The decision in 201st SEAC meeting:

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to raise ADS for Forest NOC as the Inimerla Reserved Forest is at a distance of 470m from proposed mining unit.

Accordingly, proponent submitted forest NOC vide letter dt.03.12.2022.

The project proponent shall comply following conditions as stipulated in the forest NOC dt.03.12.2022.

1. The user agency shall safeguard the boundary of Compartment No.438 of Inimerla RF as per the Board of Revenue Standing Orders as mentioned in BSO.No.15(35) (i) (ii).
2. The proposed area should maintain a Safety Zone as per BSO.No.15(35) (ii) (iii) from the boundary of Inimerla Reserve Forest. If mining /quarry operations cross the above said Safety Zone and overlaps with forest boundary, the Forest Department has the right to get the mining/quarry operations stopped and recommend for cancellation of the above mining/quarry lease.
3. The user agency should not use the any Reserve Forest land for any purpose including the dumping of waste etc.,
4. The user agency should carry out the Chain Link fence around the actual mining area to avoid wild animal accidents and also boundary pillars are to be fixed all along the proposed area.
5. The user agency should ensure that they shall abide by the provisions of A.P. Forest Act, 1967, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Environmental Protection Act, 1986.
6. The user agency should adhere to the Rules and Guidelines issued by the Government from time to time.
7. The user agency should not go for blasting during night times as it may be disturb the wildlife.
8. The user agency should not use the right of way / cart track within the Inimerla Reserve Forest for the purpose of transport of mined mineral.
9. The user agency should not destroy the continuity of the Right of Way which is outside the Reserve Forest.


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10. The user agency / their representative should not enter into Inimicus Reserve Forest without prior permission from the competent authority.
11. The user agency/ their representatives should not indulge in any kind of Forest Offences and they should always abide by the provisions of A.P. Forest Act, 1967, Forest (Conservation) Act 1980, Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and all other acts / rules relating to environment.
12. The Forest Department reserves right to include any new condition / conditions at any point of time in the interest of protection of adjoining Forest.
13. The NOC issued by the Forest Department is liable for cancellation at any point of time/complications/allegations/legal disputes/any kind of Forest Offences involved by the user agency etc arise in future without any prior intimation or notice.
14. Any violations are noticed at a later date, the WOC issued shall be summarily cancelled without assigning any reasons thereof and action will be initiated against the applicant according to the AP Forest Act, 1967 and Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as deemed fit.

15. The area of mining lease for Quartz may be verified as per the request of the applicant in the field and the proposed exact mining area (2.50 Ha) is not related to the Forest Department. NOC is issued in favour of applicant for the area of 2.00 Ha Non Forest Land with the following Geo-Coordinates.

He stated that he won't carry out rig blasting and will operate as per the norms only.

The base line data was collected from Jan, 2022 to March, 2022. The predominant wind direction is observed to be South East to North West. The maximum concentration of SPM is observed to be 63.5 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$. The incremental concentration is 4.95 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$. The GLC of SPM will fall at 0.3 Km in West direction of the mine.







The proposed project is for mining of **Colour granite in an area of 7.100 Ha. with a proposed of production quantity of Colour granite - 6225 m³/annum** with a condition that the total production during a scheme should be limited to the approved quantity as per Mining scheme/ plan.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (≤ 250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

The project proponent and their M/s. EHS360, have attended the meeting.

The Committee noted that as per the cluster letter issued by the Asst., Director of Mines & Geology, Srikakulam, vide Letter dated:04.01.2023, there are no existing quarry leases within the radius of 500 mtrs area. The total cluster area is > 5.0 Ha.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to raise ADS for submission of following:

1. Geo- coordinates to be corrected as per DGPS survey.
2. Letter from the concerned authority of Department of Mines and Geology regarding the status of determination.


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
