaiah and Sri Mohan Reddy of M/s. Rightsource Industrial Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 01.10.2008 in favour of the proponent for a period of 10 years upto 30.09.2018. Subsequently, the 1st renewal of lease was granted (inprinciple) on 29.06.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 3.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 Category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 1,09,250 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal. The proponent continued mining operations even after 30.09.2018 as per lr. dt. 07.09.2022 of ADMG, Suryapet District, without obtaining prior EC.

Nearest human habitation is Madhavanagar (V) @ 0.9 km; Nearest water body is Mukundapuram pond exsits at 1.35 km (W) from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri P.Gopi and Sri. Deepak Sharma of M/s. Ambiental Global Pvt.ltd., Delhi attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

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The SEAC noted the lease was initially transferred on 24.08.2010 from Sri. P. Venkateshwar Reddy to the project proponent for a period of 10 years i.e., upto 07.04.2020. Subsequently, the renewal of lease was granted (in-principle) on 10.09.2022 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 4.0 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. Thus, the project is considered under B2 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan & EMP Report.

The nearest village Bodagutta Tanda (V) exists at a distance 0.8 km; nearest water body i.e Balanagar lake exists at a distance of 6.5 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 12,000 m³/annum of Gravel and 1,55,250 TPA of Building Stone and Metal and the life of mine is reported as 11 years.

The representative of the project proponent Sri G. Venkatesh; and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was initially granted on 04.12.2007 in favour of Sri. Badavath Khekkan the proponent for a period of 10 years. Then, the lease was transferred on 15.06.2012 in favour of the proponent for unexpired period of lease upto 09.12.2017. Subsequently, the 1st renewal of lease was granted on 28.11.2019 for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted before 09.09.2013. Hence, cluster is not applicable to the project. The SEAC noted that the Mine Lease Area is 0.94 Ha. which is less than 5.0 Ha. The project has to be considered under B2 Category, but since it is a violation case, the project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted application along with Scrutinized /Approved Mining Plan. The proponent informed that the production capacity of the project is to mine 10,000 m³/annum of Building Stone & Road Metal. The proponent continued mining operations even after 2017 without obtaining EC, as per lr. dt. 18.10.2022 of ADMG, Peddapally District.

Nearest human habitation is Boduguttapalli (V) @ 660m; Nearest water body i.e SRSP canal exists at 0.49 km and Nearest RF is Putnnoor RF exists at 8.0 km from the mine lease area.

The SEAC confirmed the project as a case of violation of the EIA Notification, 2006 and the project has to be considered in the terms of the provisions of the S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; and O.M. dt: 07.07.2021 & O.M. dt: 28.01.2022 issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI w.r.t. SOP for identification and handling of violation cases under EIA Notification., 2006.

The proponent informed that they have already collected the baseline data from October 2022 to December 2022 and requested to consider the same for preparation of EIA report based on the Standard Terms of Reference for proposed Quarry. The SEAC considered the request of the proponent for utilizing the baseline data from October 2022 to December 2022 for preparation of EIA report.

After detailed discussions, the proponent is directed to prepare EIA report considering the baseline data from October to December 2022, as per the Standard Terms of Reference (TORs) issued by the MoEF&CC, GoI for "Mining of Minerals" along with the Specific Terms of Reference w.r.t. violation as per S.O.No.804 (E) dt.14.03.2017; S.O.1030 (E), dt.08.03.2018; OM dt.07.07.2021 & OM dt.28.01.2022 and submit EIA report to the SEAC for appraisal.

The representative of the project proponent Sri Vasala Ravinder and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted the lease was granted (in-principle) on 08.10.2018 in favour of the proponent for a period of 20 years. It may be noted that the Mine Lease was granted after 09.09.2013. The Proponent also submitted a copy of Lr.dt. 09.11.2020 of ADMG, Karimnagar informing that there are no quarry leases falling within 500m from the proposed quarry lease. The SEAC noted that the mine lease area is 8.0 Ha. It is further noted that the total Cluster area is 8.0 Ha. And Net cluster area is 8.0 Ha. which is more than 5.0 Ha. The project is considered under B1 Category as per the provisions laid under EIA Notification, 2006 & its subsequent amendments and orders of the Hon'ble NGT. The proponent submitted a copy of Scrutinized/ Approved Mining Plan.

The SEAC noted that earlier the SEIAA, TS issued TORs (Auto generated) on 22.04.2021 for preparation of EIA Report. Accordingly, the proponent undergone the process of public hearing on 28.04.2022 and submitted Final EIA Report along with minutes of public hearing and issues emerged during public hearing. The SEAC noted the contents of Final EIA report. The SEAC observed from the minutes of Public Hearing that the total of 17 members expressed their opinions. Out of 17, 4 (NGO's) suggested the project by solving the issues raised by the villagers and other villagers opposed the project. 8 members submitted representations supporting the project. The proponent reported that they have allocated Rs. 4.2 Lakhs towards budget for CSR. It was further reported that they have allocated Rs. 10.7 Lakhs budget towards implementation of EMP measures.

The nearest village Rekonda (V) exists at a distance of 1.5 km (E); nearest water body i.e Rekonda Cheruvu exists at 0.5 km from the mine lease area.

It is proposed to mine 12,417.36 m³/annum of colour Granite and the life of mine is reported as 57 years.

The total cost of the project is Rs. 90.0 Lakhs. The proponent is proposing budget for Environmental protection towards capital cost: Rs. 9.45 lakhs and recurring cost: Rs. 1.80 Lakhs/annum.

After details discussions, the SEAC deferred the project for detailed examination keeping in view of the issues raised during public hearing.

The representative of the project proponent Sri V. Jagadeesh and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad, attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

The SEAC noted that the SEIAA earlier issued EC vide order dt.21.08.2020 to mine 1,11,668 m³/annum of Rough Stone & Road Metal with life of mine 7 years.

Now, the project proponent informed that as per the previous mining plan the quantity was approved, however the quantity in the mining plan was mistake, hence they have obtained a modified quarry plan with corrected quantity i.e., 535652.0 m³/annum and the life of the quarry is 4 years, since the quarry has not yet started the operation hence applied for amendment of EC for change in the production quantity for rough stone and metal and gravel from 111688 m³/annum to 535652.0 m³/annum and life of mine from 7 years to 4 years. The project proponent submitted copies of modified quarry plan approved by DDMC, Nizamabad, as proof for the same.

Minutes of the SEAC Meeting held on 13.12.2022

The SEAC noted that, no mining was done after the issue of EC as per lr. dt. 11.10.2022 of ADMG Sangareddy District stating that the quarry lease is not yet opened and obtained any dispatch permits till date.

After details discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of amendment to EC.

The representative of the project proponent Sri V. Yadaiah and Sri Vishnu Sharma of M/s. Ampl Environ Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad attended and made a presentation before the SEAC.

Earlier, the SEAC in its meeting held on 30.09.2022 deferred the project and informed the proponent to submit copies of documents w.r.t mine lease granted on 1982 & 2002 and status of court case mentioned during presentation and details of earlier production from initial grant of lease during 1982 till date duly certified by the Mining Department.

Accordingly, the proponent submitted a copy of lr. dt.02.07.1982, ADMG, Nalgonda District granting quarry lease and Prcds. Dt.18.06.2002 granting 1st renewal of quarry lease for 20 years upto 30.06.2020.

The proponent also submitted a copy of lr. dt. 29.11.2022 of ADMG, Rangareddy District furnishing the details of production during the period from 1982-83 to 2021-22. It is observed from the letter that production of Felspar was carried out during the period from 1982-83 to 1987-88; 1995-96 to 2000-01; 2002-03 to 2005-06; 2007-08; 2009-10; 2012-13 to 2018-19 and Quartz from 2006-07 to 2008-09; 2011-12 to 2018-19 and Nil during the remaining periods upto 2021-22.

The proponent also submitted a copy of Legal Heirs / Family members on Rs.20/- Stamp paper dt.23.05.2016 sworn and signed on June 2016 before the Magistrate, Court of XVII Special Metropolitan Magistrate, Secunderabad stating that the proponent i.e., Sri G. Srinivas is one of the Legal Heir of Sri G. Tateswar Rao after his death on 08.04.2016.

After details discussions, the SEAC recommended for issue of EC.
